FRISCO, TX — A night after being blown out 12-2, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals responded Friday night in North Texas, exploding for 11 runs across the first three innings for an 11-2 win over the Frisco RoughRiders

- to even the series back up at two games each.

 Michael Massey started the scoring for Northwest Arkansas in the first inning, with his first home run of the year, a two-run shot to right field for a 2-0 lead.
- After walking in the first, Nick Loftin stepped to the plate with the bases loaded in the second inning again Frisco starting pitcher Cody Bradford, his former teammate at Baylor. On the first pitch, Loftin drilled a grand slam to center field to put the Naturals up 6-0, the team's first grand slam of the season and the Naturals' eighth home run this week.
- In the third inning, the Naturals tagged Frisco for five more runs. Robbie Glendinning doubled home Sebastian Rivero, then scored on a Jake Means double. Loftin singled home Logan Porter, and Massey doubled in Means and Maikel Garcia.
- Massey finished the day 2-for-4 with four runs batted in, while Loftin went 2-for-4 with five runs batted in, as well as a walk. Garcia, Loftin, Glendinning and Porter each scored two runs as well in the winning effort, while Garcia and Porter both drew a pair of walks.
- Starting pitcher Angel Zerpa, stretched his scoreless streak to 9.1 innings, throwing five scoreless on four hits and just one walk while striking out five, to improve his record to 1-1.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 5-4 all-time when playing on April 23

On April 23, 2012, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals, 5-0 at Arvest Ballpark, behind a strong start from Jake **Odorizzi**. Odorizzi allowed just four hits and one walk across 7.0 scoreless innings, while striking out 11, which at the time was a Naturals' single-game record, but is currently tied for Ith all-time in a single game. **Sean Keating** pitched the final two innings to earn his third save of the year, while **Sharlon Schoop** hit a homer in the 8th, his second long ball of the year.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder **Seuly Matias**.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher **Tyler Cropley**, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- RHP Alec Marsh started Tuesday and will go ahead on Sunday, April 24th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP **Drew Parrish** started Wednesday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP **Anthony Veneziano** started Thursday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa started Friday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and has drawn four walks across in his last three games, is tied for the lead in the Texas League with 14 walks.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 61 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 28 times, for a cool .459 on-base percentage (14 hits + 14 walks) ... his OBP ranks sixth in the league and is the best among qualified Naturals hitters ... he is the only Natural that has reached base in all 13 games this season and one of just two players in the Texas League with a 1213game reached base streak this year, along with San Antonio's Esteury Ruiz.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leader in many categories, including 6th in on-base percentage (.464), tied 1st in walks (14) and tied 3rd in
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia has gone hitless in his last three games and is 0 for his last 11 at the plate, with four walks.

STREAKY STARTS

While Maikel Garcia is the only Naturals hitter that has reached base at least once in all 13 games the team has played, he is not the only Natural that has reached base in every game they have played.

- SS **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in all <u>13 games</u> he's played started the season hitting .298 (14-for-47) with 2 doubles and 14 walks, giving him a .459 on-base percentage.
- INF **Robbie Glendinning** has reached base in all <u>10 games</u> he's played started the season hitting .233 (7-for-30) with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 11 walks, giving him a .452 on-base percentage.
- Prior to Tuesday, INF/OF Nate Eaton and 2B Michael Massey had both reached base in all eight games they'd played this season and OF Tucker Bradley had reached base in all six games he'd played to start the season, but all three of those streaks ended Tuesday as Eaton, Massey and Bradley all failed to reach base ... pinch-hitting in the 9th inning on Tuesday and striking out, Bradley's team-best six-game hitting streak ended as well.

SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

On April 9, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: **Scott Barlow**, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.




