Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Trenton Denholm** to the mound tonight, looking to become the first 10G winner in the IL (0-2 in last 5GS). The Indians will counter with RHP **Thomas Harrington**. Columbus is 52-37 (.584) versus right handers this year. Harrington has pitched against the Clippers eight times in his career, going 1-4 with a 3.98ERA (31.2IP, 27H, 15R, 14ER, 14BB, 29K).

vs. the Indians

Columbus is 7-8 against Indianapolis this year, posting a -20 run margin (9-9, +13 in 2025; 12-5, +45 in 2024; 10-8, -23 in 2023; 12-8, +53 in 2022). Since the start of the 2022 season, the Clippers are 18-10 (.643) in games against Indianapolis that are decided by at least five. Individually, **Cooper Ingle** is 19x63 (.302) with 3HR, 9RBI in 18G vs. Indy in his career (**Milan Tolentino** has 6HR, 21RBI in 32G).

Start with a Bang

The Clippers are 5-0 in the last five series openers, outscoring the opposition 68-23 (last loss: 5-2 vs. Indy on 7/17). Over the last 22G, the Clippers have plated 172 runs (most in the IL, 7.8 per), with 114 (66%) tallied in the first four innings of the game, including nine innings of 5+. Columbus is the only undefeated team in the IL when leading after the 7th (48-0, 58 straight since 8/22/25 vs. Omaha).

Aside from That...

If no homers were hit last week, Columbus would have outscored St. Paul by a total of 20-7, as the Saints scored 35 times thanks to 22HR (Clippers scored 31 runs off 17HR). Dating to 7/28, the Clippers have the most homers in pro ball (57), while giving up the 5th most (47; leads IL). Victory Field has seen the fewest homers per game in the IL this year (1.4; last 22G for Columbus have seen 4.7).

Ingle is Back

In 32G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 42x125 (.336), drawing 29BB (.458OBP) with 16XBH (6HR, .560SLG). He is the only batter in the IL hitting .300/.400/.500 (20PA from permanently qualifying for rate statistics), but is just 8x45 in his last 13G (.178; has drawn 18BB for a .413OBP, also has 19K in 63PA). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.298OPS (15HR) in 45G (.635OPS, 3HR in 37G between DH and LF).

Little Heaters

Daniel Schneemann has five multi-hit games since 8/15 (12x26, .462) and, dating to 4/25/24, he has played 52G in the IL, batting .324/.446/.569 with 47 runs scored (18 runs in last 16G) and 36RBI (5RBI in last 16G). **Kyle Manzardo** has hit safely in each of his last 7G since 8/15 (.310, 9x29, 2HR, 10RBI) and his double on Saturday night was the 62nd XBH of his Clipper career (50 singles, .556SLG).

King Ralph

Dating to 7/28, **Ralph Velazquez** leads pro baseball in HR (16, +5), RBI (32, +1) and SLG (.987, +70). In fact, his 16HR (in 21G) are more than eight minor league teams, including Indianapolis (15HR in 24G). He is the reigning IL Batter of the Week (.455 with 6HR and 12RBI vs. St. Paul) and, aside from going 0x21 in 6G at St. Paul (7/21-7/26), he is hitting .348/.422/.727 since 6/18 (19HR, 46RBI).

All or Nothing

Over his last 21G, since 7/25, **Kody Huff** is mired in a 14x73 (.192) slump, though he has connected for 6HR (19HR on the season; had 18HR in career prior). He leads the team in runs (73) and RBI (68) and is set to become the fourth 70-70 Clipper since 2019 (**Johnathan Rodriguez**, **Jhonkensy Noel**, **Juan Brito**). He was 4x4 Sunday, he enters today on a 14G on base streak (.361OBP since 8/2).

Out of a Slump

After doubling twice on 6/25 at Omaha, **George Valera** hit .111 (8x72) with a .139SLG in his next 20G (6/27-7/28). On 7/30, he was 2x3 with a HR (snapped 124AB homerless streak) and his 150th career RBI as a Clipper (38th most all-time), and he has hit safely in eight straight (.387, 12x31, 4HR, .935SLG). On Thursday (first game since 8/5), he doubled twice (reached 50 doubles in Clipper career).

Problems on the Back End

Since allowing 7ER in 4.1IP at Lehigh Valley on 7/12, the Clipper bullpen has registered an IL-worst 7.63ERA in 32G (135.2IP, 115ER). Clipper relievers have surrendered 36HR in that time (most in the IL) and the bullpen has not put together a scoreless outing since back to back games vs. Louisville (7/4-7/5). Columbus starters have a 4.95ERA since 7/12 (11th in the IL; 32HR allowed is most, +8 on 2nd).

This Date in Clipper History

8/25/1979

The Clippers captured their first International League pennant with a 3-1 win over the Syracuse Chiefs. **Roy Staiger** hit a 2-run HR in the 11th to give Columbus the lead and Dave Righetti tossed 4.0 innings of shutout relief for the win. The Clippers would follow up a 1979 Governors' Cup Championship with wins in 1980 and 1981, becoming the first, and only, team to win three consecutive Governors' Cups.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,494 to 1,439).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 178-139 (.562) in pitch reviews, with batters going 92-84 (.523) and pitchers/catchers going 86-55 (.610). They have run out of challenges in 47G and have not challenged in 6G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 846, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 145 through 123G (on pace for 173SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 43CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (51; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 174 runs while crafting a .891OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 116 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +58 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 288-183 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 80 grand slams and 1,989RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.50 through 123G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 212HR (2nd most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.981), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 67G this season (40-27, .597), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 8th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 12th most games decided in the last at bat (27, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 101G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-53 (.475, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 452-463 (.494), 422-417 with Columbus (.503).

500K:

On 8/1 vs. Toledo, Denholm racked up 8K for the third time this year, crossing 500 in his career in the process (8.4K/9IP). He has seen that rate bump slightly this season (9.0K/9IP), while his 3.89K/BB ratio ranks 4th in the IL among 86 pitchers with at least 60.0IP (0BB to 67BF from 7/21-8/7).

Great Start:

Denholm's season debut, 4/1 vs. Indianapolis, was his 100th career game and his second at the Triple-A level (367 days between Triple-A games). He needed only 69 pitches to record a quality start (6.0IP, 1ER), giving the Clippers their first of the season (5th game, did not have a quality start until 41st game last season). Columbus has 17QS on the season (18QS through this point last year, on the way to 23), with **Rorik Maltrud** (7), **Logan Allen** (4) and Denholm (3) accounting for 82%.

In Relief:

Denholm pitched exclusively in relief during May and June, but each appearance came on starter's rest, as he averaged 56.0 pitches per outing (ranged from 38-84, while recording 2.0-5.0IP). In total, he was 7-0 with a 1.95ERA over 9G (32.1IP, 30H, 9R, 7ER, 5BB, 35K). He led the IL in wins from May-June and, among 76 pitchers with at least 30.0IP, his ERA was 2nd best (also 2nd with 7.00K/BB and 6th with a 1.08WHIP). On 5/20 vs. Louisville, Denholm notched his first save in Triple-A (4.0IP, 1ER) and the fifth of his pro career.

Tough Ones:

On 4/12, Worcester hung 7ER on Denholm, tying a career high (third time), while also connecting for 2HR (eighth career game giving up 2HR, first time allowing both to same batter, Allan Castro). He followed up with a quality outing next time out, 4/18 vs. Iowa (6.0IP, 3ER), throwing a season high of 92 pitches. Denholm closed out April by giving up 7ER again (fourth time), this time to Toledo on 4/30, while giving up 3HR for the first time in his career.

Limiting the Longballs:

From 4/12-4/30, Denholm surrendered 7HR to 90BF (one per 12.9BF), accounting for 15 of 19ER (6HR with men on base, including a grand slam on 4/12 at Worcester). He allowed only 2HR to the next 188BF from 5/7-7/12 (94.0BF per) before surrendering a pair in the 3rd inning at Lehigh Valley on 7/12. Including those IronPig homers, Denholm surrendered bombs in each of 3GS from 7/12-7/26, giving up 5HR to 57BF (one per 11.4BF; 3HR to 77BF in August).
