HIGHLIGHTS

PATH TO THE POSTSEASON: Somerset's 12-1 win on Friday night locked up the Patriots' second consecutive first half championship in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. Entering May 28th, Somerset trailed Portland by a season-high 5.5 games. From that day forward, the Patriots went 17-6 with a +50 run differential and 40 HR in the 23 games that culminated with Friday's celebration. Somerset did not take a share of first place until its 59th game of the season on June 15th vs. Altoona, when the Patriots' seventh consecutive win gave them sole possession of first place. MAKING UP FOR LOST TIME: Over the first 27 innings of this week's series, Somerset scored a total of 3 runs on 7 hits. The Patriots did not take their first lead of the series until a balk forced in the winning run in the bottom of the 14th inning on Thursday night. On Friday night, a win away from a postseason berth, the Patriots erupted for 12 runs on 9 hits, including a season-high 5 HR. **OPPOSITES ATTRACT:** Entering this week's series, the Patriots and Fisher Cats were tied for having allowed the fewest home runs in the Eastern League this year (49). After homers from Trey Sweeney, Everson Pereira, Austin Wells, Tyler Hardman and T.J. Rumfield on Friday night, the Patriots have now hit 9 HR in this week's series vs. the Fisher Cats.

MAKING THE FISHER CATS FISH: Through four games in this week's series, the Patriots pitching staff has struck out 55 batter (13.75 strikeouts per game). For the first time this season, Somerset's pitching staff leads the Eastern League in ERA (3.73), K (664) and WHIP (1.31). In the month of June, the Patriots pitching staff leads all of Double-A with a 2.87 ERA (4th in MiLB), 1.11 WHIP (3rd in MiLB) and 223 K (3rd in MiLB). The Patriots' 15 wins in the month of June are tied for the most in Minor League Baseball over that span (Round Rock-TEX, Omaha-KC).

2023: Assigned to the High-A Hudson Valley break camp roster, making his professional debut for the Renegades on April 11 vs. Aberdeen. Went 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA in nine High-A starts before he was promoted to Double-A Somerset on 6/15. At the time of his promotion, Hampton's 77 strike-outs led the Yankees organization and ranked 5th in all of MiLB. Over his final four High-A starts, Hampton posted a 2.31 ERA and struck out 35 batters over a span of 23.1 IP.

Career Notes: Selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech as a draft eligible sophomore, signing for a \$497,500 bonus. Pitched to a 4.29 ERA over 15 total appearances including 11 starts his sophomore year, where he ranked third on the team with 72 K in 56.2 IP. Set a career high with 12 strikeouts in his final collegiate outing in the Statesboro Regional versus Notre Dame, matching the program record for most single game strikeouts in a NCAA tournament game. Posted a 3.84 ERA his freshman season in 18 total appearances with 34 K in 44.1 IP.

Personal Notes: One of three former Texas Tech Red Raiders on the Patriots, joining Clayton Beeter and TJ Rumfield. Attended Kilgore High School in Kilgore, TX. Finished high school career with 284 strikeouts and a 1.94 ERA in 162 innings pitched, earning First Team All-State and District MVP honors his senior year. Was also awarded 2020 Perfect Game Preseason All-American and First Team All-Region honors. Helped Kilgore reach 2019 State Championship game his junior year.

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trienton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL.
