LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo collected a pair of extra-base hits - a double and a triple - in addition to 4 RBI in Saturday night's win over Hudson Valley...Over the last 3 games against the Renegades, the 21 -year-old is 5 -for-11 (.455) at the plate with a run scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 6
RBI, and a walk...Over the course of the 2 -week homestand, Lugo has slashed $.324 / .419 / .459$ with a. 878 OPS in 11 games...The Dominican native has scored 2 runs, picked up 3 doubles, a triple, 6
RBI, and 5 walks during that span...Entering play on Sunday, Lugo's batting average is 84 points higher at home than the red (265 to 181) and his OPS in 260 pation
