### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha won 10 of 15 from May 9 to 24 but have gone 5-11 in the last 16 games since May 25.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Omaha has been under .500 following 40 of their last 41 games (since April 24) and the Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days at or above .500.

#### COMEBACK KIDS

- The Storm Chasers have 18 comeback wins this season, tied for the 7th-most in the International League and tied 10th at the Triple-A level.
- Omaha previously had a stretch of 10 wins (May 13 to June 4) that were all comeback wins (games the team won despite trailing at some point in the game).
- On the flip side, Omaha has lost 19 games in which the team led, tied 3rd-most in the league and tied 6th-most in Triple-A ... the Storm Chasers have led at some point in 7 of their last 12 losses, including for the first 8.5 innings on Sunday in Columbus and by 7 runs for nearly half of that game.
- In the last 31 games (since May 9), Omaha is 15-16 ... they have trailed at some point in 11 of 15 wins and led at some point in 9 of 16 losses, meaning 20 of Omaha's last 31 games have been a comeback win for one of the two teams ... in the stretch since May 9, 10 of 15 wins have been decided by 3 runs or less, while 12 of 16 losses have been decided by 3 runs or less ... 12 of the 31 games have been decided by 1 run.

#### WHAT HAPPENS IN OMAHA...

- This week, the Storm Chasers welcome the Pacific Coast League's Las Vegas Aviators to Werner Park for the first interleague series in the ballpark's history.
- These games mark the first visit to Werner Park by a PCL team since Omaha joined the International League in 2021 ... the last PCL team to play at Werner Park was the Round Rock Express, from August 30 to September 2, 2019.
- This week also marks the first time Las Vegas has played in Omaha since August 10-13, 2019 - during the Aviators' first season affiliated with the Athletics - when Las Vegas took 3 of 4, with Omaha's lone win coming on a **Kelvin Gutiérrez** walk-off single in the 10th inning on August 11 for a 4-3 victory.
- Las Vegas joined the PCL in 1983 and played alongside Omaha in the league from 1998 through 2019 ... this week marks the Aviators' 7th visit to Werner Park ... from 2005 to 2019, the clubs met in one 4-game series per season, alternating home ballparks annually ... while Omaha has not played a regular season game in Las Vegas since 2017, the Chasers did participate in the 2024 Triple-A National Championship Game at Las Vegas Ballpark.
- This is the second straight year the Storm Chasers have participated in Triple-A interleague play and the first of two interleague series on the schedule this season ... Omaha lost 5 of 6 at Salt Lake from May 20-25 last year ... the Chasers return to Salt Lake City July 21-26.

#### CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

- Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.
- Omaha's 83.5% success rate (71-for-85) ranks tied 4th in the IL and tied 7th in Triple-A ... however, the team has the 11th-most steals in the 20-team IL.
- John Rave** leads Omaha in steals (16) ... **Gavin Cross** has 12 steals in as many tries, the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... **Drew Waters** has 8 steals in as many tries and **Peyton Wilson** has stolen 7 bases.

#### OMAHA'S FINEST

- A trio of the hottest hitters in the International League come from Omaha's lineup.
- Outfielder **Matthew Lugo** reached base in his first 6 games played with the Storm Chasers ... he is 8-for-24 (.333) with 7 extra-base hits (4 doubles, 3 homers) and 10 RBI ... he's 7th among Triple-A players in RBI since June 4.
- Thursday, **Abraham Toro's** 12-game hitting streak came to an end, tied for Omaha's longest of the year ... from May 24 to June 9, he hit .404 (19-for-47) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 8 RBI and a 1.004 OPS.
- Kameron Misner** was recalled by the Royals Wednesday after being named the IL's Player of the Week for the week of June 1-7, as he went 10-for-24 (.417 average) at the plate in Columbus ... he had 3 doubles and 5 home runs for a Minor League-leading 28 total bases, with 10 RBI and 8 runs scored ... he led Triple-A last week with a 1.167 slugging percentage and 1.648 OPS.

TODAY'S APPEARANCE

- Henry Williams is making his **5th start** this year with the Storm Chasers, his **6th Triple-A appearance** and his **13th overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **4th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Williams' 1st career outing against the Aviators ... he has 4 previous starts against Athletics affiliates, appearing in 2 games against Single-A Stockton in 2023 while with the Lake Elsinore Storm in the Padres organization, and 2 games against the High-A Lansing Lugnuts in 2024.

HENRY'S HUNCH

- ROAD TO OMAHA:** Williams was assigned to Omaha on May 12 for his second stint with the Storm Chasers after making his Triple-A debut last May with 2 starts (from May 27 to June 5) ... in 20 appearances (18 starts) after returning to Double-A, he posted a 4.16 ERA (45 ER in 97.1 IP) for the Naturals.
- STRENGTH AND STAMINA:** Williams got off to a hot start in 2026, allowing 2 earned runs or less while going 5.0+ innings in 4 of his last 6 starts at Double-A ... following his stretch with Omaha in 2025, Williams went back to NW Arkansas (AA) and pitched 5.0+ innings in 13 of his last 18 starts at Double-A.
- HOMERUN HURTING:** Much of the damage off Williams in Triple-A this season has come on the long ball ... he has allowed 9 home runs (all solo homers) in just 5 outings for a 3.92 HR/9 that ranks 2nd-highest at the Triple-A level (min. 20.0 IP) ... homers represent 50% (9 of 18) runs he's allowed with Omaha.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, JUNE 7 @ COLUMBUS

- Made his 2nd start of the week against the Clippers, throwing his second quality start of the season, his first career quality start in Triple-A ... threw a career-high 99 pitches, the most by an Omaha pitcher in a game this year ... worked a 1-2-3 inning in the 1st and threw a scoreless 2nd before allowing a solo homer to Nolan Jones to open the 3rd ... threw scoreless 4th and 5th innings, with a stretch of 7 straight batters retired between the 4th and 6th ... allowed solo homers in the 6th to Gabriel Arias and Ralphy Velazquez, but finished the inning without allowing another run ... did not come out for the 7th.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025**
- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made 2 starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1) and tied 6th in strikeouts (106).
  - Opened the year with the Naturals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.
  - In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts
- MINOR LEAGUE CAREER**
- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April 2025.
  - Split the 2023 season between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with San Diego's Single-A affiliate, the Lake Elsinore Storm, but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies.
  - Made his professional debut at the start of the 2023 season with Lake Elsinore after San Diego drafted him in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Duke University ... made 12 starts for the Storm before his trade to the Royals, working a 5.74 ERA (27 ER in 42.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts for Lake Elsinore ... missed the 2022 season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.
- MISCELLANEOUS**
- Attended Duke University (2019-2021), where he appeared in 9 games (7 starts) over 3 seasons with the Blue Devils (ACC), going 3-3 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER in 37.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts ... only pitched one full season in Durham (2021) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (2020) and Tommy John surgery in December 2021, keeping him out of action his junior year (2022).
  - Lettered in both baseball and basketball all 4 years at Darien High School (CT) ... was a team captain for the basketball team his senior season.
  - Father David played collegiate baseball at Davidson College from 1987 to 1991.
