### Jersey Shore BlueClaws (16-14/54-42) vs Hudson Valley Renegades (13-16/46-48)

Heritage Financial Park – Wappingers Falls, NY (opened 1994) RHP Casey Steward (1-0, 1.17) vs RHP Trent Sellers (6-2, 2.75) Series: Game 1 of 6 (Jersey Shore leads season series 7-5 of 24)

Last Time Out... Aberdeen scored seven times in the top of the seventh inning and topped the BlueClaws 8-5 on Sunday afternoon at ShoreTown Ballpark... Trent Farauhar had three hits and Troy Schreffler had two for the BlueClaws in the loss...Estibenzon Jimenez took the loss, allowing five runs and recording just one out...Carter Young and Douglas Hodo each had two hits and two RBIs for Aberdeen...The teams solit their six game series.

State of the BlueClaws...The BlueClaws are on current stretches of 5-3, 11-5, and 13-6 (since July 3rd, after they dropped the first two games at Wilmington on July 1st and 2nd) and sit in second place, just two games behind first place Greensboro in the SAL North...The BlueClaws are 12 games over .500 on the season...Last year, they got to 15 over at 65-50 with three weeks left in the season

Strong From the Start... Jersey Shore is 13-6 in their last 19 games... In those games, BlueClaws starting pitchers are 8-3 with a 2.55 ERA...In 99 innings, they have allowed just 28 earned runs on 65 hits and 32 walks while striking out 108.

Three for Trent...Trent Farquhar of Michigan State University had three hits on Sunday, two doubles, and is now 6-21 with three walks and three HBPs so far with Jersey Shore...He was hit by three pitches in his BlueClaws debut on July 20<sup>th</sup>, matching a team record set by Nick Ward on 6/6/23 against Hudson Valley at ShoreTown Ballpark...Farquhar, signed as a NDFA last year from Michigan State, began the year with Clearwater, where he was hitting .314 in 32 games with 35 walks and 26 strikeouts through 32 games...He had been on the IL since May 30 before his promotion on Saturday.

The Hittin' Hawkeye ... Keaton Anthony had two hits on Sunday and is now 27-79 (.342) with the BlueClaws since arriving on June 26<sup>th</sup> with eight multi-hit games...He had a walk-off single last Tuesday against Aberdeen...He was hitting .322 in 44 games with Clearwater, adding four home runs and 21 RBIs, and drew 28 walks in 186 plate

appearances while striking out only 28 times...At the time of his promotion, led the Florida State League in OBP (.446) and OPS (.916) while third in SLG (.470) and fourth in BA (.322)...He signed as an NDFA from the University of Iowa in 2023 after three years with the Hawkeyes.

On the Move...George Klassen was scratched from his start on Saturday night and traded to the Angels (with 2023-24 BlueClaws LHP Sam Aldegheri) for RHP Carlos Estevez...The BlueClaws have had several active players in deadline deals over the last few years: 2023 – IF Hao Yu Lee to the Tigers for Michael Lorenzen...2021 – RHP Tyler Burch to the Orioles for Freddy Galvis...2021 – RHP Kevin Gowdy (and others) to the Rangers for Ian Kennedy and Kyle Gibson...In 2022, RHP Ben Brown was traded to the Cubs for David Robertson one day after getting promoted from the BlueClaws to Reading and before he made his Fightins debut...In 2009, RHP Jason Knapp was traded to the Indians (with others) for Cliff Lee and in 2010. SS Jonathan Villar was traded (with others) to the Astros for Roy Oswalt

Willie B ... William Bergolla enters today on a 10 game hitting streak (15-46) - he had two hits including a bunt single on Thursday and two more hits on Friday ... He has 19 multi-hit games on the year, most among active players (Justin Crawford had 29 before his promotion to lead the team)...The 19 year old was in the Injured List and didn't play from June 22<sup>nd</sup> – July 8<sup>th</sup>...Bergolla hit .172 in April but since then, is 58-172 (.340)...He was the 3<sup>rd</sup> youngest player on a South Atlantic League Opening Day roster.

With a Win...With a win today, Greg Brodzinski will break a tie with PJ Forbes (2004-05) for fourth on the BlueClaws managerial wins list...Brodzinski is 127-100 in two years with the BlueClaws...Shawn Williams (147-131 in 2015-16) is third on the list (20 wins ahead with 37 games left in the regular season)

Hittin' Hendry...Hendry Mendez 21-63 so far in July and had two hits on Saturday...He hit his first BlueClaws home run on July 6th...He had a four-hit game on July 4th, his first four-hit game of the year (and first since a rehab game on 6/27/23 with the AZL Brewers), while driving in four of the BlueClaws 15 runs... He has five multi-hit games this month (he had one between May 30<sup>th</sup> and July 2<sup>nd</sup>)...The 20 year old came to the Phillies with Reading IF Robert Moore for Brewers IF Oliver Dunn in November.

A Record Pace ... The BlueClaws have scored 495 runs in 96 games so far this year, and at 5.13 runs per game, they are on pace to set a club record for runs per game...The current record is 4.96 runs per game set in 2010...Last year, the BlueClaws scored 4.83 runs per game, the second most in club history for completed season...Their current team OBP of .336 is tied with last year's team and .001 ahead of the .335 set by the 2005 BlueClaws...Only Greensboro (577 runs) has scored more runs than Jersey Shore this season.

Zach Attack...Zach Arnold had three hits on Wednesday, his fourth three-hit game of the season, and two RBIs on Thursday...He is now 20-55 in July with three multi-hit games, nine RBIs and six walks...Arnold was a 14<sup>th</sup> round pick last year from the Univeristy of Houston.

Viars Joins the BlueClaws...Jordan Viars, a 3rd round pick in the 2021 draft (Reedy HS, Frisco, TX), joined the BlueClaws last week (2-22 so far)...He had an RBI single on July 20th and a hit and two runs scored on Wednesday...Viars was hitting .252 with Clearwater, adding 12 home runs and 39 RBIs at the time of his promotion...He had a three home run and nine RBI game on 5/30 vs Lakeland.... At the time of his promotion, he was tied for third in the FSL with 12 home runs, first in slugging percentage (.491), and second in OPS (.846)...He turned 21 years old on Thursday, July

Paxton on the Mark...RHP Paxton Thompson joined the BlueClaws on July 2<sup>nd</sup> and has thrown 8.1 innings without allowing an earned run (one unearned) with Jersey Shore so far, including two scoreless innings on Sunday in Brooklyn...He threw two scoreless innings on July 3rd in his BlueClaws debut...He joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA in 19 appearances...He struck out 30 and walked nine in 27.1 innings with the Threshers...Thompson signed with the Phillies last year from UNC-Charlotte where he helped them reach the NCAA Tournament last year and he threw three scoreless innings in the Regionals to eliminate #3 Clemson

Going Going Gone... The BlueClaws (30 HRs in Lakewood and 30 on the road) got a home run from Troy Schreffler on July 13<sup>th</sup>...They hit four home runs on July 6<sup>th</sup> against Wilmington - one each from Emaarion Boyd, Justin Crawford, Hendry Mendez, and Leandro Pineda... Aidan Miller hit a leadoff home run in the game on July 4<sup>th</sup>...Jordan Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda has eight...Felix Reves has five, four since June 16th...William Bergolla hit his first professional home run on June 8<sup>th</sup> at Greensboro.

Hitting Triple Digits ... A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches seven times in a game this season - all seven are BlueClaws...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13th), Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 no-hitter at COL), not incluing Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was suspended.

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on

June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling (now with Reading) earned his sixth save of the year in the win on July 14th... Gunner Mayer has four while Charles King has two.

Walk-Off This Way... The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year – July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

The Comeback Claws ... The BlueClaws got a two-out, two-strike hit from Keaton Anthony and a two-strike RBI double from Felix Reyes on July 21st at Brooklyn to tie the game, that they would win 9-6 in 10 innings...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June 15th to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15th, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10).

Just Grand ... The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30th - one by Justin Crawford (May 30<sup>th</sup>), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9<sup>th</sup>), and one by

Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Aidan Miller is the 16th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team...(his ex-teammate Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).



From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer ... Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach ... Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017... Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

Season Notes: Threw a career-long seven scoreless innings on 7/23 vs ABD...Earned first BC win on 7/3 at WIL (5 IP, 2 R/1 ER)...Struck out nine over five innings, one run in Claws debut on 6/27 vs GBO...Joined the BlueClaws on 6/27 from Clearwater where he was 4-2, 3.38 in 12 games (10 starts) with 52 strikeouts and 19 walks in 50.2 innings pitched...Threw five scoreless innings with five strikeouts on 5/4 at Lakeland.

Career Notes: Made five appearances between the FCL Phillies (two scoreless innings in two games) and Clearwater (two runs in four innings in three games) in first professional season...First player the Phillies have drafted from D2 Washburn University...Notable baseball alumni include Davey Lopes, who had a 16 year big league career, managed the Brewers (2000 - 2002) and was the Phillies 1B coach from 2007-2010, including for their 2008 World Series title... Has a twin brother named Calvin.

stolen bases...His home run came on 7/3 vs Dunedin. Career Notes: Made pro debut with the FCL Phillies, going 4-21... Played four years at Wake Forest including the 2020 COVID-shortened season...Hit .353 in his last year and was the toughest hitter to strikeout in the ACC (11.2 AB/K).

Resides: Valencia, Venezuela Season Notes: Phillies Minor League Player of the Month for June (hit .419)...Had 2-run single and two SBs in 6/19 2-0 win at BRK...Had five hits in 6/9 win at GBO, tying BlueClaws record...Hit first professional home run on 6/8 at GBO...Had two hits and two RBIs in 6/1 win vs BRK...Had three hits and two RBIs in 5/26 win at ABD...Had three hits and three RBIs in 5/18 win at HV...Had four hits and scored three runs in 4/6 win vs ABD ... Entered the season as the Phillies #12 prospect per MLB Pipeline ... Opening Day age of 19 years, 5 months, and 17 days makes him the second youngest BlueClaw debuter since the team moved to High-A in 2021 behind only Andrew Painter (19 years, 2 months 2 days in 2022).
