Let's Play Two

Tonight, Reading continue a six-game homestand with the Altoona Curve, the double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It's the fourth and fifth of 12 matchups between the teams this season, one in Reading and another in Altoona. After this week, Reading travels to Altoona from July 18-23. In 2022, the teams split their series in Reading and Altoona took 4/6 in September to win the season series 7-5.

Slipped Away

Altoona won a pitchers' duel 3-2 Thursday night. After neither team scratched a run across in the first seven innings, Reading took a 1-0 lead on a RBI single from Wendell Rijo. But, Max Kuhns surrendered three runs to Altoona in the top of the ninth. The Fightin Phils threatened in the bottom of the inning to cut the deficit to one, but a game-ending double-play sealed the victory for the Curve.

Double Trouble

Thursday night, the R-Phils turned two double plays, which were just their sixth and seventh twin killings this season, through 18 games. Reading ranks last in the league in double plays turned, while their oppenent, the Altoona Curve, lead the Eastern League with 22 double plays this season.

Wonderful Wilson

Ethan Wilson's torrid return from the injured list continued Thursday night. Wilson went 1-3, with a double and run scored. His double hit off the lower part of the Redner's Event Center. That came after back-to-back games with home runs off the top of the new event center. Wilson now owns hits in his last four games and has reached base in seven-straight, dating back to opening weekend before going on the injured list.

Ranger Rehab

Phillies starter Ranger Suarez made the second-straight rehab start by a member of the Phillies, after Nick Nelson threw three innings on Wednesday night. Suarez looked solid, pitching two innings and striking out one Curve hitter. Suarez is expected to make 3-4 rehab starts before returning to the Phillies rotation. He was sidelined to open the season after experiencing forearm tightness in the World Baseball Classic.

Around the Organization

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies defeated the Houston Astros 3-1 last night in a rematch of last season's World Series. The two teams are back in action today at 5:10. A big game from former R-Phils Simon Muzziotti led Lehigh Valley to an 11-4 win over Jacksonville. Jersey Shore and Brooklyn were postponned and Clearwater's hot start continued with a 7-2 win over St. Lucie.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 29, 2009: At Reading, Vance Worley, Josh Shortslef and Sergio Escalona combine to shut out visiting Altoona, 2-0. Worley goes 7.0 innings for his second win, allowing just three hits and a walk while striking out seven.

Welcoming the Curve

The Altoona Curve enter tonight with a 9-8 record on the season. Altoona casually just took four-of-five games from the Bowie Baysox at home. Saturday's game between the teams was rained out. Prior to the Bowie series, the Curve had just won three of their first nine games to start the season. After this week, Altoona stays on the road for a six-game series at Richmond next week.

"Curve" Ball

Aaron Shortridge is slated to start game one for Altoona and Matt Eckelman will follow for game two. Shortridge is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA this season over four games (three starts). He last pitched on Sunday against Bowie, allowing just one earned run over six innings. Eckelman starts game two and its his first start of the season. Over five appearences, Eckelman has not allowed a run and just four hits over nine innings. Eckelman last threw on Tuesday against the R-Phils, going 1.1 innings of scoreless ball with three strikeouts.
