PUNCHING A PLAYOFF TICKET

The Shuckers clinched the First Half South Division title on Sunday with a 3-2 win in game one of a doubleheader... The Shuckers have clinched a spot in the 2026 Southern League Playoffs, which begin on Tuesday, September 15... The Shuckers will host games two and three (if necessary) at Keesler Federal Park on Thursday, September 17, and Friday, September 18.

- 2026 marks the 25th playoff appearance by a Brewers Double-A affiliate and the 6th in Shuckers franchise history.
- The Shuckers have won the First Half title in the South Division in back-to-back seasons, matching 2018-19 for the longest streak in franchise history.
- The Shuckers are looking to reach the Southern League Championship Series for the first time since 2019... The Shuckers are looking to become the 1st Brewers Double-A affiliate to win a League Championship Series since the 1994 El Paso Diablos (Texas League)... No Brewers full-season affiliate has won a league championship since the 2012 Wisconsin Timber Rattler (Midwest League).
- The Shuckers are the 1st Brewers Double-A affiliate to reach the playoffs in 3 straight seasons since the El Paso Diablos, who reached the Texas League Playoffs in 5 consecutive seasons between 1990 and 1994.

WAKING UP THE BATS

The Shuckers enter today with a 5-game win streak, tied for the team's longest win streak of the season... It marks the 9th win streak of at least 5 games by a Southern League team this season... During the streak, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 39-17 (+22).

- During the streak, the Shuckers lead Double-A in runs (39), average (.367), on-base percentage (.448) and OPS (1.049).
- The Shuckers have scored at least 5 runs in 4 of the 5 games, recorded 4+ extra-base hits in 3 of 5 and recorded 10+ hits in all 5 games.
- The Shuckers 5-game streak with 10+ hits is tied for the 2nd-longest in franchise history... The streak is the longest since July 29-August 3, 2023 (5g).
- Entering today, the Shuckers have recorded 6 home runs in their last 3 games, their longest streak since May 21-27 (4g).

SWEET 16

1B BLAKE BURKE recorded his 16th home run of the season on Wednesday, a 103 MPH, 405' blast to center... Burke enters today tied for 2nd in the Southern League in home runs... Since making his Double-A debut on August 2, 2025, Burke has 27 home runs in 102 games, tied for the 7th-most by a player in Shuckers franchise history.

HIT 'EM WHERE IT HURTS

OF JACOB HURTUBISE tied his career-high with 4 hits and extended his on-base streak to 13 consecutive games on Wednesday... Since returning to the Shuckers lineup on June 10 (11g), Hurtubise is hitting .405 (15-for-37) with 2 doubles, 2 triples, 6 walks and 3 stolen bases... Hurtubise has reached base in 13 of 14 games with the Shuckers this season.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

OF JOSH ADAMCZEWSKI has recorded a hit in all 6 Double-A games since making his debut on June 17... Over that span, Adamczewski is 9-for-22 (.409) with 2 doubles and 2 walks... 9 of his 18 balls in play have been hard hit (95+ MPH) and 8 have been in play at 100+ MPH.

GONE FISCH-ING

3B ANDREW FISCHER recorded his 3rd Double-A home run on Tuesday, a 105 MPH, 396-foot solo shot with a 40° launch angle... Fischer has recorded an extra-base hit in 5 of 6 Double-A games since being promoted on June 15 (5-for-21, 2B, 3B, 3 HR).

This season, 6 home runs between MLB and Triple-A have been hit with a launch angle of 40+°, an exit velo of 105+ MPH and a distance of 390+ feet.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... Guerrero needs 18 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,482 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP JARON DEBERRY (5-3, 4.13) makes his 14th start of the season and his 4th against the Biscuits... DeBerry enters today among the Southern League leaders in opponents average (2nd, .202), ERA (4th, 4.13), strikeouts (6th, 66) and innings (7th, 65.1)... In 3 starts against Montgomery, DeBerry owns a 3.00 ERA (6er, 18.0ip) with 23 strikeouts and a .172 opponents average.
