ABOUT SUNDAY: Hudson Valley stunned the Maimonides Park crowd with six runs in the top of the 10th inning in a 9-3 victory over the Brooklyn Cyclones to win the series four games to two. The Renegades earned the season split with Brooklyn, having won 16 of the 30. Renegades OF **Aaron Palensky** hit an opposite-field grand slam in extras. The Cyclones squandered a big chance to score with the winning run at third base in the ninth inning. C **Jose Mena** paced the offense with three hits and a home run. Despite 13 hits and four walks, the Cyclones stranded 15 men, going 3-for-19 with RISP.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 18 games remaining and three series: six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in third place at 1.5 games behind Hudson Valley who plays Hickory this week at Dutchess Stadium.

OLD BAY SEASONING: The last time the Cyclones played Jersey Shore, OF Alex Ramirez hit two home runs in a three-game weekend series after the MLB All-Star Break, going a whopping 8-for-13 (.615).

2021 CYCLONES TAKEOVER QUEENS: With Monday's promotion of RHP **Connor Grey** to the Mets roster, the Cyclones saw three 2021 members of the roster earn the callup. 3B **Brett Baty** has played with the big club since last Wednesday and RHP **Jose Butto** made his MLB debut Sunday in Philadelphia.

HOW RUDE!: In August, OF **Matt Rudick** has a whopping .421 on-base percentage and a .814 OPS over 16 contests. Rudick has been on base in 11 consecutive games and is hitting .295 (18-61). In the stretch, Rudick has raised his batting average from .205 to .228.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Per-**

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies High-A affiliate sits in last place in the North Division of the South Atlantic League at ShoreTown Ballpark in Lakewood, New Jersey. Against the BlueClaws, the Cyclones are 16-5. Jersey Shore hosts four of Philadelphia's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, including No. 8 OF Ethan Wilson, No. 14 INF Luis Garcia, No. 21 RHP Christian McGowan, and No. 27 INF Casey Martin.

oza has a OPS of .891 over his past 34 games with a 21-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 32 of the past 34 games, hitting .311 with a .407 OBP. The current active streak leader is Rome C **Tyler Tolve** who has a 25-game on-base streak.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half sixth-fewest in Minor League Baseball overall, having allowed 459 runs in 114 games (4.0 runs/game).

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 444 runs in 114 games (3.9 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and third-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

BRETT THE BAT: Former Brooklyn Cyclones 3B **Brett Baty** made his MLB debut Wednesday with the Mets in Atlanta, hitting a two-run home run in his first at-bat en route to a 9-7 Mets victory. Baty played with Brooklyn in 2019 and in 2021 and becomes the 91st former Cyclones player to make the major leagues. He is also the first from the 2019 Mets draft class to

NICE TO MEET ASKEW: Former Clemson Tiger Keyshawn Askew makes his first start against Jersey Shore and four overall appearance at High-A.

PROMOTION!: Askew made 13 appearances with Low-A St. Lucie and four starts, tossing 46.1 IP and posting a 1.93 earned run average. Askew struck out 64 batters and walked 19, allowing six hit batters and three home runs. In his final outing before the promotion, Askew struck out eight Palm Beach Cardinals on July 30th.

INJURED LIST STINT: Askew made four appearances with Low-A St. Lucie this spring before landing on the injured list, missing April 28-June 6.

MEET THE METS: The Mets selected Askew in the 10th round in 2021 out of Clemson University in the Atlantic Coast Conference, signing him for \$125K. Askew was one of six Tigers selected last year. Only Seattle SS James Parker was selected higher (eighth round).

COLLEGE: Was a weekend starter for Clemson in 2021, working his way back from missing the first 12 games of the season with a leg injury. Made a total of 21 starts and 33 appearances across three years with Clemson.
