**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds being a six-game road trip tonight with game one in St. Paul, Minnesota against the Saints. It's the first ever meeting between the two teams. Right-hander Jason Alexander starts for Nashville against right-hander Dereck Rodríguez for St. Paul.

**Jason Alexander:** 29-year-old Jason Alexander starts for the Sounds in the series opener tonight. The right-hander makes his fourth start of the season and first against St. Paul. He is 3-0 with a 2.40 ERA through his first three starts. His three wins are tied for the most in the International League. Last time out, Alexander allowed one run on four hits in 5.0 innings against Charlotte on April 20. He spent the 2021 season in the Marlins organization, going 1-1 with a 1.37 ERA in seven games (6 starts) between FCL Marlins, Double-A Pensacola and Triple-A Jacksonville. He was originally signed as an undrafted free agent in 2017 by the Angels out of Menlo College in California.

**Dereck Rodríguez:** 29-year-old Dereck Rodríguez starts for the Saints in tonight's game. The right-hander is making his fourth appearance overall in 2022, and third with St. Paul. In two games with St. Paul, Rodríguez is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (7.0 IP/0 ER). He last pitched on April 20 in a relief appearance at Toledo. He went 3.0 innings and allowed two unearned runs on two hits. He did not issue any walks, struck out five, and picked up his first win of the season. Rodríguez made a relief appearance for Minnesota on April 13 vs. Los Angeles-NL. He worked 4.0 innings and allowed three runs on four hits and three walks and two strikeouts. Rodríguez, who signed a minor league contract with Minnesota on January 11, 2022, is the son of Ivan "Pudge" Rodríguez.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 4, Second: 8, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Open It:** Nashville is 2-1 in series openers in 2022. They topped Durham, 5-4, to start the season on April 5, lost to Gwinnett, 4-3, on April 12, and beat Charlotte, 7-0, last Tuesday.

**Go Streaking:** Infielder Mark Mathias (six games) and Brice Turang (five games) extended their hitting streaks on Sunday. Mathias is hitting .450 (9-for-20) with 1 run, 3 doubles, 1 RBI and 3 walks during his six-game streak and Turang is hitting .500 (11-for-22) with 3 runs, 3 doubles, 6 RBI and 2 walks during his five-game streak.

**Three and Counting:** The Sounds turned in their third straight series win to start the season by taking five of six from Charlotte. The last time a Nashville club won its first three series of the season was in 2003. Back in '03, the Sounds played Iowa and Albuquerque, and went 6-0 with a pair of three-game sweeps after both finales were postponed due to rain. They then went on the road to Iowa and won three of four. The Sounds returned home to welcome Memphis for a four-game series and swept the Redbirds to improve to 13-1 on the season.

**Mendoza Line:** Nashville pitchers continue to stifle hitters. After yielding only six hits in 32 at-bats on Sunday, Sounds pitchers have held opponents to a .198 batting average. Nashville is the only pitching staff in Triple-A Baseball holding the opponent under .200. The staff is allowing only 6.4 hits per game.

**Defense Wins Games:** The Sounds have not made an error since April 14 at Gwinnett, going 88.1 innings without a miscue in the field.

**Earn It:** Nashville's team ERA went down to 2.48 with Sunday's win. The 2.48 ERA (160.0 IP/44 ER) is the lowest in Minor League Baseball.

**White Hot:** Sounds infielder Tyler White continues to swing a hot bat and knocked in two more runs with a two-run blast Saturday night. White has recorded at least one RBI in six consecutive games and has hit safely in seven straight. He's hitting .440 (11-for-25) with 6 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs, 10 RBI and 4 walks during the streak.

**Hold the Line:** Nashville relievers have amassed 18 holds this season, the most in all of Minor League Baseball. There's a four-way tie for second-most with 14 between Albuquerque, Columbus, Lehigh Valley and Oklahoma City.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 520-465 record during this span.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
