TODAY'S GAME: Tacoma holds a 1-0 series lead after an eighth inning comeback to claim a 10-9 win last night ... The Isotopes are expected to send Tyler Danish to the hill while the Rainiers are slated to start Casey Lawrence.

REHAB: Jake Bird commenced his second rehab stint of the season with Albuquerque and pitched around a trio of singles in the seventh inning to work a scoreless frame.

SERIES OPENERS: Tacoma has won five of the last six series openers against the Isotopes, dating back to June 24, 2021 in the Duke City ... In 2024, the club dropped to 4-12 in series openers. The loss ended a three-game series-opening winning streak.

LEAD LOST: The Isotopes lost a game when leading by three or more runs for the eighth time in 2024, including the third occurrence in their prior 11 contests (also: June 27 vs. Salt Lake, July 6 at El Paso).

LOSING STREAK: Albuquerque is slumping through their first three-game losing streak since June 2-7 (five losses total: finale vs. Oklahoma City, first four contests at Sacramento).

RUNS ALLOWED: The Isotopes pitching staff allowed double-digit runs last night for the 22nd time this season, dropping to 1-21 in such instances (last: June 29 vs. Salt Lake, 13-2 defeat). It was the third time they have suffered the fate in their last four home games.

ONE-RUN GAMES: The Isotopes dropped to 7-16 in one-run games this season, dropping a contest by a tally for the second time in three outings (last: 5-4 loss at El Paso, July 6).

NINE-PLUS: Albuquerque lost for the eighth time when scoring nine or more runs last night (last: May 17 vs. Sugar Land, 14-12 defeat)

GO-AHEAD HIT: Grant Lavigne delivered Albuquerque's 10th go-ahead hit in the seventh inning or later this season, and first since Connor Kaiser hit a walk-off two-run double in the 11th on June 28 vs. Salt Lake.

ATTENDANCE: Over 46 openings, Albuquerque has tallied the fifth-highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball (304,051) and second-highest in the Pacific Coast League ... The club is also averaging 6,610 per game, the highest in the PCL

TACOMA TIES: Rainiers hitting coach Shawn O'Malley played for the Isotopes in 2018... Tacoma skipper John Russell managed the IL squad in the 2007 Triple-A All-Star Game in the Duke City.

BOOCHIE THE BRUIN: Sean Bouchard tallied two hits last night for his 10th multi-hit contest of the year, extending his onbase streak to 16-straight with Albuquerque, fifth-longest active streak in the Pacific Coast League (longest: Luis Rivas, Tacoma, 22). Slashing .345/.486/.618 with two doubles, two triples, three homers and 13 RBI.

MONTI: Elehuris Montero registered two hits yesterday for his third multi-hit contest in four games with Albuquerque ... Has recorded an RBI in three of four games with the Isotopes ... Four of his seven hits have been doubles.

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron went 4-for-5 last night, including a solo homer, to extend his hit streak to seven-games. Slashing .538/.548/.962 with three doubles, a triple, two homers and 14 RBI ... Has a hit in 14 of his last 15 games, raising his batting from .269 to .305 during span.

JC: Julio Carreras has stolen a base in back-to-back contests for the fifth time in 2024 and first since June 4-6 at Sacramento ... Has a hit in seven of his last eight games, going 10-for-27 with three doubles, a triple and three RBI ... Has swiped a career-high 22 bags this season.

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall has gone hitless in two-straight games for the fifth time in 2024, first since June 29-30 vs. Salt Lake (0-for-7 in last two games).

MR JONES: Greg Jones went 2-for-5 last night for his ninth multihit game of the campaign and first since June 28 vs. Salt Lake ... Is 4-for-34 with 16 strikeouts over his last eight games.

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver tallied two hits Sunday for his 17th multi-hit contest of the year and his fourth-straight, first time in career has four-straight mult-hit games ... Has a six-game hitting streak, slashing .524/.522/1.095 with three doubles, three homers and seven RBI.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 9th in average (.300) ... Sean Bouchard is T-4th in triples (6) ... Julio Carreras is T-6th in SB (22).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in triples (41), and total bases (1,477), 2nd in hits (862), slugging (.478) average (.279), 3rd in OPS (.835) and 6th in runs (520).

FREE PASSES: Peyton Battenfield walked four batters in 5.0 innings last night, the 16th time an Isotopes starter has issued at least four free passes.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
