LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox were shut out on Saturday night 4-0 from The Diamond. Richmond starting lefty John Michael Bertrand and righty Wil Jensen combined to retire the first 22 Bowie batters on the night. Adrian Sugastey and Dilan Rosario both hit their first Double-A homers off right-hander Kyle Brnovich to take a 4-0 lead after the fifth. Brnovich came in after starting right-hander Brandon Young pitched three perfect innings with seven strikeouts in his return from the injured list. The Baysox threatened in the eighth after a Frederick Bencosme walk and singles by TT Bowens and Connor Pavolony but Collin Burns and Anthony Servideo both struck out to end the frame.

SIZING UP THE FLYING SQUIRRELS

The Flying Squirrels completed their first series win of the season after previously splitting their last two series against Akron and Harrisburg. Richmond is hoping to make the postseason for a third year in a row after falling to eventual 2023 Eastern League champion Erie last year. Richmond's roster includes six of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), LHP Reggie Crawford (No. 8), OF Grant McCray (No. 13), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 20), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 24)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Carson Ragsdale gets the start for Richmond today. The 25-year-old is in his first season with Richmond, makes his fifth start of the year and his second of the series. Ragsdale got the start on Tuesday and threw four scoreless innings before giving up a two-run homer to John Rhodes in the fifth, which knocked him out of the game. He finished the day throwing 4.1 innings allowing two runs on five hits with four walks and five strikeouts in a no-decision. Last year, Ragsdale spent the season in High-A Eugene where he struck out 42 batters over 27.2 innings before missing the rest of the season due to injury.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** had his 15-game on-base streak come to an end last night after going 0-for-4. The Orioles No. 7 prospect was one game away from matching his career-long on-base streak set back in 2022 with Single-A Delmarva. Beavers still owns the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League and has already surpassed his season-long on-base streak from last season at 12 games, while with High-A Aberdeen. The 22-year-old is fifth in the league in OBP (.419).

BOWENS IS BACK

1B **TT Bowens** continues to perform well at the plate to start the season after only playing 47 games last year with the Baysox due to injury. Bowens is tied for second in the league in RBI with 18, along with Reading's Carson Taylor. The 26-year-old ranks eighth in slugging percentage (.561) and eighth in OPS (.936).

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has barreled up the ball since arriving the Double-A level to begin the season. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is ninth in the Eastern League in batting average (.314), third in runs (15), fifth in hits (22) and fourth in total bases (36). The middle infielder has hits in 13 of his first 18 Double-A contests, including seven multi-hit contests. Bencosme has also already hit three homers on the season after hitting only two all of last year in High-A Aberdeen. Only 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

SETH ON THE SLAB

RHP **Seth Johnson** gets the starting nod for the Baysox today. This will be Johnson's fifth career start with the Baysox and his fourth of the year. The 25-year-old got the start on Tuesday and lasted only 2.1 innings, giving up five hits and five runs (two earned) with three walks and one strikeout in the loss. The Orioles No. 10 prospect hasn't made it past the third inning in his first two road starts. Johnson, who is on the Orioles 40-man roster, hasn't pitched a full season since 2021 after undergoing Tommy John surgery in 2022 and rehabbing from the surgery all of 2023. He fanned 115 batters in 93.2 innings in his last full season with High-A Charleston in 2021 while in Tampa Bay's organization.

CATCHER IN THE RYE

C **Silas Ardoin** has been arguably the best defensive catcher in the league, thus far. The 23-year-old has caught a league leading 11 base runners stealing and has allowed only six stolen bases, the lowest total amongst the top 10 Eastern League catchers. Ardoin has also not committed an error behind the plate nor has he allowed a passed ball. Last season, he caught seven out of 30 base stealers in his first 26 games at Double-A.

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster. Has yet to reach the third inning in two road starts. Delivered four shutout innings in home debut on 4/17 vs ALT. In most recent start on 4/23 @ RIC, gave up five runs but only two were earned in loss.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
