FRES-NOTES

STRONG FIRST HOMERS: Kevin Fitzer and Alan Espinal both notched their first professional home runs on Wednesday night at Valley Strong Ballpark in Visalia. Its the third time this season that the Grizzlies have hit multiple home runs in the same game, with all three instances coming in the last three weeks. Two of the three have come against Visalia. Teammate Blake Wright also had his first professional home run last August at the same venue.

THE WAY OF THE K: Everett Catlett struck out a career-high 9 batters on Wednesday night and the Grizzlies pitching staff registered 14 total strikeouts in the ballgame, tied for the third highest total in a game this season. Its the fourth time this season the Grizzlies have tallied 14 K's against the Rawhide this year, but Frenso is 0-4 in those games. The Grizzlies are just 3-11 when registering 12 or more strikeouts this season.

(DON'T) WALK THIS WAY: The Grizzlies have allowed the second fewest walks in both Single A and the California League since the start of June with 46, only Modesto has issued fewer. The Grizzlies have allowed more hits and more home runs in the month but have still posted a 3.74 ERA in June, putting them in the upper third of Single A.
