## FROM THE CROWS NEST

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Bradenton Marauders used a six-run ninth inning to down the Clearwater Threshers 9-7 at BayCare Ballpark on Tuesday night. **Esmerlyn Valdez** and **Jeral Toledo** each paced the offense with three hits and three RBIs each. **Enmanuel Terrero** bashed his second home run of the season. **Antwone Kelly** tossed another quality start, allowing just two earned runs and striking out five in 5.2 innings.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to Wednesday's game, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced that **C Abraham Gutierrez's** rehab was transferred from the FCL Pirates to Single-A Bradenton. It's a bit of homecoming for Gutierrez who was acquired in a trade between the Philadelphia Phillies and the Pirates on 7/30/21 for LHP Braeden Ogle. At the time of the trade, Gutierrez was playing for the Clearwater Threshers and finished the year with Bradenton where he was a part of the 2021 Low-A Southeast Championship roster. In game one, Gutierrez worked a walk-off bases loaded walk against the Tampa Tarpons before hitting two home runs in game three.

**THEY'RE FIGHTING:** After a 4-22 record on the road to start the season, Bradenton won three of their last four games at TD Ballpark in Dunedin last week to force a series split. It was the first time this year that the Marauders have won back-to-back games on the road this year or shared a series split. Bradenton won their third-straight road game on Tuesday for the first time since 7/29/23 - 8/8/23 when they won two in St. Lucie and one game in Fort Myers.

**PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS:** With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, **RHP Christian Curtis** entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30 on Tuesday night. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system. The Altoona Curve (Double-A) are the closest team holding seven of the Top 30 with five of the Pirates top eight prospects there. **LHP Michael Kennedy** is the highest-rated player on the Marauders roster at No. 14.

**IT'S ALWAYS SUNNY IN CLEARWATER:** This week the Bradenton Marauders make their second and final visit to BayCare Ballpark this season. In their first trip, Bradenton dropped five of the six games with all six games in the series decided by eight runs. The Marauders have lost 10 of their last 12 games in Clearwater and haven't won a series at BayCare Ballpark since they won four out of six from 9/6/22 - 9/11/22, the final series of the season.

**HERE COMES THE POWER:** The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games, the second-most in the FSL, with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. This came after the Marauders had only 10 longballs in 22 games in April. So far in June, Bradenton has 25 home runs in 22 games, which is the most in the FSL and all of Single-A. Bradenton has homered 15 of their last 17 games. The most home runs hit in a calendar month in franchise history is 34, achieved back in June of 2023.

**JAVVY'S MASHIN:** Since June 4, **Javier Rivas** is slashing .400/.455/.717 with five doubles, a triple, four home runs, 11 RBIs, one walk, and 11 runs scored in 18 games. Rivas' career-long 13-game on-base streak came to an end on Wednesday against Lakeland. It was his longest streak since he reached base in 11-straight games from 8/10/21 - 8/26/21 when he was a member of the DSL Pirates Black. His six home runs are a new career-high.

**LIFT OFF:** After only hitting one home run in their first nine meetings against Clearwater, Bradenton has slugged 11 over their last seven games against the Threshers. The only other home run against Clearwater hit by the Marauders came on April 26 at BayCare Ballpark when P.J. Hilson hit a two-out eighth inning go-ahead solo-home run in a 1-0 victory.

**TO FRESH BEGINNINGS:** Friday night marked the first game in the second half of the 2024 Florida State League season. The Marauders ended the first half in fifth place with the Clearwater Threshers taking the West Division for the second straight season. Lakeland needed a win and a Clearwater loss to win the half. With the victory, Bradenton is over .500 for the first time this season. Bradenton dropped two of the first three games in April before going on a seven-game losing skid.

**CLOSE QUARTERS:** Friday's win against Lakeland marked the Marauders' 26th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 15-11 record in those games with 46 of their first 70 (65.7%) games having been decided by three runs or less. Only nine of their last 19 games have been decided by three-runs or less.

**Last Time Out:** In his first day start, an 11am Camp Day game, Reed allowed three earned runs. After Bradenton scored two in the second, two runs scored in the third to tie the game. The score remained that way until Reed walked Patrick Lee to start the sixth. Lee stole second and advanced to third on a throwing error before scoring a on a wild pitch. Reed induced a groundout to Samuel Gil to end his outing.

## 2024 Highlights:

- Named Opening Day starter. Struck out a career-high six batters in four innings of work. Four of the five runners left on-base were in scoring position.
- Struck out a career-high eight vs DAY (4/20)
- In a career-high six innings, allowed just one run in a 3-1 win vs Tampa (5/16)...also needed just 69 pitches in his outing. Became second Marauder this season, joining Michael Kennedy, to toss six innings.
- Earned the win in an 8-0 shutout after striking out nine in five scoreless frames against CLR (6/6). Was named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on 6/10 becoming the first Marauders pitcher to pick up that honor this season.
- **Enters start on 6/26 with the second-best GB% in the Pirates org. and third-best in the FSL among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings thrown.**

## Personal:

- Enters the 2024 season as the Pirates' No. 26 prospect per Baseball America...moved up to No. 25 in May re-rankings.
- Became the first player from WVU to be drafted by the Pirates since Kim West in 1972.
- Became the highest-drafted Mountaineer since Alek Manoah was selected 11th overall by the Blue Jays in 2019.
- At WVU: Was an All-Big 12 first-team selection in 2023...went 2-1 with seven saves, a 2.61 ERA (38.0 IP, 11 ER) and 60 strikeouts in 25 appearances in 2023.
- Made three appearances (three starts) for the WV Black Bears and the Trenton Thunder in the 2023 in the MLB Draft League.
- Named to 2023 National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper-of-the-Year Award watch list.
- Was West Virginia's Opening Day Starter in 2022 against Central Michigan.
- Inspiration to become a pitcher came from older players such as Satchel Paige. Read a few books about him growing up and took an interest.
- Grew up playing the saxophone.
