YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the RubberDucks, 3-0, to open the 12-game road trip. Yordys Valdez opened the scoring with an RBI single in the third inning. Kahlil Watson led off the bottom of the fourth with a solo homer. Petey Halpin added an RBI single in the fifth to open a 3-0 lead. **Ryan Murphy** allowed three runs over five innings with no walks and four strikeouts. **Evan Gates** threw two scoreless innings out of the bullpen and struck out four, lowering his season ERA to 0.79. **Jose Cruz** pitched a 1-2-3 bottom of the eighth. Akron starter Tommy Mace picked up his third win of the year, throwing six scoreless innings with six strikeouts. Bradley Hanner pitched two innings and Jack Leftwich closed out the save in the ninth. It was the eighth consecutive win for the RubberDucks.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the second of a six-game series at Canal Park. The two teams split a series at The Diamond from April 9-14. Along with this series, the Flying Squirrels return to Akron for three games from July 19-21 following the All-Star Break. The RubberDucks return to Richmond from Sept. 3-8 for six games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 10-7 in their last 17 games after starting the season 1-4. Last week, they picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. The Flying Squirrels have gone 6-3 in their last nine games since April 20, including winning four straight from April 20-24. Dating back to Friday, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff has posted a league-best 1.80 ERA (7 ER/35.0 IP). They also lead the league in that span in WHIP (0.71) and BAA (.149).

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won eight consecutive games, the longest win streak by an Eastern League team this year. It is also their longest win streak since winning 11 in a row in August 2016 en route to winning the Eastern League championship. Last week, they picked up their first six-game sweep in franchise history, taking the entire series at Altoona. For the season, Akron's pitching staff leads the Eastern League in ERA (2.33), shutouts (5) and WHIP (1.17). Akron's roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including OF Chase DeLauter (No. 1), OF Petey Halpin (No. 14), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 18), 3B Dayan Fries (No. 19) and SS Kahlil Watson (No. 22). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes five Akron players, including DeLauters (No. 1), Watson (No. 14), Halpin (No. 15), Walters (No. 25) and Fries (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his fifth appearance and his fourth start of the season. He last pitched last Thursday at The Diamond against the Baysox and was charged with a loss after surrendering five runs over 3.1 innings. He faced the RubberDucks on April 13 in Richmond in his first start of the season and allowed three runs over three innings. Frisbee is in his fourth season pitching with Richmond and has gone 17-16 with a 4.89 ERA in 69 games, including 40 starts. Frisbee has 244 strikeouts in his Richmond career, which is fourth-most in team history. He also ranks third in franchise history (min. 150 IP) with 8.71 K/9. On May 13, 2021, Frisbee threw six perfect innings in a combined no-hitter with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo, the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history and the second overall no-hitter in team history. On August 10, 2022 at Portland, Frisbee set a single-game franchise record with 13 strikeouts and allowed one hit, a fourth-inning single by rehabbing Red Sox outfielder Kiké Hernández, over six scoreless innings. Last year, Frisbee spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-0 with a 4.54 ERA in 27 appearances, his first season working primarily as a reliever. Frisbee was selected by the Giants in the 15th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Rodney Boone makes his third start and fifth appearance of the season. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels on April 13 at The Diamond and allowed four runs over four innings in a no-decision with three runs scoring on a homer by **Logan Wyatt**. Boone last pitched last Thursday at Altoona and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to lower his season ERA to 2.95. Last year, he made 18 appearances (17 starts) for High-A Lake County and went 6-4 with a 4.95 ERA. Boone, a San Francisco native, was selected by the Guardians in the eighth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UC Santa Barbara.

AWESOME APRIL: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans this month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,874) and Worcester (7,856).

SUGASTAY SURGING: **Adrián Sugastey** is riding a nine-game on-base streak, tied for the second-longest by a Richmond player this season. He also has at least one hit in eight-of-his-last-nine games, hitting .323 (10-for-31) with a double, a homer, eight RBIs, three walks and four runs scored since April 14. On Saturday night, he hit his first Double-A homer, a three-run shot to break a scoreless tie in a 4-0 win over the Baysox. This year, Sugastey is the youngest catcher in the Eastern League. With his debut earlier this month, Sugastey became the second-youngest catcher in team history behind Tommy Joseph (2012) and the 13th-youngest player in franchise history.

WILL POWER: **Will Wilson** is batting .351 (13-for-37) over his current 10-game on-base streak with three doubles, five RBIs and seven walks. That stretch has raised his season batting average from .069 to .227. In his last six games since April 23, Wilson is batting .421 (8-for-19) with two doubles, four RBIs, six walks and two runs scored while posting a .560 on-base percentage and a 1.086 OPS. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 156 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons.

HOWELL HEATING UP: **Carter Howell** has reached base in 11 consecutive games, the longest on-base streak by a Flying Squirrels batter in 2024 so far. In that stretch, he is batting .333 (13-for-39) with four doubles, one triple, six RBIs, six walks and seven runs scored. Last year in his first full professional season, Howell led the Giants system in hits (144) and triples (8) and was second in the organization in batting average (.294) and runs scored (94) between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene.

PITCH PERFECT: **John Michael Bertrand** was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for April 22-28. On Saturday, he pitched seven perfect innings against the Baysox at The Diamond, retiring all 21 batters he faced in order on 68 pitches. In his five games (four starts) this year, Bertrand is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (6 ER/26.2 IP). He currently ranks second in the Eastern League in innings pitched, sixth in ERA and seventh in WHIP (1.05).

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 211 strikeouts this season, third-most in the Eastern League, and also ranked third with a 3.10 ERA. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.18 ERA this year, which is third-best in the league behind Akron (2.13) and Erie (2.71). The Richmond bullpen has the third-lowest ERA (3.03) in the league.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are five relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 10 IP), three Richmond pitchers rank in the top 10 in ERA. **Evan Gates** is fifth with a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP), **Tanner Kiest** is sixth with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP) and **Wil Jensen** is 10th with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP), which is the lowest in the league for any pitcher who has worked at least 15.0 innings. **José Cruz** has posted a 1.17 ERA (1 ER/7.2 IP) in his six outings and **Nick Garcia** has a 1.80 ERA (2 ER/10. IP) in his seven appearances.

BIDDING FOR HISTORY: Richmond starters **Hayden Birdsong** and **John Michael Bertrand** each worked hitless starts over the weekend. On Friday night, Birdsong threw five innings and the bullpen carried a no-hit bid into the ninth inning. On Saturday, Bertrand worked through seven perfect innings before the Baysox broke up the perfect game and no-hitter in the eighth inning. There has only been one no-hitter pitched by the home team in the 40-year history of The Diamond, which was a seven-inning no-no in 2013 by Jack Snodgrass and Daryl Maday. The last time a Richmond team completed a no-hitter at home was on June 1, 1977 when Richmond Braves pitcher Mickey Mahler no-hit the Toledo Mud Hens at Parker Field. The only other nine-inning no-hitter thrown by the home team in the current location, which dates back to 1954, was thrown by Al Downing and the Richmond Virginians on May 12, 1962 against the Syracuse Chiefs. The only perfect game by a Richmond professional baseball team was thrown in a seven-inning game by Pete Smith for the Richmond Braves in 1992 at Rochester.

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Reggie Crawford** (No. 9), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).

Later in the game, he went deep with another home run. Richmond homered four times in the game, tying what was then the franchise single-game record for home runs, which was broken in 2022 and then passed again in 2023.
