### FROM THE CROW'S NEST\*\*\*

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Marauders overcame a 7.2-inning no-hit bid by Lakeland pitching Sunday afternoon, storming back to win, 4-3... The win salvaged a series split for the Marauders, who have not won a series since April 26-May 1 vs Dunedin... Bradenton trailed, 3-1, when **Luke Brown** drew a one-out walk from Cristhian Tortosa in the eighth, **Mike Jarvis** spoiled the no-no with a bloop single to shallow right, and **Rodolfo Nolasco** followed with a go-ahead three-run homer to left... **Yunior Thibo** and **Dante Mendoza** each followed with one scoreless inning of relief, with the latter earning his first career save... **Randy Romero** gave the Marauders their first run in the third inning, drawing a walk and stealing second base to draw an errant throw, allowing him to score... **Justin Meis** and left-hander Carlos Pena dueled on the mound for five innings each, with Pena striking out a season-high nine for Lakeland... The win also marked the first of the season for the Marauders in which they trailed after seven innings (0-22 previously).

**THE OPPONENT:** The Threshers are coming off a series split with Dunedin... Clearwater is in second place in the FSL West Division, 3.5 games ahead of the Marauders... The team's roster currently features two players in *Baseball America's* latest top 30 prospect rankings for the Phillies organization: INF Hao Yu Lee (#19) and OF Jadel Sanchez (#21).

**MAKE IT CLEAR:** The Marauders went 17-7 against Clearwater in 2021, winning all four series matchups... The West Division foes will meet just 15 times this season, and the current six-game series is the Threshers' only visit to LECOM Park in 2022.

**\*\*\*STARTING STRONG:** Over the last six games, Bradenton's starting pitchers have combined for a 1.74 ERA and a 0.97 WHIP (31 IP total), including just six walks and 33 strikeouts... The stretch includes back-to-back quality starts from right-handers **Valentin Linarez** and **Joelvis del Rosario** on Tuesday and Wednesday, respectively.

**TOP PIRATES PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently includes two prospects in *Baseball America's* Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: LHP **Anthony Solometo** (#11) and OF **Rodolfo Nolasco** (#28)... *Baseball America* lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball.

**FIELD STAFF:** Manager **Jonathan Johnston**, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer **Yorman Bazardo** is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate **Mendy López** joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... **Casey Harms** is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... **Gustavo Omaña** is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021.

**HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS:** The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Hank Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.
