RIDERS TAKE GAME TWO OVER ARKANSAS IN COME FROM BEHIND FASHION:

The Frisco RoughRiders erased a five-run deficit to best the Arkansas Travelers 7-6 on Wednesday night from Riders Field. Arkansas (5-3, 40-37) roared in the front in the top of the first when Lazaro Montes rolled an RBI single to grab a 1-0 lead. The Travelers then tallied four runs in the top of the fourth when Caleb Cali rolled an RBI groundout, Nick Raposo plated a run on a throwing error and Blake Rambusch ripped an RBI single to take a 5-0 lead. Frisco (3-5, 41-35) then rallied in the bottom of the fourth when **Jax Biggers** and **Aaron Antonini** notched RBI singles, **Cam Cauley** lifted a two-run double and **Abimelec Ortiz** stung an RBI single to tie the game at five. In the top of the fifth, Arkansas recaptured the lead when Raposo smashed an RBI infield single to snatch a 6-5 lead. **Keyber Rodriguez** then rifled an RBI single in the bottom of the seventh, deadlocking the game at 6-6. In the bottom of the eighth, Cauley smashed an RBI groundout to give the Riders a 7-6 advantage, their lone lead of the game. Next half inning, Riders reliever **Gavin Collyer** worked a scoreless top of the ninth to secure the victory and capture his team-high seventh save. Frisco reliever **Josh Moller** (1-0) notched his first Double-A win, pitching two shutout innings. Arkansas reliever Nick Davila (0-2) took the loss, allowing Cauley's go-ahead groundout in the bottom of the eighth.

OPEN UP THE GATES:

Over the last two seasons, the RoughRiders have hosted their second and third-best crowds in franchise history on their July 3rd or 4th games at home. In 2023, the Riders welcomed 12,045 before eclipsing that number with 12,051 last season on July 4th. The franchise record for the largest crowd is 12,067 on July 20th, 2018 when the Riders hosted Dude Perfect Night. Frisco's 11,062 fans on May 13th this year were the most in a non-Triple-A game in Minor League Baseball this season and a crowd of over 12,000 today would rank as the fourth-most attended game in the minors in 2025.

REHABBING WYATT:

Wyatt Langford is expected to rehab with the RoughRiders today and play left field. This is Langford's second rehab appearance with the RoughRiders this season. In two games earlier this season, he homered and doubled while walking twice. Over 14 games in his Frisco career, he is hitting .405 (17-for-42)/.500/.833 with three doubles, four home runs, 10 RBIs, 11 walks and just seven strikeouts. He was placed on the 10-day Injured List by the Rangers with a mild left oblique strain on June 25th.

MR. JONES AND ME:

In his Double-A debut on Tuesday, **Keith Jones II** hit his first career Double-A home run in his second at-bat and his dad was able to track the baseball down in left field! He also added an RBI single in the bottom of the 10th inning for his 18th multi-hit game of the season. He tripled in his second game on Wednesday. The 2024 draft pick out of New Mexico State hit .270/.406/.451/.857 with 10 home runs and 35 RBIs over 68 games with High-A Hub City before his promotion.

JUNE GLOOM:

The RoughRiders struggled in the month of June, going 10-15 overall. Their 3.4 runs per game in the month marked their single worst month in runs per game since June of 2019, when they scored just 3.1 runs per game (and went 6-18). Their 10-15 record was their worst month since they went 9-16 in May of 2023. On the positive side, the Riders owned a 3.96 ERA in June, which was sixth in the Texas League. Frisco played 10 one-run games in the month, going just 3-7 in those games.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league overall with 53. They also have just committed just 33 errors in their last 53 games. That mark is also second-best in Double-A. Their 49 double plays turned since May 1st also paces the league. Their 53 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball.

OFFENSIVE WOES:

Frisco struggled on offense in their last 20 games, batting just .225/.307/.320/.627 with 3.5 runs per game, which are the fewest in the Texas League during that stretch. Their 11 home runs are sixth in the league while their 198 strikeouts are the most as well.

SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (seven) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for fourth in the Texas League. Their 25 saves are tied for the second-most in Double-A. Their 4.20 bullpen ERA is seventh in the league. In June, their 3.62 reliever ERA was fourth in the Texas League.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.7 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. In his last 22 games, he is hitting .268 (22-for-82)/.365/.305/.670 with three doubles, seven RBIs, 13 walks, 19 strikeouts and seven stolen bases. This season, he is on pace for 33 steals over 131 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22).

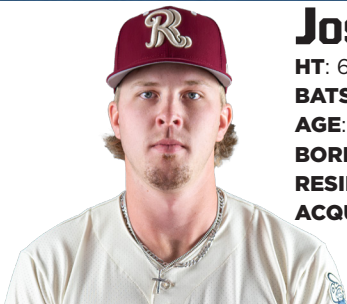

-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Alabama, and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate the new contract.

2025 SEASON

-Enters into 2025 in the 5th spot in the rotation.

-Last three starts: 2-0, 1.69 ERA (3ER/16.0IP)

2024 SEASON

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Made only relief appearance of the season on 7/9 vs. NWA, coming out of the bullpen behind MLB rehabber Tyler Mahle.

2023 SEASON

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).

-Induced ground balls at an over 50% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.
