WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Single-A Fredericksburg jumped on Salem (BOS) last night, winning by a score of 10-2...LF **NICK PEOPLES** reached base four times in the win, going 3-for-4 with a double, a walk, and three runs scored.

R FLEW THE COOP: Looking to move one step closer to an International League first half title, Rochester used an 11-run sixth inning to blow open a close game and cruise past the Toledo Mud Hens, 14-1, on Saturday night...C **HARRY FORD** led the way with a home run, a double, and three RBI, while the Red Wings sent 17 batters to the plate during their decisive sixth-inning outburst...all nine hitters in Rochester's lineup scored a run, and five different players logged a multi-hit performance...with a chance to return to the postseason for the first time since 2013 and become the second Nationals affiliate to clinch a first half title in 2026 (Single-A Fredericksburg), the Red Wings will send LHP **JACKSON KENT** to the mound for the first half finale this afternoon, once again against Mud Hens RHP Troy Watson.

R WIN. AND. IN.: With last night's Red Wings win, combined with Memphis's 17-3 loss to Nashville, Rochester is back into first place in the International League first half based on winning percentage...a victory this afternoon clinches the first half title, home field advantage in the IL Championship Series, and their first playoff bid in 13 years...the Red Wings last playoff-clinching win came on 9/2/2013 in a 13-3 rout of Scranton/WB, when MLB veteran Eduardo Escobar logged four extra-base hits (HR, 3 2B) and drove in five runs to lead the way.

R ACTION JACKSON: Taking the mound to start things off for Rochester this afternoon will be LHP **JACKSON KENT**, making his sixth Triple-A start with 199 career strikeouts under his belt...the southpaw took the loss in Tuesday night's series opener, logging 4.2 innings while allowing two earned on two hits, with six strikeouts and a pair of walks...Kent ranks sixth, and is one of nine qualified pitchers in full-season Minor League Baseball with a WHIP under 1.00 this season (.95) alongside RHP **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** (.9th, 0.99)...he also leads all Nationals MiLB pitchers with a .187 BAA, and ranks third with a 3.11 ERA (19 ER/55.0 IP) in 12 starts between Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg...since the start of June, Red Wings starters lead all Triple-A staffs, and rank eighth in full-season MiLB in batting average against (.206), rank second in Triple-A in WHIP (1.13, 9th in full-season MiLB), and sixth (25th in full-season MiLB) in ERA (3.88, 27 ER/62.2 IP)...

R In three starts following a team win with Rochester and Harrisburg this season, Kent boasts' a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP) with 18 strikeouts, four walks, a 0.76 WHIP and .155 BAA.

R RISP-Y BUSINESS: 11 of the Red Wings 14 runs last night came in one inning...Rochester sent 17 men to the plate in the sixth, logging 10 hits and 11 RBI while drawing five walks...this was the Red Wings highest-scoring frame since a 13-run, third-inning outburst against the Mud Hens in Toledo on 5/7/2000...it also marked the club's first double-digit inning since 5/5/2015 at IND, and is the first time doing so at home since 6/7/2010 (vs. TOL)...they are the third International League team since 2004, and first since Syracuse on 5/7/2024 (19), to send at least 17 men to the plate in one inning...

R Rochester went 7-for-10 with RISP last night, their highest batting average (.700) in a single game (min. 10 AB w/ RISP) since at least 2004.

R BUILT FORD TOUGH: C **HARRY FORD** connected on a pair of extra-base hits for the second time this season (5/22 at WDR), going 2-for-4 with his second homer of the season, eighth double, three RBI and a pair of runs scored...the homer traveled 417 feet and came off the bat at 102.4 MPH, his farthest home run at the Triple-A level since a 443-foot shot on 5/29/2025 as a member of Tacoma (SEA)...across six Saturday games this season, Ford is hitting .333 (7-for-21) with both of his home runs, a .667 SLG, and 1.148 OPS.

R FRANK(LY) SPEAKING: LF **CHRISTIAN FRANKLIN** broke the Red Wings' early dry spell last night, knotting the contest at one run apiece in the bottom of the fourth with a 380-foot bomb to right field...the University of Arkansas product registered an efficient outing in the 14-1 victory, going 2-for-3 at the plate alongside a pair of runs and walks each...over 11 Saturday games this season, Franklin is hitting .310 alongside nine runs and an SLG and OBP of .452 and .431, respectively...the 26-year-old has recorded a hit in nine out of 14 games in June, with three separate multi-hit performances over the month.

R Since his Triple-A debut on 3/28/25 with Iowa, Franklin leads the International League with 124 walks.

R HOUSING HITS: 3B **BRADY HOUSE** put on a show in last night's dazzling win over Toledo, recording a team-high four RBIs while going 2-for-4 at the plate...the Georgia native took part in a dominant sixth inning with both an RBI double and single, and has now recorded a pair of multi-hit performances in this week's series against TOL...

R House holds the highest batting average (.400), OBP (.417), SLG (.771) and OPS (1.188) of any Red Wing in day games this season. (min. 35 AB).

R PHILLIP'N GOOD: 2B **PHILLIP GLASSER** joined the fun in last night's offensive victory over Toledo, going 2-for-4 at the plate with two singles, a pair of runs, and an RBI...this marks the infielder's third consecutive multi-hit performance and sixth straight game recording at least one hit...the showing also extended his run streak to five and on-base streak to 13, the first of which is tied for the third-longest active run streak in the International League...the Ohio product is currently batting .302 (26-for-86) during home games, second on the Wings this season only behind teammate **YOHANDY MORALES** (.326)...through the beginning of June, Glasser ranks third on the team in RBI (10) behind Morales (14) and **SEAVAR KING** (11)...

R Glasser is batting .412 (14-for-34) during Sunday contests going into today's final game before the end of the first half of IL play.

R MOR(ALES) LIFE: 3B **YOHANDY MORALES** was one of three Red Wings to record a home run in the team's explosive win last night, as the Miami native smashed a 445-foot moonshot over the video board in left center-field in the bottom of the eighth for the game's final run...he now has a career-high, and team-leading 16 homers this season, 7-7th most in the International League...the 24-year-old continues to spearhead Rochester in its playoff push, currently holding a team lead in batting average (.325), OPS (.964), runs scored (53), and OBP (.395)...the former Nationals' second-round pick went 2-for-5 last night as part of a month of June where he has recorded four separate multi-hit performances...

R Morales is slashing .353/.417/.541 alongside 16 RBI and five home runs in day games this season.

Entering his third professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the fourth round of the 2024 MLB Draft, out of the University of Arizona...named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/13/2025 with High-A Wilmington.

- Made his fifth start with Rochester on 6/16....on 6/10 he turned in his second quality start of 2026, and first as a Red Wing (6.0 IP, 1 ER)...has a road ERA of 1.01 (3 ER/26.2 IP) across six starts with Triple-A Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg, with a 0.79 WHIP and .152 BAA.
- Kent ranks sixth, and is one of nine qualified pitchers in full-season Minor League Baseball with a WHIP under 1.00 this season (0.95).
- Leads all Nationals MiLB pitchers with a .187 BAA, and ranks third with a 3.11 ERA (19 ER/55.0 IP) in 12 starts between Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...made seven starts with the team to start the season, logging a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with 38 strikeouts and eight walks, a 0.88 WHIP and .176 batting average against...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 5/21 for his Triple-A debut two days later.
- At the time of his promotion to Rochester, he led the Eastern League (min. 25.0 IP) in WHIP, held a share of the league-lead in fewest runs allowed (8), and ranked fourth in batting average against, H/9 (5.58) and K/BB (4.75)...turned in at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs in each of his last three starts, and four of his last five.
- Split his first professional season between High-A Wilmington (18 GS), and Double-A Harrisburg...combined to log a 4.61 ERA (63 ER/123.0 IP), with 132 strikeouts, 38 walks, a 1.22 WHIP and .243 batting average against.
- Began the season with High-A Wilmington...set career-highs with 7.2 innings pitched and 11 strikeouts on 5/6 vs. Hudson Valley (NYY)...turned in 6.0 scoreless innings in his final start with the team on 8/5, and was transferred to Harrisburg on 8/12 for his Double-A debut.
- Turned in at least 5.0 and struck out at least five batters in five of his six starts at Double-A.

- Among all pitchers in the International League, he is tied for fourth with five wins and tied for seventh with 72 strikeouts in 49.1 IP.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
- Ranked among qualified Nationals Minor League pitchers with a .186 BAA (2nd), 104 strikeouts (2nd), 1.08 WHIP (3rd), 104.0 innings pitched (4th), and a 3.28 ERA (5th).
- Began the season with High-A Wilmington...transferred to Double-A Harrisburg on 5/23, and Triple-A Rochester on 8/6.
- Matched his career-high three times with 7.0 innings pitched (4/23, 5/17, 6/19)...set a career-high with 10 strikeouts in game one of a doubleheader on 4/12 against Hub City (TEX).
- Across seven appearances (6 GS) from 6/8-7/27 with Double-A Harrisburg, allowed just five earned across 39.2 innings (1.13 ERA) while holding batters to a .163 BAA.
