THE BAT CRACK OF CASEY COOK: Casey smacked the first four-hit game in Spartanburgers history Friday. He singled in four of his five at-bats, driving in four runs, one short of a Hub City season high (Keith Jones, 5).

DAILY SPECIALS

DIRTY BIRDS: Aberdeen leads the entire SAL with 181 stolen bases, averaging over 2 per game. The IronBirds stole 10 bases over three games against HC in April; Ethan Anderson nabbed four. The Spartanburgers are middle of the pack in the SAL, throwing out 20% of baserunners.

CAROLINA CAN: Three North Carolina Tar Heels reunite at Fifth Third Park this week. Casey Cook and newly promoted Dalton Pence welcome Vance Honeycutt to the Upstate. The trio never faced USC Upstate nor Wofford in their time at UNC - the Tar Heels are 6-1 all time against Wofford, and have never faced Upstate.

OFFENSIVE UPSWING: Hub City's offense lagged behind for most of the first half, posting a .211 batting average, the worst in the SAL. The 'Burgers were bottom-five in the league in runs, hits, doubles and triples. However, HC tallied 10+ hits in three of its five games against BG.

MOORE'S ON THE MEND: Malcolm Moore rejoins the Spartanburgers Tuesday after missing over two months recovering from a fractured right hand. Texas's No. 2 prospect had reached base 17 times through his first nine games with the Spartanburgers, including three doubles and a homer (which came against the Hot Rods) before being placed on the IL

MOLLERUS ON THE MOVE: Josh Mollerus is the third Spartanburgers player to get the bump to Double-A Frisco. The 24-year-old, who was acquired by the Rangers last summer in a July trade, leaves as the team as the active leader in wins (6) and pitched to a 2.57 ERA in 35 innings.

ROUND ONE: Hub City and Aberdeen met up for the first three games of the season from April 4-6. The Spartanburgers won the season opener. a 12-inning epic, 4-3. Julian Brock had the go-ahead single in the top of the 12th. Aberdeen took game two, but the Burgers nabbed the getaway game thanks to 7 runs on 11 hits.

# CLUB INFO & COACHING STAFF



The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



### Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



### **Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach**

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



### Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



### Jav Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



### **Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach**

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
