TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their lone series of the season with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. The Curve last played Binghamton in 2023 and are 59-52 all-time at their stadium.

Lefty Jonathan Santucci takes the ball for his Double-A debut. Santucci was New York's 2nd round pick last year out of Duke, he hails from Leominster, MA. Santucci was an All-ACC First Team selection last year and is ranked as the No. 11 Prospect in the Mets system according to Pipeline. Santucci's father played baseball at Assumption from '91-93 and his cousin Nick plays at Division II Rollins College in Florida. He had surgery to clean up bone chips in his elbow in 2023, and also dealt with a 2024 rib injury that cost him most of May; he only threw a couple of innings in June (he looked healthy, up to 97). He never threw more than 58 innings in any college season and struggled with walks.

KELLY K'S: Righty Antwone Kelly struck out a career-high 9 batters in 4.2 innings on July 10 at Binghamton. The 21-year-old has struck out 15 batters in 10.1 innings to start July, he holds a 0.94 WHIP which ranks 8th among qualified minor league pitchers. Kelly's 88 strikeouts this season are second-most in the Pirates minor league system (Bubba Chandler, 93), just one ahead of teammate Wilber Dotel (87).

THINK WE LEFT THE BATS BEHIND: Since Altoona won 9-of-12 games to start the second half of the season, picking up their sixth straight win on July 4th at Harrisburg, the Curve offense has scuffled, including a pair of shutout losses. Altoona has the fewest runs (5) scored since July 5 by a Double-A club and a .128 batting average (19-149).

THE PITCHING WILL CARRY US: Since June 2, Altoona pitchers are 3rd among Double-A teams with a 3.21 ERA. The team has allowed the 2nd-fewest runs (115), earned runs (97), home runs (14) and issued the 2nd-fewest walks (91) in 272.1 IP. Alessandro Ercolani (2.53 ERA, 10 ER / 32.0 IP) and Blake Townsend (1.57 ERA, 4 ER / 23.0 IP) have been two of the top performers of late.

A MAJOR CROWD: Altoona welcomed 9,165 fans to PNG Field on Thursday, July 3, the 3rd-largest crowd in franchise history for a regular season game.

CIM CIM CIMILLO: First baseman Nick Cimillo had an 11 game on-base streak, punctuacted by a walk-off 2-run homer on Thursday, July 3 at PNG Field, end on July 10 at Binghamton. Cimillo has 10 RBI in his last 12 games and is recording a .705 OPS since June 20.

A NEW FUTURE: Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez was promoted to Altoona, along with C Omar Alfonzo, on July 1. Valdez, who leads the South Atlan-Lic League in nearly every major hitting category, was also chosen to represent the organization in the MLB All-Star Futures Game on Saturday July 12 at Atlanta's Truist Park. Valdez is the 23rd Curve player to participate, joining Bubba Chandler (2024), Henry Davis (2022) and Roansy Contreras (2021) as recent selections.

CLOSE WINS: 10 of Altoona's last 11 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 41 of the team's 79 games this year (51%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

THE NEW GUYS WHO THROW HARD: Righty Ryan Harbin had the 4th-longest scoreless streak in the minors this season end on July 9 at Binghamton. From May 13 - July 9, Harbin went 2-0 in 22.1 IP, 10 H, 13 BB, 37 K (.137 BAA), before allowing a run on July 9.

Righty Brandon Bidois has thrown 9.1 scoreless innings since joining the Curve, allowing just 3 hits and 2 walks with 10 strikeouts. The Austrailian native has been unscored upon in 20-of-22 outings this season, going 1.0+ IP in 13 of his 22 outings, totaling 38 strikeouts in 32.1 innings this vear.

CY YOUNG?: Lefty Cy Nielson has struck out 43 batters this season, 5th-most by an Eastern League reliever. Nielson has collected at least one strike out in 35-of-36 career outings with the Curve, racking up 75 in 56.0 IP.

THE TERMINATOR AGES: Infielder Termarr Johnson, who has not yet faced a pitcher younger than him in his professional career, turned 21 on June 11. Johnson played 67 games at Double-A, the third-most by a player under the age of 21 in franchise history. Andrew McCutchen (138 games) and Jose Tabata (83 games) are the only players in franchise history to play more games than Johnson before their 21st birthday.

Johnson batted .295/.333/.410/.743 OPS in 20 games during the month of June with 3 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI and 2-2 SB. Entering play on July 9, Johnson leads the club with 8 homers and is one of four players on the team with 10 or more stolen bases (12)

WEATHERFORD BOYS: The Curve roster features two Weatherford, TX natives in Beau Burrows and Brenden Dixon, Burrows, who signed with the Pirates on May 12 out of the Mexican League has allowed a 0.65 WHIP in 15.1 innings for the Curve, earning 16 strikeouts. He's tossed 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings in his first 10 outings with Altoona.

Dixon played some his best baseball for the team in June, batting .263 with a .795 OPS in 15 games. Additionally he drew 13 walks for the team, helping the team record a 9-1 start to begin the second half of the season. He's reached base safely in 17-of-his-last-22 games.

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 9 of his 16 outings this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count this year, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 17 in 63.2 IP. His 2.39 BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

#### Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

#### Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

#### Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and ioins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

#### Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.
