RIDERS DROP SERIES FINALE IN ARKANSAS:

The Frisco RoughRiders hit a pair of home runs in their Sunday finale against Arkansas, but ultimately fell to the Travelers, 8-4. Designated hitter Kellen Strahm and third baseman Trey Hair each went deep in the loss for Frisco, as the Riders won four of six against Arkansas to take the series at Dickey-Stephens Park. Frisco (36-33) homered twice in the Sunday loss for just their fifth of the series against Arkansas (36-33). The RoughRiders rank second in the Texas League with 93 home runs on the season, trailing Tulsa (95) for most in the league. Riders starter Tim Brennan (1-2) gave up six earned runs on five hits in his three innings, as Arkansas homered three times in the first three innings on Sunday. Arkansas starter Levi Stoudt (5-4) gave up three earned runs on seven hits in his five innings. Despite the loss, the RoughRiders scored first on an RBI fielder's choice in the first inning, thanks to Blaine Crim. With runners at the corners, Crim hit a high ground ball left side of the infield and finished safe at first to score Dustin Harris from third and giving Frisco a 1-0 lead. Arkansas hopped on Brennan in the bottom of the first with a solo shot from Arkansas designated hitter Joe Rizzo. The Travelers took the lead in the second with two outs on a two-run bop from first baseman Connor Hoover. The early runs continued for Arkansas in the third on a three-run blast from center fielder Cade Marlowe to give the Travelers a 6-1 advantage. Frisco scored three unanswered runs to work their way back in Sunday's game, beginning with a two-out blast from Strahm in the top of the fifth frame. Strahm's two-run homer registered as his fourth longball of the season to cut into the deficit, 6-3. Hair's 13th home run came in the following inning with the bases clear and one out to dwindle the Arkansas lead to 6-4. Following an inning from reliever **Tai Tiedemann**, southpaw Grant Wolfram struck out four batters and walked none in his two innings of relief. Wolfram departed after giving up a leadoff single to begin the seventh, allowing Seth Nordlin to enter in relief with nobody out. Arkansas right fielder Jack Larsen homered on Nordlin's first pitch to put the Travs in front for good, 8-4.

WELCOME TO THE SECOND HALF:

Today marks the 70th game of the season and, thus, the second half of the season begins. The Riders just missed the playoffs by three games in the first half, with the San Antonio Missions winning the First Half South Division crown in the Texas League. Frisco has won seven of its last 10 games to pull close to the Missions, but over that same span, San Antonio is also 7-3. June has made the biggest difference as San Antonio has gone 15-7 in June, while the Riders have gone just 10-13. In the second half, the RoughRiders will try to win the division to make the playoffs for the first time since 2014. If San Antonio wins both halves, the playoff spot goes to the team with the best overall record (both halves combined) in the division

VS. THE HOOKS

In the last series the Riders played against Corpus Christi, a series split, there were 22 combined homers in the six games. Dustin Harris led the way with four homers for the Riders while also driving in 10 runs over his five games. David Garcia also belted two homers himself. The Riders averaged six runs per game over the six games with a .892 team OPS.

Trey Hair has been on fire in June. In the month, he is second in the Texas League in home runs with eight, while hitting .242/.296/.652. Hair's 13 home runs this season lead the club and tie a career-high. He hit his career-best 13 last season in 66 games while he has managed 13 in just 45 games this season so far. The 13 long balls are also the most in the organization.

Riders infielder Jonathan Ornelas has been on fire at the plate all season long, but recently, he has been even better. Over his last 13 games, Ornelas is hitting .382 (21-for-55)/.407/.564 with two doubles, a triple, two home runs, nine RBIs and five runs. This season, he leads the Riders with 28 multi-hit games and 13 games with three or more hits. Ornelas is leading all active hitters in Double-A with a .339 batting average while he is first in hits (87). His batting average is tied for the sixth-best in the minors and he is tied for second in hits in MiLB.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder Kellen Strahm started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Since May 27th, over his last 23 games, Strahm is hitting .390 (30-for-77)/.484/.558 with four doubles, three home runs, 14 walks, 17 runs and seven RBIs. His .390 average since May 27th is the fourth-best in Minor League Baseball among qualifiers. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .266 and his OPS from .528 to .774. In his last 29 games, he is batting .343/.440/.475/.915. Among those with at least 190 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is eighth in walk rate (16.1 percent).

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 4-19 when scoring three runs or fewer and 18-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 69 games, Frisco has hit 93 long balls (1.3 per game) which is the second-most in the Texas League and 12th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 186 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (topping 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). Out of their 69 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 47 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 22 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 10-12. **Trey Hair** has the team lead with 13, tied for seventh in the league.
