### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- The Chasers won last week's series opener against Louisville 9-4 to clinch the 1st half.
- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset today with the start of the 2nd half, Omaha's enters today's game with the best overall record in Minor League Baseball, 25 games over .500 at 49-24 (.671).

- 49 wins are tied for the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, tied with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A) for the winningest MiLB team.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .671 winning percentage overall this year is also the best, just ahead of Sugar Land (49-26 / .653).
- Omaha has held the best record in Minor League Baseball for 20 days, since June 5.

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

49 of Omaha's 72 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer, including 15 of 23 losses in 2024.

- Omaha is 17-7 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... the Storm Chasers have won 10 of their last 14 games decided by just a run.
- As a team, Omaha's 23 saves are the 5th-most of any Minor League team and second in Triple-A ... Will Klein's 9 saves individually rank third in the International League, while six Storm Chasers players have 2 or more saves this year.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 413 to 326 this season, a +87 run differential.

- A +87 run differential ranks as the best the International League and is the 2nd-highest mark at the Triple-A level, just behind Oklahoma City (+91).
- Omaha ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +141 (445 to 304).

#### COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 27 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (55%) of this year's wins have been comeback victories.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as five runs to win and 10 times, have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 10 of the 27 comeback wins, with four victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 7 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

#### YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.

- When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 23-8 record (.742 winning %), compared to 25-17 (.595 winning %) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 29-6 (.829 winning %), while the team is just 20-18 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher (.526 winning %).

#### RELIEF AID

For much of this season, Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 3.58 ERA, 1.33 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .208/.321/.346 ... the .206 opponents' average is tied for the 5th-best in all of the Minors.
- Including Friday's loss to Louisville, Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 19 games this year, including 5 of the last 10 games ... since June 14, Omaha's bullpen has a 1.91 ERA (8 ER in 37.2 IP), the 11th-best in the Minors in that stretch.
- Walter Pennington's 73 strikeouts in 29 games (2 starts) are the 6th-most in the International League, while 61 strikeouts in relief lead all MINOR LEAGUE RELIEVERS ... his 37.2% strikeout rate is 3rd in MiLB (min. 45.0 IP).
- Noah Murdock and Evan Sisk have each offered a pair of impressive scoreless streaks that are active entering today's game ... Sisk has gone his last 6 games without allowing a run, since June 9, 3.2 innings ... Murdock made his Triple-A debut last week in Toledo and since arriving to the Storm Chasers, has thrown 6.2 scoreless innings over 5 appearances.

Joins the Royals for his 2nd MLB organization, after being acquired via trade with Ryan Brady from Milwaukee for Taylor Clarke in December 2023
Opened the 2023 season on the 7-Day Injured List for Nashville (AAA) but was activated April 20 and played 103 games (271/363/461 (91-for-336) ... led the Sounds in games and runs scored (57), while tied 6th among Brewers Minor League players in extra-base hits (40) ... made a start at every spot in the batting order except leadoff.
Between 2019 and 2023, he had the most doubles (81) of any Brewers Minor League players while he ranked 2nd in games played (379), 3rd in hits (324) and tied 4th in runs batted in (179) ... his .766 OPS since being drafted ranks 5th among Milwaukee Minor Leaguers with at least 1,000 plate appearances.

Made his first Opening Day roster with Royals in 2023, but hit .075 (4-for-53) in 28 games over 4 stints with KC ... had hits in first 2 AB's with Omaha and homered in his first plate appearance of his first stint on 4/27 at Nashville, again to open his first stint on 6/17 vs. Columbus ... of 15 HR this year have come on the first pitch ... DFA'd 11/2, outrighted 11/8.

Joins the Royals for his 2nd MLB organization, after being selected by Kansas City from Boston in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 Draft in December 2023.
Spent most of the 2023 season with Worcester (AAA) but missed 25 games on the IL, combined to slash .268/.348/.491 (90-for-336) with 25 2B, 7 3B, 12 HR and 60 RBI.
