KEEP IT ROLLING: Owners of the longest current winning streak in the Carolina League, the FredNats will try to make it five victories in a row tonight as they face the Salem Red Sox for games three and four of this six-game series. Today is a doubleheader after yesterday's game was rained out, and RHP Luke Young will start game one. RHP Austin Amaral makes his FredNat debut in game two. The 16th round draft pick from Stetson will try to continue a very strong pitching week for the FredNats in which they have allowed just one run and three hits in each of the first two games to Salem. He faces Salem righty Elvis Soto, who is making his second start for the Red Sox. He pitched four innings of scoreless, two-hit ball against Lynchburg last week.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats jumped on Salem starter Jose Ramirez for four runs in the first inning, and never looked back on the way to a 7-1 win. Andrew Pinckney had three hits and two RBI, and after starter Erik Tolman had to exit with an apparent leg injury before the 3rd inning, the FredNat bullpen pitched seven innings of one-run ball. Miguel Gomez went three innings, Mason Denaburg went three, and Juan Abreu finished off the win.

THE CALVARY HAS ARRIVED: After the promotions of Sammy Infante, Cortland Lawson and Matt Merrill to High-A Wilmington, the FredNats welcome seven new players today, all members of the Nationals' 2023 draft class. 2nd round pick Yohandy Morales (INF) out of Miami (FL) highlights the group that includes 4th round pick Andrew Pinckney (OF) from Alabama, 5th round pick Marcus Brown (INF) from Oklahoma State, 6th round pick Gavin Dugas (UTL) from LSU, 8th round pick Jared Simpson (LHP) from Iowa, 14th round pick Elijah Nunez (OF) from TCU, and 16th round pick Austin Amaral (RHP) from Stetson. Most of the group have played a couple games in the Florida Complex League before their promotions to Fredericksburg.

INSTANT IMPACT: The 2023 draft class had an instant impact through the first two games in Fredericksburg. Andrew Pinckney has five hits, two RBI and three runs scored through two games, Yohandy Morales has two hits and two RBI, Marcus Brown hit a two-run single in yesterday's game, Elijah Nunez has three runs scored, and Gavin Dugas got a base hit in his first action.

COLD BLOODED: FredNat closer Marquis Grissom Jr. has been a force at the back end of the bullpen, especially of late. In his last eight outings, Grissom has allowed one earned run in 12 1/3 IP, has nine strikeouts to just three walks, and the opponents are hitting just .152 against him (8-for-46).

TO THE MAX: Catcher Max Romero Jr. has had a great stretch at the plate since returning from the injured list in late June. In 15 games in July, Romero slashed .340/.453/.585 for an OPS of 1.038. He hit the first three home runs of his professional career, threw out about a third of baserunners from behind the plate, and drove in 15 runs in July to lead the team. He also had an RBI single last night in the first game of August.

CLOSE IT OUT: When the FredNat offense has given the team a late lead in games this year, the bullpen has done well to close the games out. Fredericksburg is 35-5 this year when leading after seven innings, and 33-3 when leading after eight innings. Seven different pitchers have recorded a save this year for the bullpen.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 33, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and ZSP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

TONIGHT'S START: Luke Young makes his ninth start in his last 10 outings for the FredNats tonight against the Salem Red Sox. Young's season, much like his fellow relievers, started out a bit rocky before turning around in May. Young worked to an ERA of 8.49 in April, but dropped it to 3.00 in five appearances throughout May.

SELF MADE: Young was very lightly recruited as a high-schooler, with his fastball sitting in the mid 80's. He elected to go to Midland Junior College in Texas, where he got the heater up to 96 MPH. That earned him an offer to pitch at Oklahoma State, but Young elected to sign with the Nationals.

LAST TIME OUT: Young delivered five innings of two-run ball at a time where the FredNats needed a strong start. Having dropped the first four games of the series, Young limited a red-hot Pelicans lineup to just six hits over five frames, and propelled the Nats to take both games on the weekend.

TONIGHT'S START: Austin Amaral is making his professional debut for the Fredricksburg Nationals tonight, after being selected in the 16th round of this year's MLB Draft.

ROAD TO FREDERICKSBURG: Amaral spent three years with the Stetson University Hatters, in Deland, FL under Steve Trimper. Austin began his Hatter career as a bullpen arm in 2021 and 2022, though he did make three spot starts in '22. Then just this past season, Amāral slotted into the Stetson rotation. He made 15 starts this year, striking out 82 batters in 76.1 innings.

In the summer circuit, Amaral spent part of one season in the Florida Collegiate Summer League, another year in the New England Collegiate Baseball League, and most recently in 2022 he pitched in the prestigious Cape Cod League with the Hyannis Harbor Hawks.
