Today: It's the series finale, coinciding with a Capital City Market Kids Day and Princesses at the Ballpark, as the Lansing Lugnuts play the sixth game in a six-game series against the Peoria Chiefs. After today, only 13 games remain in the season and only seven games remain in the home schedule: September 1-6 vs. Fort Wayne.

If the Lugnuts win... it would be the Nuts' 13th win in their last 15 home games... it would give the Nuts five wins in six games against Peoria, the same result as 2024.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 1, Chiefs 0 (6). Daniel Bucciero lined an RBI single in the first inning, and Jorge Marcheco tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, leading Lansing to victory in front of a Saturday night crowd of 7,309. The game was delayed 55 minutes with two outs in the 6th for a thunderstorm before it was called due to wet field conditions.

No Place Like Home: The Nuts are 12-2 in their last 14 home games, 7-2-2 in home series overall, and 33-24 at home this year, trailing only South Bend (35-21) for the best home record in the league.

Who's Streaking:

- **Jake Reinisch** went 0-for-1 with a walk last night to extend his team-high on-base streak to 33 games. Reinisch is batting .294 with a .446 OBP and a .505 slugging pct. during the streak, with 32 base hits and 28 walks.
- **Daniel Bucciero** went 1-for-1 with an RBI single and a walk last night to extend his own on-base streak to 19 games. Bucciero is batting .299 with a .427 OBP and a .443 slugging pct. during the streak, with 20 base hits and 14 walks.

Debut Day: Liberty product **Tanner Marsh** made his professional debut yesterday, going 0-for-2 as the Lugnuts' starting shortstop. Marsh, the A's ninth-round selection in July, was added to the roster on Thursday. He finished 5th in the nation this past season in defensive runs saved, all the while leading Conference USA in base hits, runs and assists... and his 70 runs scored (achieved in 64 games) set a new Liberty single season school record. He is the first Liberty Flame to play for the Lugnuts since 2014 outfielder **Ian Parmley** as well as the 1,011th all-time Lugnut and the 51st different Lugnut to suit up this season.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics, and – on August 9 with two scoreless innings in relief – 2021 Lugnut **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

Cooperstownian Nut: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

AUGUST 23 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: Blake Tekotte (TEE-kuh-tee) led off the bottom of the 13th inning with a walk-off home run, and the Fort Wayne TinCaps beat the Lugnuts, 3-2. Lansing manager Clayton McCullough was ejected for arguing a play at the plate in the 11th where the Lugnuts' Welinton Ramirez was called out attempting to tag and scare on a Justin McClanahan fly-out.

2019: Right fielder Griffin Conine and closer Cre Finrock were named to the 2019 Midwest League Post-Season All-Star Team, Conine as one of the three OF and Finrock as the league's right-handed reliever. Conine ended up leading the league with 22 homers while Finrock led the league with 17 saves in 17 opportunities. In the game at South Bend, Otto Lopez's fourth hit of the game was a two-out, two-run triple in the tenth, giving the Lugnuts a 5-4 win at South Bend.

In a Nutshell: Began the season on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster... making his sixth straight start after 23 relief appearances opened the year, moved into the rotation on July 25 following the promotions of Ben Hansen, Zane Taylor and Nathan Dettmer to Double-A Midland.

Last Start, August 18 vs. Peoria: Opened the series with a gem, fanning eight Chiefs while allowing two runs on three hits and two walks in 5 2/3 innings... one run was scored against Novotny, an RBI single by Jalin Flores with one out in the sixth inning; the other was scored against Luis Carrasco, a two-out RBI double that gave Peoria a 2-1 lead... the Nuts rallied to tie the game in the bottom of the 6th and went on to beat the Chiefs, 6-5.

Hometown Hero: Attended Park of Cottage Grove, where he lettered in baseball, basketball and bowling (he has bowled a 300 game)... Mr. Baseball finalist, ranked Perfect Game's No. 5 player in Minnesota and No. 1 LHP... as a senior: 10-1, 1.26 ERA, 78 1/3 IP, 11 ER, 25 BB and 114 K.

College Days: Chose the Golden Gophers over Alabama, USC, Illinois and Wichita State... majored in accounting at Minnesota's Carlson School of Management... spent his summer ball days with the Minnesota Mud Puppies (2021), Willmar Stingers (2022), Cotuit Kettleers (2023)... ascended to Minnesota's Friday starter as a sophomore in 2023 and was named Dave Winfield Pitcher of the Year... ranked 5th in the Big Ten in K/9 in 2024 (10.7), with 62 K in 52 IP, and was named All-Big Ten Third Team... named D1 Baseball's No. 26 Draft Prospect in the Big Ten.

2025: Signed for \$125,000 as the first pick of the 18th round in 2018... dominated out of the bullpen for the Stockton Ports, and was sporting a 1.63 ERA when he moved to the starting rotation on July 13... whiffed nine Modesto Nuts in five innings in his first California League start, following up with six scoreless innings against Modesto on August 10... in total: 1.67 ERA as a reliever (37 2/3 IP, 15 R, 7 ER, 20 BB, 52 K), but a 5.85 ERA as a starter (40 IP, 27 R, 26 ER, 17 BB, 45 K).

2026: Joined the Lugnuts to open the season and allowed only two runs in his first six appearances, but gave up five runs at South Bend on May 8 and four runs vs. Quad Cities on May 15... Midwest League base-stealers are 4-for-7... lefties are hitting just .202; righties are batting .263 with a .380 OBP (23 BB), but have hit into nine (of 10) double plays... 4.24 ERA as a starter (23 1/3 IP), 5.80 as a reliever (35 2/3 IP).
