OF **RECE HINDS** (98, CHA, 2023) is the only Southern League player with 90+ RBI in a season since 2017... **OF TYLER O'NEILL** (102, JAX, 2016) is the last Southern League hitter with a 100 RBI season.

HIP, HIPO O'RAE!

2B DYLAN O'RAE enters today with 50 stolen bases, the most in the Southern League and the 3rd-most in Double-A... O'Rae is the 2nd player in franchise history (since 2015) to reach 50 in a season, joining **OF JOHNNY DAVIS**, who set the single-season franchise record with 52 in 2017.

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

Across 48 games in the second half, the Shuckers have hit 82 home runs, tied for the 6th-most by a Southern League team in the 2nd Half since 2005.

The Shuckers need 6 home runs to break the franchise record of 154, set in 2022.

SAVE TONIGHT

RHP GARRETT HODGES recorded his 1st career Double-A save on Thursday night, becoming the 13th different Shucker to record a save this season, tying the franchise record.

The Shuckers finally set the record at 13 in 2025.

RHP CAMERON WAGONER (7) is the only Shuckers pitcher to record 5+ save this season.

LAUNDRY BUSINESS

On Thursday night, the Shuckers paired their road gray jerseys with their gray BP hats for the first time since at least 2023... It marked the first time the Shuckers have worn their gray BP caps during a game since April 28, 2024, when **RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI** struck out 6 over 3.2 hitless innings at Pensacola.

MAKING A MARK (IN COLORADO)

On Wednesday, **LHP MARK MANFREDI SR.** became the 1st member of the 2026 Shuckers to make their MLB debut and struck out 2 in 1.1 shutout innings against the Los Angeles Dodgers... Manfredi, who was acquired by the Colorado Rockies at the trade deadline, becomes the 90th former Shucker to make their MLB debut.

TEENAGE DREAM

On Tuesday, **INF LUIS PEÑA** became the 2nd teenager to appear for the Shuckers this season, joining **SS JESUS MADE**... Peña also became the 4th teenager to appear for the Shuckers in franchise history (since 2015) and the 3rd to achieve the feat since 2022.

Peña and Made are the 1st pair of teenage position players to appear in the same lineup in the Southern League since 2009, when **1B FREDDIE FREEMAN** and **OF JASON HEYWARD** achieved the feat with the Mississippi Braves.

3B ANDREW FISCHER recorded his 37th home run of the season on Sunday, moving into a tie for 2nd place for the most home runs by a Brewers Minor League player in franchise history (since 1970)... His 37 home runs mark the most by a Brewers Minor League hitter since 1985.

Fischer needs 3 more home runs to become the 2nd Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season... He would become the first since **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.
