LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped the series finale to the Portland Sea Dogs 11-2 on Sunday afternoon. Both John Rhodes and Jackson Holliday notched solo home runs for the Baysox, but ultimately, Bowie's offense was held mostly quiet, with just four hits on the afternoon. Portland managed five runs on six hits through four innings against right-handed starter Ryan Long, who took the loss on Sunday. At the plate, the Sea Dogs were powered by three home runs of their own, including a three-run shot from Tyler Dearden - part of a four-RBI day from Dearden and a six-run seventh inning from the Sea Dogs. Right-hander Jean Pinto allowed six runs (two earned) through three innings out of the bullpen for Bowie, while right-hander Nick Richmond tossed a pair of scoreless frames in relief.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter this series with a record of 52-50 on the season. Their 19-14 mark in the second half has them leading the Southwest division standings and sitting two games above Bowie. The Baysox are 8-10 against the Flying Squirrels this season, securing a series split in Richmond back in early July. Richmond's 3.83 staff ERA on the campaign is third-best in the Eastern League. However, their starters own the fifth-worst ERA in the league (4.23) with the fewest innings (372). The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, The Flying Squirrels active roster includes five of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 23 SF), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 25 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 26 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Carson Seymour is projected to get the ball for Richmond. In four starts against the Baysox this season, Seymour has pitched to a 6.87 ERA (10 ER in 13.1 IP) after allowing five earned runs across three innings in his most recent start against Bowie on 7/9. Seymour is coming off a start which earned him Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors in which he fired five shutout innings with just a single hit and no walks allowed, while striking out nine, this past Tuesday in Altoona. The No. 14 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, Seymour is originally a 6th round pick of the Mets in 2021, but was traded over to the Giants this past August in the Darin Ruf deal. Seymour was drafted out of Kansas State University, where he pitched for two seasons after one season at Dartmouth. He only pitched 84.2 innings through his whole collegiate career due to transfer rules and the COVID-19 cancellation for the 2020 season. Seymour's fastball can climb as high as 99 mph, partnered with a turbo sinker in the mid-90s, along with a high-80s slider/cutter, high-80s changeup, and a low-80s curveball.

COMEBACK KIDS

Recently, the Baysox have made it a habit of coming from behind in games. Bowie has conceded the first run in 14 of its last 15 games. However, in that stretch the Baysox have gone 7-8 overall. This season, Bowie is 17-33 in total when allowing the first run. Eight of the last ten Baysox victories have come after failing to score first.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday returned to the Baysox lineup in a big way last weekend. Saturday and Sunday marked the first time in Holliday's professional career with home runs in back-to-back games, as he's gone 6-for-11 at the plate with two walks since his return to the lineup on Friday. Overall, Holliday has recorded hits in 11 of his first 13 games at the Double-A level, with seven of those games being multi-hit efforts. This season, across three different levels, Holliday ranks top five in the Orioles' organization in batting average (.294), on-base percentage (.464), slugging percentage (.464), OPS (.732), OPS (1st - 1.007), triples (1st - 6), and walks (1st - 69). Holliday's on-base percentage also leads all of Minor League Baseball. He is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has continued his surge in the Eastern League throughout the summer months, as his .294 average since June 1 is third-highest in the league amongst players with at least 200 plate appearances. Cook has also brought the pop, with his 24 extra-base hits in that span sitting at third-most in the league. This past week, Cook hit .280 (7-for-25) with four home runs and 12 RBI. Cook currently leads active Baysox players in home runs (17), RBI (62 - third-most in the Eastern League), on-base percentage (.322), slugging (.473), OPS (.795), and stolen bases (23).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers joins Bowie from High-A Aberdeen after one of the best performances across Minor League Baseball in the month of July. The No. 10 prospect in the O's system, per MLB Pipeline, hit .397 last month - second-highest in Minor League Baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances, while his 1.185 OPS was fourth-best and led the Orioles' minor league system. Beavers also led the Baltimore farm with his .494 on-base percentage in the month of July. He's opened his time in Double-A with hits in four of five games, including three multi-hit contests, and a 8-for-20 start overall.

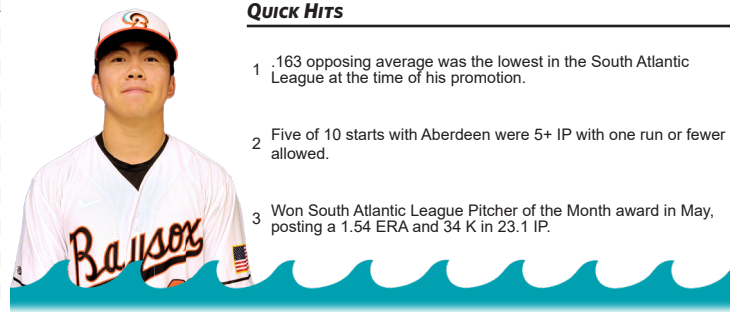

CAREER NOTES

- Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26.
- Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June.
- Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.
- Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.
- Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.
- Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.
