Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound tonight, looking to avoid the first 3G losing streak since 4/29-5/1 vs. Toledo.

Omaha will counter with RHP **Ben Sears**. Columbus is 28-13 (.683) versus right handers this year. Sears has pitched against Columbus once in his career, getting the start Wednesday night (ND, 2.1IP, 3H, 2R, 2ER, 1BB, 1K).

vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus has lost 47 of the last 74 regular season games against Omaha, dating to 5/5/22. Of those 74G, the Clippers are 9-45 (.167) when they allow at least four runs to Omaha, while going 18-2 (.900) when they hold the Storm Chasers to three or fewer. Individually, **Petey Halpin** has played 17G against Omaha in his career, hitting .354 (23x65) with 2HR and 11RBI.

Getting There

With 4PA tonight, **Cooper Ingle** will qualify for rate statistics in the IL and his current .460OBP would pace the circuit. Ingle has slumped to a .292OBP over the last 10G (8x41, .195, 6BB), but since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, he has the best OBP in the IL (.429, +21 points on **Johnathan Rodriguez**) and the 4th most walks (56). As a catcher, Ingle has a 1.292OPS (.464OPS in 10G at DH).

Arias Rehab

Gabriel Arias joined the Clippers on rehab Thursday, coming back from a strained left hamstring (on the shelf since 4/7, transferred to 60-day on 5/29). Arias hit .200/.250/.433 with 2HR and 4RBI in 10G with Cleveland prior to injury (5x14 in 5G after 1x16 start). All time with Columbus, Arias has played 240G, collecting 33HR and 112RBI (currently on second career rehab stint; 4G from 7/18-7/24/25).

Brito is Back

Juan Brito is hitting .400 (12x30) over his last 8G, since going hitless in each of 5G from 5/20-5/27 (18AB). Brito has but one double in that time though (just a pair in the last 23G, had eight in first 17G), giving him 57 in his Columbus career (four from the franchise top 25). All of Brito's homers (4) have come from the right side of the plate (41AB) and on the weekend (82AB; 74AB Monday-Thursday).

Watch Out for Watson

Kahlil Watson is hitting .285/.371/.569 with 20XBH and 31RBI in his last 37G (1XBH in first 12G), including 7HR and 19RBI since 5/10 (t-5th most HR in the IL during that span, t-9th in RBI). However, with RISP this year, he is hitting just .172 (10x58). Watson's walk last Saturday snapped a 15G streak without, as he has 2BB and 28K in his last 18G (80PA; was 2nd in the IL with 30BB in 31G through 5/9).

Under the Radar

Petey Halpin saw his career best hit streak snapped at 14G Thursday (.300, 18x60, 4/12-4/28) and his on base streak went down at 16G (.359OBP, 4/10-4/28). At the time of his promotion last month, he led the IL with 105 runs scored since his debut (3/28/25). Despite the month away, Halpin enters tonight at #6 on that list, nine off the lead (has scored 11 times in last 13G with Columbus).

Gaining Steam

George Valera owns a 19G on base streak since 5/5 (.417OBP). Over the first 8G of the streak, Valera had a .250OBP (36PA; hit .182, 6x33 with 3BB and 11K), but he has over reached half the time in the last 11G (.542OBP in 48PA; hitting .389, 14x36 with 12BB and 5K). Valera's K-rate is down considerably this season (16.1% from 26.5% in first four seasons with Columbus), with 4K in his last 43PA.

Half Season, Full Huff

Tonight will mark **Kody Huff's** 50th game of the year, nearly halfway to his career high of 101G in 2025 (205PA this year, 50.3% of career high: 405PA last year). Last night's HR established a new career high (8, had 7HR with Akron in 2024), while giving him 41RBI (career best is 47RBI last year). His 36 runs are 80% to his personal best, his 51 hits are 62% of the way there and his 33K are 32% to a high.

Snapping Out of It

After being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** hit .165/.267/.215 with 0HR and 8RBI over his next 22G (4/21-5/23; 39K in 90PA, 43%). Starting with game two vs. Louisville on 5/23, in which he snapped an 83AB homerless streak with a grand slam, he is slashing .296/.321/.444 with 1HR and 6RBI over the course of 28PA (8K, 29%).

This Date in Clipper History

6/6/2024

Having gone hitless in his first 4AB of a 23-5 win at Indianapolis, **Johnathan Rodriguez** hammered a 2-run homer in the 8th inning. He followed up with a 3-run shot and a grand slam in the 9th, as the Clippers scored a franchise record 12 times in the frame.

Bryan Lavastida also went deep twice in the 9th (solo, 2-run), marking the first time a Clipper homered twice in an inning since 1982 (**Steve**

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,436 to 1,380).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 85-81 (.512) in pitch reviews, with batters going 46-54 (.460) and pitchers/catchers going 39-27 (.591). They have run out of challenges in 33G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 844, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 87 through the first 60G (on pace for 216SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 20CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (50; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,934RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.38 through the first 60G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 163HR (nearly 20HR under the average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 9th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 32G this season (20-12, .625), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Kody Huff bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 419-433 (.492), 389-387 with Columbus (.501).

Workhorse

Allen is the only Clipper averaging over 80 pitches a start this season, at 87.3 (along with **Ryan Webb**, only pitchers to throw more than 90 in a game multiple times). Averaging almost 93 pitches per outing in the Majors last season, Allen hit triple digits six times (Columbus has not had a pitcher reach 100 since **Peyton Battenfield** on 9/2/22, 524G ago)

On Guard(ians):

In two stints in the Majors this season (27th man in a DH on 4/5 and a two day excursion from 5/24-5/25), Allen has appeared once for Cleveland, closing out the game on 5/25 vs. Washington (4.0IP, 5H, 0R, 0ER, 1BB, 7K). The game was his second in relief at the Major League level (once last season) and he has just 4G out of the bullpen in the minors (all on starter's rest, three piggybacking rehabbing Major Leaguers).

Stellar Support:

Through 9GS, the bullpen has graced Allen with a 1.43ERA in relief (37.2IP, 6ER), stranding two of four runners inherited. The defense has committed only 7E in Allen's starts, while the offense has put forward 6.0 runs per game. That all adds up to an 8-1 record for Columbus when he takes the hill.

Tough Split:

In his first 5GS (103BF), Allen recorded 32K (31%) against only 10BB (10%), while painting the zone with strikes on 63% of his pitches. Since the calendar flipped to May, however, he has made 4GS (87BF), watching his strikeout rate dip to 16% (14K) and his walk rate inflate (14%; strikes on 57% of pitches).

Inverse Split:

Lefties are posting a .953OPS off Allen this year, hitting .320 (8x25) with a pair of homers against only 6K (22%). From the right side, opposing hitters are still at an .869OPS with 5HR in 139AB and a 25% strikeout rate (40K).

Cleaning Up:

Opposing cleanup hitters have just one hit off Allen in 19AB this season, though the hit went over the wall (**Charles McAdoo**, 4/26 at Buffalo). Looking at the lineup as a whole, the top five in the order have slashed .235/.342/.408 with 3HR in 98AB against Allen, while batters 6-9 have hit .364/.427/.652 with 4HR in 66AB.
