**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** After a seven-run inning doomed the Vancouver Canadians on Tuesday, it was a five-run fourth that poisoned the C's chances to even the series as they went on to lose 6-3 to the Tri-City Dust Devils (Angels) Wednesday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

Leading 3-0 thanks to a run on three singles - including an RBI base hit from Spencer Horwitz - in the first and a two-run shot from Sebastian Espino in the third, Vancouver starter Sem Robberse (L, 0-2) surrendered five runs (two earned) on four hits and three walks in the fourth though got no help from the defense; they made three errors in the frame to help the Dust Devils go ahead 5-3.

Tri-City added a run in the sixth to go up by three.

Horwitz logged four hits for the second consecutive night while Espino matched a C's season high with a knock in ten consecutive games. Tanner Morris extended his hitting streak to a personal-best nine consecutive games while Will Robertson has a hit in eight straight. On the mound, Hayden Juenger led the way with two perfect innings of relief. Thomas Ruwe made his High-A debut and twirled a scoreless ninth.

**DEVILS MAY CARE:** The Canadians take on Tri-City this week for their second and final meeting with the Angels affiliate this season. These two teams haven't met since the first week of the season when they split six games at Gesa Stadium in Pasco. That week, the Dust Devils outscored the C's 31-28 but Vancouver won the last two games of the series by a combined score of 11-4.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY:** August 19, 2017 - Vancouver used a six-run third to beat Spokane 10-1 at Avista Stadium. Owen Spiwak's first home run of the year - a grand slam - was the highlight of the big inning. On the mound, Dalton Rodriguez, Miguel Burgos and Jake Fishman combined to limit the Indians to one run while scattering ten hits. Fishman worked the last three innings to earn his first professional save.

**BIG INNING BLUES:** The C's have surrendered a combined twelve runs over two innings this week. They were torched for seven runs on seven hits in the third inning on Tuesday before allowing five runs on four hits in the fourth last night.

**HIT PARADE:** Vancouver has reached double digits in hits - averaging 12.8 each night - for nine consecutive games, yet they're only 4-5 in that span. The C's have outscored opponents 71-66 over this recent stretch.

**SPARE NO EX-SPENCE:** Spencer Horwitz is in the midst of his best stretch at the plate this season, highlighted by a career-high four hits in each of his last two games. In the last seven games, the Timonium, MD native is 18-for-32 (.563) with three doubles, a home run - his first since June 29 - seven runs scored and 10 RBI.

**ON THE HILL:** Paxton Schultz climbs the slope for Vancouver. His name was last called on August 13 in Everett, when he got a no decision after working four innings in which he gave up four runs on five hits with two walks and eight strikeouts, the third time he's punched out eight hitters in a game (his season high is nine). Schultz, 23, made his Blue Jays system debut against Tri-City on May 9 in Pasco; that night, the Orem, UT native went four innings, allowed two runs on three hits, walked two and K'd six in four innings of relief to earn the win. He was Milwaukee's 14<sup>th</sup> round pick (433<sup>rd</sup> overall) in 2019 out of Utah Valley before he was the Player To Be Named Later in the trade that sent Derek Fisher to the Brewers in February of this year.

Jake Smith gets the ball for Tri-City in his third professional outing and first start of his career. He made his pro debut on August 8 in Eugene when he earned the win with two innings of scoreless and hitless relief. He last worked on August 14 against Spokane and logged another two scoreless frames. Smith, 21, was Los Angeles' sixth round pick in this year's draft out of the University of Miami, where he spent one season with the Hurricanes and went 3-1 in 18 games (seven starts) with a 3.45 ERA over 47 innings pitched. He previously pitched for State College of Florida and Chipola College, where he helped the Indians to the JUCO World Series.
