Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds wrap up their six-game series with the Norfolk Tides this afternoon. Nashville fell 11-8 in front of a sellout crowd at First Horizon Park. Right-hander Pedro Fernandez will face left-hander Drew Rom in the series finale.

Pedro Fernandez: 28-year-old Pedro Fernandez makes his fourth appearance and third start of 2023. The Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic native last pitched on Thursday, going 2.0+ innings. He gave up a couple of runs (2 ER) on a hit with four walks in a no decision. Fernandez went 8-4 with a 4.42 ERA in 17 starts for Quintana Roo of the Mexican League last season and was signed to a minor league deal with Milwaukee on January 23, 2023. Prior to this season, the last time Fernandez was in affiliated baseball was in 2018 with Double-A Northwest Arkansas and Triple-A Omaha in the Royals organization. He was initially signed as an international free agent by Kansas City on September 2, 2011.

Drew Rom: 23-year-old Drew Rom starts for the Tides today. The left-hander is 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP/3 ER) to start the 2023 campaign. Rom started in game one of the series, working 6.0 scoreless innings in a no decision (3 H, 1 BB, 4 K). He is tabbed as the No. 19 prospect in the Orioles organization by MLB Pipeline. In 2022, Rom went 8-3 with a 4.43 ERA (120.0 IP/59 ER) in 26 games (25 starts) between Norfolk (7) and Double-A Bowie (19). He was a MiLB.com Organization All-Star last season and a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star in 2019. Rom was drafted by Baltimore in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Highlights High School in Fort Thomas, Ky.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 1, Seventh: 0.

Strong Arms: Despite the 11-run barrage from the Tides last night, the Sounds bullpen holds true as one of the best in Triple-A. Nashville relievers boast a 2.97 ERA (78.2 IP/26 ER) through 14 games, the second-best in the league, trailing Memphis' 2.48 mark. The 'pen also leads the league in strikeouts (92) and ranks third in WHIP (1.25).

Singleton Streaking: Jon Singleton extended his hit streak to nine games last night, making it the longest by any Sounds hitter this season and tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the International League. During the streak, Singleton is batting .333 (12-for-36) with 3 home runs and 6 RBI.

Blake Bashing: Blake Perkins tallied another hit in last night's contest, bringing his hit streak to four games. On the year, the 2015 second round pick is batting .333 (13-for-39) with 7 runs, 6 walks and a .422 on-base percentage.

Our Hiura: Keston Hiura crushed his fifth home run of the season and third of the homestand with a two-run blast in the first inning. Hiura ranks among league leaders (T-4th) in the big fly department.

Power Surge: The Sounds have hit the most home runs among International League teams this week with 11 homers since April 11. Only Salt Lake in the Pacific Coast League has hit more in that span (12).

Erceg's Excellence: Reliever Lucas Erceg's no-hit streak ended at 7.2 innings on Friday, but the lefty still has not allowed a run in 8.2 innings of work this season, the longest in Minor League Baseball. Erceg is 2-0 and has fanned 10 of 30 hitters faced (33%).

Seasoned Vet: Sounds reliever Alex Claudio worked another scoreless outing, his third consecutive in the series and his fifth in six appearances of 2023. Through 5.1 innings, Claudio boasts a 0.75 WHIP and a .188 batting average allowed.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 608-524 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Fernandez' last appearance came on April 13 vs. Norfolk. After escaping the first and second innings without damage, he allowed the first three Tides to reach in the third before departing. In 2.0+ innings, he allowed 2 runs (both earned) on a hit and four walks. Fernandez did not factor into the decision as Nashville won 5-2.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Fernandez lone career appearance against Norfolk came in game three of the series. He is 0-0 with a 9.00 ERA and no strikeouts.
