GAME 114: After winning the first two of the series and dropping the last three, the FredNats aim to salvage the series today and split with the Salem Red Sox to maintain the division lead in the second half. A win today would also mean a split in the two-week home stand. RHP Brayan Romero makes his second start of this series after he pitched four innings of one-run ball on Tuesday to lead the FredNats to an 8-1 win. He faces Salem righty Juan Valera, who is making just his second appearance with the Sox.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Fredericksburg managed just four hits on offense for the second night in a row, and was shut out for the second time this season, 4-0 with Salem. Bryan Polanco bounced back nicely on the mound, pitching four scoreless innings in his start. Brenner Cox robbed a home run and Cristhian Vaquero just missed a home run with a triple, but the FredNat bullpen allowed four runs late to secure at least a series split for the Sox.

INSTANT IMPACT: Washington's top two picks in the 2024 draft - Seaver King and Caleb Lomavita - both made their professional debuts this week and have majorly contributed to the two wins this week over Salem. King has two hits in both his games so far, including a triple in the first inning of last night's game to open the scoring. Lomavita has two hits in two games and has scored five runs, reaching base in six out of nine plate appearances. In MLB Pipeline's updated post-draft rankings that were released yesterday, King is Washington's 5th-best prospect and Lomavita is ranked 10th.

HOT AUGUST: A few FredNat hitters are off to a good start through the first half of August. Brandon Pimentel, Jorgelys Mota, Everett Cooper III and Cristhian Vaquero are all hitting over .300 this month with an OPS over .800. Those four hitters have been key to Fredericksburg's offense averaging over five runs per game in August.

HE'S SOMETHING ELSE: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. In seven starts since July 1, Sykora has allowed a total of six earned runs for an ERA of 1.29 in that time frame. He's got 49 strikeouts and nine walks in those six starts, and the FredNats have won five out of the six games. The opponents are hitting .112 against him in that time frame, and .162 for the entire season. In MLB Pipeline's re-ranking of prospects, Sykora shot up the list to Washington's third overall prospect, and entered the Top 100 prospects in baseball as well.

NO-HITTER!: Last Friday, Travis Sykora, Angel Roman and Merrick Baldo combined to throw the first nine inning no-hitter in Fredericksburg Nationals history. It was the 32nd total no-hitter this year in Minor League Baseball, but only 20 of those have come in full-season ball. Of the 32 total no-no's this year in MiLB, only 16 of them have come in nine innings. It was the second no-hitter this year in the league.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 203-170 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Brayan Romero is set to make his fourth start as a FredNat today, in a crucial series finale against Salem.

Romero was called up from the FCL on 7/26, in conjunction with Marc Davis being promoted to A+ Wilmington.

ROAD TO FXBG: Romero's pro career began in 2022, primarily as a reliever in the Domincan Summer League. He covered 11 innings in the DSL, working to a 3.27 ERA with opponents hitting just .154 against him. That earned him a mid-summer bump to Florida, where he posted a 5.79 ERA over five outings (two starts).

Romero lost 2023 due to injury, but has excelled this season in the FCL. He's transitioned to a starting role (12 appearances, 9 starts), sporting a 2.52 ERA across 39.1 innings, nearly double his 2022 workload. He's struck out 39 men, while walking just nine, with a .212 BAA.

LAST TIME OUT: Romero scattered six Salem hits earlier this week, giving up just one earned run over four frames. He did not walk a batter, and struck out one.
