TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a 6-game set at Somerset.

LAST TIME OUT: Somerset picked up a second straight win over Altoona by smashing 3 home runs. Abrahan Gutierrez accounted for 3 hits and 3 runs batted in in a 5-4 defeat.

FATHER ABRAHAN: In place of the promoted Henry Davis, Altoona welcomed C Abrahan Gutierrez to the roster for their series at Richmond. Gutierrez reached base safely in 6-of-7 games played including 3 2B, 2 HR and 6 RBI, including a gametying 2-run homer on Sunday, June 11 to aid Altoona to a 5-4 comeback win in 10 innings. Gutierrez was acquired from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for LHP Braeden Ogle in July of 2021 and the two worked as the battery on Friday, June 9.

COMEBACK KIDS: Altoona picked up 3 wins in their series at Richmond and each time rallied from a deficit after 7 innings.

PEGGY'S POP: Infielder Liover Peguero enters play on June 14 as one of the league's top hitters this month, he is T-17th in the Eastern League batting average with a .317 mark and reached base safely in 12 straight games (5/31 - Present).

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Wednesday, June 14, Altoona has struck out 464 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 5th-fewest in minor league baseball. In their series at Richmond beginning on June 4, the Curve struck out 62 times (including 4 games with 10 or more) one shy of a season-high in a six-game series.

WE'LL TAKE TWO: Altoona is 3rd among all Double-A teams with 55 double plays turned.

A BID FOR THE AGES: Altoona right-hander Jared Jones carried a no-hit bid into the 7th inning on Thursday, June 8 at Richmond. Jones allowed just one walk and hit one batter in his first six innings before Brandon Martorano swatted a solo homer to left field to leadoff the 7th inning. <u>Jones is now ranked as the No. 89 prospect in all of minor league baseball ac</u>cording to Baseball America.

HAMMERING HANK HEADS TO INDY: C Henry Davis, who had at least one hit in 17-of-22 games in May and had his first two career multi-homer games was promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on Tuesday, June 5. <u>Davis' .980 OPS is 3rd-best among all</u> Double-A players and he reached base safely in 37-of-41 games with Altoona.

PROSPECT PARTY: The Curve roster features several top Pirates prospects according to MLB Pipeline led by No. 6 INF Liover Pequero, No. 11 RHP Jared Jones, No. 17 OF Matt Gorski, No. 20 RHP Kyle Nicolas, and No. 23 OF Matt Fraizer.

THE PATRIOTS ARE THE YANKEES?: Fresh off an Eastern League championship in just their second season of play as the Yankees Eastern League affiliate, Somerset enters the series in the thick of the First Half Championship race. Their roster Pereira, No. 5 INF Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Richard Fitts, No. 9 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, and No. 13 RHP Clayton Beeter.

A PATRIOT ON THE 'SET: Yoendrys Gomez takes the ball for the Patriots tonight. Gomez has tossed 8.2 scoreless innings in 3 starts this year. Gomez signed for \$50,000 out of Venezuela in 2016 and was added to the Yankees 40-man roster this past off-season. He is ranked as the No. 9 prospect in the system by MLB Pipeline.
