REHABBING BRADFORD, HOMERS GUIDE RIDERS TO SHUTOUT WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Tulsa Drillers 5-0 on Tuesday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (13-9, 57-34) starter and Major League rehabber Cody Bradford spun a pair of scoreless, one-hit frames with three strikeouts against Tulsa (12-9, 46-44). The RoughRiders started the scoring before notching their first hit against Kendall Williams (4-9). In the bottom of the third inning, Cooper Johnson, Daniel Mateo and Alejandro Osuna worked walks before a wild pitch and a sacrifice fly by Maximo Acosta gave Frisco a 2-0 lead. Ben Anderson (5-5) took the hill in the top of the third and turned in 4.0 innings, allowing no runs on three hits and three walks while fanning three. Johnson belted his eighth homer of the season in the bottom of the fourth inning, extending the Riders lead to 3-0. In the top of the seventh inning, the RoughRiders turned to Andy Rodriguez who delivered 2.0 scoreless and hitless frames while walking one. Frisco added a pair of runs in the bottom of the eighth inning on back-to-back homers by Acosta and Josh Hatcher, marking the second time this season the Riders have hit consecutive home runs and pushing the lead to 5-0. Skylar Hales picked up a strikeout in a clean ninth inning, helping the RoughRiders to their eighth shutout of the season. Offensively, Frisco turned in their third three-homer game of the season. Acosta led the way with two RBI and Hatcher collected the lone multi-hit performance, going 2-for-4.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Maximo Acosta has been swinging a hot bad for the RoughRiders in July, hitting .296 (16-for-54)/.339/.444/.783 with three doubles, a triple, a home run, eight RBIs, 10 runs scored and six stolen bases. As one of six qualified players in the Texas League age 21 or younger, Acosta is hitting .387 (12-for-31)/.429/.513/1.042 over his last eight games. He has also excelled with runners in scoring position, placing third in the Texas League with a .353 average with RISP and first with a .474 average with RISP and two outs.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 32-13 at Riders Field this season. Their 32 wins and .711 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +76 run differential, a 3.61 ERA and is averaging 5.7 runs per game with a .751 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 25-21 with a 3.41 ERA, but a +17 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .633 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .338/.385/.565/.950 at home this season with seven of his 10 home runs. His .338 batting average is the second-best in the Texas League play a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 17 games, he is hitting .299 (20-for-67)/.373/.582/.955 with six doubles, two triples, three home runs and 12 RBIs. Over his last 14 games, he is batting .315 (17-for-54)/.403/.630/1.033 with four doubles, two triples, three home runs and 12 RBIs. Two Fridays ago, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .357 (5-for-14) with three doubles and a 1.042 OPS for the Riders.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman has been one of the best hitters on the RoughRiders this season. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has been hot in July. Over his last 14 games, he is hitting .273 (15-for-55)/.328/.400/.728 with four doubles, a home run, 10 RBIs and four runs scored. This season, he has a career highs in average (.272), slugging percentage (.446) and OPS (.772) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (70) and home runs (17).

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.96 ERA, which is also the best in all of Minor League Baseball. Both in their series opener and series finale against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday and Sunday, the bullpen allowed six runs. Those six runs were the most the the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.51), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .228 BAA is on pace to tie the 2021 team for the lowest mark in the franchise's history.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

REPERTOIRE

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrines College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.
