#### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

Steve Balboni becomes the first Sound to hit three home runs in a game at Knoxville on May 1, 1980. His 34 home runs that season is still the franchise record, shared with Brian Dayette with 34 home runs in 1982. Balboni would play in parts of 11 seasons in the Majors and won a World Series with the Royals in 1985.

**Today's Game:** The Nashville Sounds look to take another series this afternoon at St. Paul. The Sounds took a 7-3 win in the completion of Friday's game on Saturday, then beat the Saints and the rain for a 12-3 triumph in five innings. Right-handed opener Luis Perdomo gets the ball for Nashville against Dereck Rodriguez for the Saints.

**Luis Perdomo:** 28-year-old Luis Perdomo makes his second start of the season this afternoon. He came on in relief on April 28 to close out the ninth inning in a Sounds win. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native is 0-0 with a 0.96 ERA (9.1 IP/1 ER) in eight prior appearances. He joins Nashville after being signed by Milwaukee to a minor league contract on January 4, 2021. He missed all of the 2021 season recovering from Tommy John surgery in October 2020. Perdomo spent five seasons with the Padres from 2016-2020, going 20-31 with a 5.19 ERA (444.1 IP/256 ER) in 133 appearances (61 starts). He was a Midwest League mid-season and post-season All-Star in 2015 and played in the MLB Futures Game that season. Perdomo was originally signed as an international free agent by the Cardinals in 2010.

**Dereck Rodriguez:** 29-year-old Dereck Rodriguez starts for the Saints in today's game. The right-hander is making his fifth appearance overall in 2022 and fourth with St. Paul. In three games with St. Paul, Rodriguez is 1-0 with a 0.77 ERA (11.2 IP/1 ER). He last pitched on April 26 against Nashville. He allowed five hits and one run (ER) in 4.2 innings to start the series. He struck out six Sounds in a no-decision. Rodriguez made a relief appearance for Minnesota on April 13 vs. Los Angeles-NL. He worked 4.0 innings and allowed three runs on four hits and three walks and two strikeouts. Rodriguez, who signed a minor league contract with Minnesota on January 11, 2022, is the son of Ivan "Pudge" Rodriguez.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 8, Second: 9, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Power Surge:** Nashville has blasted nine home runs over the past three games, the most in the league since Thursday. Six of these nine homers have come from Brice Turang, Jon Singleton and Weston Wilson, who each have two. Also joining in on the long ball in the few days are Mark Mathias, Tyler White and Corey Ray. The Sounds are 11-1 when homering.

**Talented Turang:** The Brewers' No. 4 prospect Brice Turang extended his hitting streak to 10 games yesterday, the longest for any Sounds hitter this year. Turang is hitting .423 (18-for-42) with five doubles, two homers and 10 RBI since the streak began on April 19.

**Going For Four:** The Sounds can take their fourth straight series win with a victory today at St. Paul. The last time a Nashville club won its first four series of the season was in 2003. Back in '03, the Sounds played Iowa and Albuquerque, and went 6-0 with a pair of three-game sweeps after both finales were postponed due to rain. They then went on the road to Iowa and won three of four. The Sounds returned home to welcome Memphis for a four-game series and swept the Redbirds to improve to 13-1 on the season.

**Rain is a Good Thing:** The Sounds have endured three hours and 28 minutes' worth of rain delays over the past two games, not including the suspension of Friday's game into Saturday and the shortening of yesterday's game to five innings. Despite this, Nashville has combined to outscore St. Paul 19-6 in those contests.

**Earn It:** Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.61 (200.0 IP/58 ER) after giving up three runs in their last game. The 2.61 ERA is the lowest in Minor League Baseball, ahead of Double-A Somerset (2.68), only behind Indianapolis (2.39). The Sounds have the best ERA among relievers in Triple-A (2.45).

**Just Hold On:** Nashville relievers have amassed 19 holds this season which is the second-most in the International League. Only Lehigh Valley has more with 21.

**Looking Ahead:** After today's game, the Sounds return home to First Horizon Park for six games against the Norfolk Tides, Triple-A affiliate of the Orioles. It will be the first-ever meeting between the two clubs.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
