**FINALLY 50:** The Omaha Storm Chasers snapped a five-game losing streak with a 3-0 shutout win over the Columbus Clippers on Saturday at Werner Park. **RHP Jackson Kowar** recorded his third quality start of the season, striking out nine over 6.0 scoreless innings. He faced two batters in the seventh inning before **RHP Dylan Coleman** entered, allowed a single to load the bases with zero outs, and escaped thanks to a double play by **1B Nick Pratto** and **C MJ Melendez** and a strikeout. **RHP Tyler Zuber** struck out two in a perfect ninth inning to earn the save. Pratto homered in the fourth, a 456-ft. blast for his third homer in as many games. It was Omaha's third shutout win of the season.

**POWER SURGE:** **1B Nick Pratto** homered for the third consecutive game on Saturday to become the fifth Storm Chaser this season to homer in three straight games. **INF/OF Ryan McBroom** homered in three straight games from 5/26-2/28 vs. IND. **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** from 6/8-6/10 @ STP, **INF Emmanuel Rivera** from 6/15-6/17 vs. LOU, and **C Nick Dini** from 8/5-8/7 @ COL. Pratto now has nine home runs at the Triple-A level and 24 total home runs this season, a mark that is tied for sixth in all of Minor League Baseball. With 22 doubles, five triples, and 24 home runs (51 XBH), Pratto is one of three players in the Royals' organization with 50+ extra base hits, joining Double-A Northwest Arkansas **1B Vinnie Pasquantino** (52) and **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** (50).

**ON THE MEND:** **SS Adalberto Mondesi** (strained left oblique) rejoined the Storm Chasers on Thursday for his third rehab assignment with the team this season. In seven games with Omaha from 8/3-pres., Mondesi is 0-for-18 with six strikeouts, including 0-for-13 during his initial five-game rehab stint from 8/3-8/10 before being returned to Kansas City. Mondesi has played 15 total rehab assignment games this season between Omaha (10 games) and Northwest Arkansas (five games). In 10 games with Kansas City across two stints, Mondesi is 13-for-36 (.361) with five doubles and four home runs. **RHP Kyle Zimmer** (neck/trap spasms) made his fifth rehab appearance of his current assignment on Thursday, taking the loss after allowing three runs on four hits in 1.0 innings. He has thrown 6.0 innings with seven strikeouts and two walks since joining the Chasers for a rehab assignment on 8/11 vs. IOW.

**DUAL THREATS:** The Omaha Storm Chasers continue to lead Triple-A East in both home runs (152) and stolen bases (110). **INF/OF Ryan McBroom** leads the team and is second in the league with 22 home runs, while **OF Edward Olivares** has 13, **OF Kyle Isbel**, **1B Nick Pratto**, and **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** have nine. Isbel leads the team and is fifth in the league with 21 stolen bases, while **INF Lucius Fox** has 13, **OF Edward Olivares** has 12, and **OF Rudy Martin** has eight. **OF Dairon Blanco** hit nine home runs and stole a league-best 32 bases prior to his promotion from Double-A Northwest Arkansas and now has 10 total home runs and 32 steals this season.

**20-20 VISION:** **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** is one of three players in Minor League Baseball (Romy Gonzalez - CWS, Anthony Volpe - NYY) with 20+ home runs and 20+ stolen bases in 2021. Witt Jr., the consensus No. 3 prospect in baseball per *Baseball America* and *MLB Pipeline*, has 25 home runs—third-most in Minor League Baseball—and 20 stolen bases this year, including nine home runs and six steals with the Storm Chasers. He is the first Kansas City Royals minor league player to record a 20/20 season since **OF Alex Gordon** hit 29 home runs and stole 22 bases for Double-A Wichita in 2006. Gordon earned Texas League Player of the Year and Baseball America Minor League Player of the Year honors. Through 28 games with the Storm Chasers, Witt Jr. is batting .286/.351/.597 with 10 doubles, nine home runs, 20 RBIs, and 27 runs scored.

**HOME RUN RACE:** **C MJ Melendez** is currently second in Minor League Baseball in home runs, trailing Miami Marlins prospect Griffin Conine (32). Melendez hit 28 home runs at the Double-A level and has four with the Storm Chasers since his debut on 8/11 vs. IOW while Conine hit 23 home runs at the High-A level and has nine with Double-A Pensacola. Melendez' father, Mervyl is the head baseball coach at FIU while Conine's father, Jeff, is an associate head coach at FIU. **OF Jeff Conine** played for Omaha in 1991, 1992 and 1998, hitting 20 home runs in 110 games with Omaha in 1992.

**FOR OMAHA:** **LHP Marcelo Martinez** makes his 11th start (12th appearance) with Omaha and second this week. He allowed five run on seven hits—including a season-high three home runs—in 5.0 innings on Tuesday. Martinez has completed 5.0+ innings in six of his 10 starts. Omaha is 2-8 when Martinez starts and 2-9 overall when he pitches.

**FOR COLUMBUS:** **RHP Heath Fillmyer**, who pitched for Omaha from in 2018 and 2019, makes his 11th start (15th appearance) for Columbus after tossing a scoreless inning in relief on 8/18 at Werner Park. Sunday is Fillmyer's first start at Werner Park since 8/8 vs. SL. Fillmyer tied a season high with 6.0 innings in his last start, allowing one run on four hits with a season-best eight strikeouts and one walk on 8/14 vs. TOL. He gave up six runs on six hits in 5.0 innings on 8/5 vs. OMA at Huntington Park. After being drafted by the Oakland Athletics in the 5th Round (162nd overall) of the 2014 MLB Draft, Fillmyer was traded with RHP Jesse Hahn to Kansas City on Jan. 29, 2018 in exchange for Brandon Moss, Ryan Buchter, and cash. Fillmyer made his Major League debut with Kansas City on June 24, 2018 vs. HOU, ultimately pitching in 29 games with the Royals between the 2018 and 2019 seasons.

- Struck out Triple-A high seven batters on 7/1 @ STP, tossing Triple-A high 5.2 innings and allowing only one run to earn first career Triple-A win
- Held Iowa to one run on two hits in 5.0 innings with six strikeouts on 6/25 @ IOW
- Gave up career-high eight runs on nine hits in Triple-A debut on 6/19 vs. LOU, exiting game with no outs in the third inning after allowing the first five batters to reach on leadoff walk and four straight hits, including a three-run homer Named Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week for June 1-7 after striking out nine batters without issuing a walk on 6/1 vs. TUL and pitching 1.1 scoreless innings on 6/6 vs. TUL before rain suspended the game
