FROM THE CROWS NEST

ROSTER MOVES: The Pittsburgh Pirates announced the following roster moves affecting the Bradenton Marauders on Tuesday afternoon. OF Will Taylor and LHP Connor Wietgrefe have been assigned to Single-A Bradenton from the FCL Pirates. Taylor was selected by the Pirates in the 5th round of this year's draft out of Clemson University and Wietgrefe was a 7th rounder out of the University of Minnesota.

ON-BASE KING: Jhonny Severino mashed a solo-home run on Sunday to extend his on-base streak to nine games. During this stretch, the Marauders infielder is hitting .297/.366/.514 with one double, two triples, one HR, five RBIs, four walks, and five runs scored. He became the just the second Marauder since 2018 to record two triples in a game last Thursday against St. Lucie.

TWO WEEKS DUE EAST: The Bradenton Marauders return to LECOM Park having recently wrapped a 12-game road trip in Palm Beach and St. Lucie over the last two weeks. The Marauders went 6-6 on the trip, but are coming off their first road trip series victory last week after winning five out of six games against the Mets at Clover Park.

TOP OF THE TABLE: Bradenton's pitching staff found their form once again in St. Lucie. During the six-game series, Bradenton allowed just 14 earned runs in 53.0 innings which is good for a 2.38 ERA, the best in the Florida State League and sixth-best in Single-A.

CURSE REVERSED: With a win on Friday night, the Bradenton Marauders clinched their first road series victory of the season. Bradenton had split a pair of road trips in June in Clearwater and Dunedin. Their previous road series victory came in their last in the 2023 season when they won four out of six in Fort Myers.

GRAND SALAMI: C Derek Berg's first professional home run came on an inside-the-park grand slam on Thursday night in Port St. Lucie. For the Marauders, it's their second inside-the-park grand slam this year, with the other coming from **Esmerlyn Valdez** against the Mets at LECOM Park on May 10. Bradenton has five grand slams this year, which is the second-most in Single-A and tied for the 10th-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Since their promotions from the FCL Pirates last week, both INF Jhonny Severino and INF Yordany De Los Santos have held their own. Severino has reached base in all nine games he's played in. Severino's best game of the season came on Thursday night, when he went 4-for-5 with two triples, a walk, and three runs. The four hits tied his career-high, last accomplishing the feat on 7/2/22 when he was a member of the DSL Brewers. The four-hits are also the most by a Marauder batter in a single-game this year.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold three of the top eight home run leaders in the Florida State League, with Esmerlyn Valdez leading the way in second with 17 longballs. Axiel Plaz is currently in third with 15 and Shalin Polanco is tied for eighth with 10. Valdez is one just HR shy of týing league leader in Áriel Almonte (Daytona). The 17 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

BOMBS AWAY: Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 85 home runs in 86 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton racked up 26 in 22 games with Axiel Plaz and Esmerlyn Valdez accounting for 12 of the 26. The 26 home runs were the third-most in Single-A in July, trailing the Inland Empire 66ers who had 29.
