Just Hold On: Nashville relievers have amassed 19 holds this season which is the second-most in the International League. Only Lehigh Valley has more with 21.

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.61 (200.0 IP/58 ER) after giving up three runs in their last game.

Looking Ahead: After today's game, the Sounds return home to First Horizon Park for six games against the Norfolk Tides, Triple-A affiliate of the Orioles. It will be the first-ever meeting between the two clubs.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
