ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn held off Greensboro for a 6-5 win, holding on in the late innings after scoring six-straight times to begin the game. INF Jose Peroza and C Jose Mena each hit solo home runs, and Brooklyn ran Greensboro starter RHP Santiago Florez from the game with a four-run second inning. LHP Nick Zwack earned his fourth straight victory, but snapped his scoreless streak at 29 innings. Grasshoppers SS Francisco Acuna doubled twice and scored twice.

**GREEN AROUND THE GILLS:** For the first time ever, the Greensboro Grasshoppers and the Brooklyn Cyclones play against each other. Prior to the realignment in Minor League Baseball ahead of the 2021 season, the Cyclones were part of the New York Penn League at Short Season Class A, while Greensboro has been part of the South Atlantic League since 1979. Pittsburgh has had an affiliate with Greensboro since 2019. Prior to that, the Miami Marlins were with Greensboro from 2003-2018 and the Yankees from 1990-2002. Baseball in Greensboro dates back to the early 1900s.

**NIC KNOWS:** C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering three times in his past 11 games -- the best home run stretch of his career. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .397 OBP and a .871 OPS, reaching in 16 of his past 18 games.

**PEROZA POP:** INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 23 total bases in his past 11 games with four doubles, one triple, and two home runs.

**HELP! I NEED SOMEONE:** Brooklyn ranks 118 out of 120 Minor League teams with 301 runs scored and 116 out of 120 teams in batting average (.215) and 115 out of 120 in home runs (46).

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted

vs. GREENSBORO: The Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate comes to Maimonides Park, setting up a matchup with Brooklyn for the first time in team history. Greensboro is in the North Division and hosts three of Pittsburgh's Top 30 prospects including former Mets minor leaguer No. 6 C Endy Rodriguez. He is joined by No. 11 RHP Jared Jones and No. 19 OF Hudson Head. The Grasshoppers play at First National Bank Field in Greensboro, North Carolina.

five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 39 home runs in the past 48 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms posted a 3.49 earned run average in 29 games with 16 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offenisvely, OF Alex Ramirez ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF Jaylen Palmer, No. 19 prospect 1B JT Schwartz, and No. 29 prospect INF Jose Peroza. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP Dominic Hamel, No. 16 prospect RHP Junior Santos, and No. 21 prospect Mike Vasil.

**FUTURE IS HERE:** C **Francisco Alvarez**, who is currently with Triple-A Syracuse, has been named the Mets representative at the 2022 Futures Game in Los Angeles during All-Star Week along with Triple-A INF/OF **Mark Vientos**. Alvarez, who was with the Cyclones in 2021, will participate in the game for the second consecutive year. The Mets No. 1 prospect homered in the 2021 game.

AS RELIEVER: Coming on as a piggybacker, Bryant has pitched in relief six times, posting a 3.63 ERA with a 23% strikeout rate and a 9% walk rate.

2021: Bryant spent 2021 with the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, breaking camp with the team in May. He made two starts before tearing his oblique in May. Did not pitch again until mid-August with the FCL Mets. Made one appearance with the Cyclones in September, allowing a career-high four home runs against Hudson Valley on September 8th.

**2019 SEASON:** Bryant put his name on the radar in 2019, leading the Cyclones pitching staff to a New York Penn League Championship over the Lowell Spinners. That season, Bryant was named to the mid-season All-Star team. Bryant struck out 75 batters in 75 innings and pitched a pair of seven-inning games for the Cyclones.
