WHAT A GAME!!! [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers advanced to the Midwest League Championship with a thrilling 7-6 win over the Quad Cities River Bandits in Game Two on Thursday night at Neuroscience Group Field](#)

in front of a franchise playoff record crowd of 4,428. Luke Adams had a two-out, RBI single in the bottom of the ninth to score Cooper Pratt and cap a three-run rally in the bottom of the ninth.

ROLLER COASTER: Adams gave Wisconsin a 2-0 lead with a two-run homer in the third. The River Bandits scored three runs with two outs in the top of the fifth. Jheremy Vargas tied the game with an RBI double in the bottom of the seventh. Quad Cities went back in front with a two-out, RBI double by Shervyen Newton in the eighth. Ramón Rodríguez tied the game again with another two-out, RBI double. The Bandits took the lead in the top of the ninth with two runs on a sacrifice fly and an error.

COMEBACK KIDS: Wisconsin loaded the bases against Ben Sears with no outs on a walk and two singles. Luis Lara drove in the first run with a fielder's choice. Pratt followed with a single to score the tying run, but Lara was thrown out at the plate trying to score the winning run. That set the stage for Adams' dramatics. Wisconsin had six walkoff wins during the regular season, including a game against Quad Cities on June 9 in which they scored four runs in the bottom of the ninth to win.

A NOTE ABOUT RUDY: Wisconsin starting pitcher Will Rudy struck out eight over 4-2/3 innings on Thursday to set a new professional single-game high.

PLAYING FOR THE PENNANT: This is Wisconsin's first appearance in the Midwest League Championship Series since the league moved up to the High-A classification. The Rattlers made the Championship Series in 1996, 1999, 2005, and 2012. Wisconsin won the pennant in 2012. The Appleton Foxes, the team that became the Rattlers in 1995, won eight Midwest League Championships from 1962-1994.

ABOUT THE LAKE COUNTY CAPTAINS: Lake County joined the Midwest League in 2010 from the South Atlantic League. They started out as the Columbus RedStixx in Georgia before moving to Eastlake, Ohio after the 2002 season. The Captains are the Midwest League affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The franchise has been affiliated with Cleveland since it was known as the Columbus Indians in 1991. Lake County won the Midwest League title in 2010 and lost to Kane County in the 2014 Midwest League Championship Series. They were the East Division Champions in 2022 and lost to the South Bend Cubs in the Midwest League Championship Series. Lake County went 77-53 during the 2024 regular season and qualified for the playoffs by winning the first half East Division title. They swept Dayton in the East Division Finals.

ABOUT THE GUARDIANS: Cleveland was the parent club of the old Appleton Papermakers in 1941, 1942, and 1946. Mike Garcia was the most notable Papermaker to play of the Indians. Cleveland's affiliation history in the Midwest League dates includes the Dubuque Packers from 1962-64 and Waterloo from 1977-1988 before the Captains.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#2), Yophery Rodriguez (#6), Luke Adams (#8), Luis Lara (#16), and Jadhier Areinamo (#21). Blake Burke (#15) is currently on the IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven Captains on their list of Cleveland prospects: Travis Bazzana (#1), Ralph Velazquez (#4), Angel Genao (#5), Jacob Cozart (#12), Alex Mooney (#23), Jake Fox (#26), and Matt Wilkinson (#30).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

LAST START: Birchard had lost at Cedar Rapids on [September 5](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with five walks and two strikeouts over three innings.

VS. LAKE COUNTY: Birchard has never faced the Captains prior to this evening. This will be the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians.

LAKE COUNTY STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RORIK MALTRUD: The Cleveland Guardians signed Maltrud as a non-drafted free agent on January 9, 2024.

HOLD THAT TIGER: Maltrud pitched one season at Missouri and was 1-2 with a save and a 5.73 ERA in twenty games – six starts. He had 65 strikeouts over 48-2/3 innings.

A LEFT TURN AT ALBUQUERQUE: Maltrud pitched two seasons at New Mexico State University. He was 4-6 with 85 strikeouts over 88 innings in 21 games – fifteen starts in his two seasons with the Aggies.

FAST MOVING: Maltrud started the 2024 season with Lynchburg, the Carolina League affiliate of the Guardians. He made twelve starts with the Hillcats, was 4-1 with a 2.38 ERA and 62 strikeouts over 53 innings before his promotion to Lake County on June 23.

WELCOME ABOARD: Maltrud made twelve starts with Lake County after the promotion and was 4-4 with a 4.53 ERA. He walked 22 and struck out 62 over 51-2/3 innings pitched for the Captains.

LAST START: Maltrud lost at Peoria on [September 8](#). He allowed seven runs on eight hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Maltrud has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.

THIS DATE IN TIMBER RATTLERS HISTORY

Brandon Macias was next, and he cracked a three-run home run to put the Rattlers up 6-3.
