Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the penultimate game in a six-game series against the division-leading West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, the 427th all-time meeting between the two teams. These are the final contests of the year in the 24-game season series.

Starting Matchup: 23-year-old Lugnuts right-hander **Kyle Virbitsky**, drafted in the 17th round last year from Penn State, makes his second Midwest League start following a call-up from Single-A Stockton. West Michigan counters with Australian lefty **Jack "O'Lantern" O'Laughlin**, making his fifth start and 26th overall appearance. Weirdly, two of his prior four starts have come against the Nuts: four scoreless innings on April 16 and four scoreless innings on May 8.

Last Night: Whitecaps 11, Lugnuts 9. In front of 7,776 fans, **Trei Cruz** capped a seven-run West Michigan 6th inning, and the Caps held off the Lugnuts in a Friday night slugfest. In defeat, the Lugnuts received a leadoff home run from **Max Muncy** and two-run shot in a four-run 7th from **Denzel Clarke**.

LUG•NOTES

Power Display: The Whitecaps have homered ten times in the four games played in this series: four times in Tuesday's 15-8 victory, including a grand slam from **Ben Malgeri**; once in Wednesday's Lugnuts 8-1 win, a **Trei Cruz** solo home run supplying the Caps' only run; and three times in Thursday's 5-1 Caps triumph, including two homers by **Corey Joyce**; and twice yesterday, with Cruz crushing a key three-run homer and **Izaac Pacheco** knocking his first Midwest League home run.

Plunked: While West Michigan's batters are hitting home run, West Michigan's pitchers are hitting Lugnuts batters. Eight Nuts have struck by pitches in the series, including **Jack Winkler** on Tuesday (which has sidelined Winkler for the foreseeable future), **Brayan Buevas** twice on Wednesday (when four Lugnuts were hit), and three more Lugnuts yesterday, each by a different Whitecaps pitcher. With all of these HBPs, the Lugnuts have now been struck by 43 pitches as a team this year – which ties them for fewest HBPs in the Midwest League. In contrast, the Great Lakes Loons have been hit 91 times. (In a harsh coincidence, the Loons hit Lugnuts shortstop **Drew Swift** in the wrist with a pitch last week, likely ending Swift's season.)

Starting Things With a Blast: The Lugnuts had not hit a leadoff home run all season before **Max Muncy** joined the team; Muncy hit the first pitch out of the park in Great Lakes on July 27 and led off the 1st inning with another homer yesterday.

Amongst the League Leaders: The Lugnuts are third in the Midwest League in team batting average (.246) and third in base hits (804). Reliever **Kumar Nambiar** is second in the league with 35 appearances, trailing only West Michigan's **Andrew Magno** (36).

An Exciting Day on the Farm: Top pitching prospect **Ken Waldichuk**, acquired in a four-player package from the Yankees with the Lugnuts' **Cooper Bowman** in a trade for Frankie Montas and Lou Trivino, makes his Athletics organizational debut tonight for Triple-A Las Vegas. No. 2 pitching prospect **Gunnar Hoglund**, acquired in a four-player package from the Blue Jays for Matt Chapman, makes his full-season A's debut tonight for Single-A Stockton.

51 in 101: Today, by Game 101 of the MiLB season, the Lugnuts have had 51 different players suit up this season. This is the fifth season in team history (2011, 2017, 2019, 2021) in which the Nuts have used at least 50 players. The franchise record for most players used in one season is 55, set last year to break the 2017 mark of 54 players.

- Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.
- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His game-worn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame, by request.

Inside the Park and Out of This World: On August 2-3, 2022, CF **Denzel Clarke** joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Major Leagues.

Roster Crunch: The Lugnuts have used 51 different players this year: 25 position players and 26 pitchers (plus two position players pitching), with 18 different starting pitchers.

From Far and Wide: The Lugnuts include players from 10 different countries: USA, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, Mexico, Panama and Venezuela in addition to Puerto Rico and 11 different states: Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Hawaii, Idaho, New York, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Texas and Washington.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has five players acquired by the Athletics via trade: **Cooper Bowman** (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22); **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22); **Joey Estes** (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17).

Nuts to the Show: Eight Lugnuts have debuted in the Major Leagues this year, 169 all-time: A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018), catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019) and pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018); Mariners reliever **Danny Young** (2016) and Red Sox starting pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: It was a very bad day for Fort Wayne catcher Marcus Greene, Jr., who committed two passed balls and two run-scoring throwing errors (of four total TinCaps errors), helping the Lugnuts win 7-4 at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2017: Dayton's Jesse Adams was a terrific reliever – except against the Lugnuts. Rodrigo Orozco ended Adams's 25 2/3 scoreless innings streak with a two-run homer in the 10th inning at Fifth Third Field, his first home run in 120 games (dating back to 8-15-15) to give the Lugnuts a 5-3 victory. Adams had last allowed a run against the Lugnuts, coincidentally.

Welcome Back! After joining the Nuts directly after signing last year as the Athletics' 17th-round selection and making seven appearances, three starts, the towering Virbitsky rejoined the Lugnuts after excelling in Stockton's rotation, replacing the demoted Stevie Emanuels... he limited the Great Lakes Loons to one Imanol Vargas solo homer in his MWL 2022 debut on July 29th, whiffing six in five strong innings.

Turning Pro: Virbitsky's first time being drafted was in 2021, taken 518th overall by the Oakland Athletics... signed for \$50,000... also from Penn State: Mike Scioscia, David Aardsma, and Hall of Famer John "Monte" Montgomery Ward... both of Kyle's parents attended Penn State.

Glory Days: Attended Episcopal Academy, where he pitched against Dayton's Michael Siani (William Penn Charter School), who also was the first player faced as a pro (Siani tripled)... named a Top-25 baseball player in Pennsylvania by PennLive.com... 2016 Perfect Game Underclass high honorable mention... 2017 Rawlings-Perfect Game honorable mention All-America... as a junior, posted 1.76 ERA with 66 strikeouts while hitting three home runs... as a senior was named Team MVP of the Episcopal baseball team, honored as the No. 8 right-handed pitcher in Pennsylvania by Perfect Game... also named Team MVP of the Episcopal football team (tight end and defensive lineman), and was honored as first-team all-league and all-area at TE and DL.

Off the Field in Happy Valley: Selected Academic All-Big Ten, 2019-2021... named 2021 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar... majored in supply chain and information systems, graduating with his bachelor's degree in May 2021... accepted to Penn State's Smeal College of Business to pursue his master's degree in corporate finance.
