YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their fourth straight game, falling to the SeaWolves, 6-1. Trei Cruz homered on the first pitch of the bottom of the first and Grant Witherspoon added a two-run homer later in the inning to open a 3-0 lead. **Riley Mahan** drove in Richmond's lone run with a single in the third, closing the score to 3-1. Diego Rincones hit an RBI single in the fourth. Cruz brought in a run with a sac fly and Colt Keith added an RBI double in the sixth to extend the Erie lead to 6-1. **Raymond Burgos** worked two perfect innings, his 10th consecutive outing without allowing an earned run.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond winning four-of-six. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game set from May 30-June 4 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season at UPMC Park from September 12-17. The Flying Squirrels are 13-14 against opponents from the Southwest Division and 7-6 in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are in first place in the division, a half-game ahead of Erie. They split last week's six-game series at home against the Curve and have dropped five-of-their-last-six games, including each of the first four games in this week's series. The Flying Squirrels offense is ranked tied for fourth in the Eastern League in batting average (.237). The Richmond pitching staff is second in the EL in ERA (3.36).

THE SEAWOLVES were swept in five games against the Sea Dogs from April 26-30 before taking four-of-six against the Baysox in Bowie last week. They have won eight-of-their-last-10 games overall. In the Eastern League, the Erie offense ranks second in runs (159), total bases (415), triples (8), homers (37) and RBIs (148). Erie's roster includes 10 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), INF Colt Keith (No. 4), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8), C Dillon Dingler (No. 14), RHP Dylan Smith (No. 15), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21), RHP Elvis Alvarado (No. 23), RHP Austin Bergner (No. 27) and INF Gage Workman (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Flores (No. 3), Madden (No. 4), Keith (No. 5), Dingler (No. 7), Smith (No. 17), Perez (No. 19), Hurter (No. 26) and Workman (No. 27). Baseball America also including the following Erie players on their Best Tools list: Perez (best hitter for average), Andrew Magno (best curveball), Flores (best control), Dingler (best defensive catcher) and Workman (best defensive infielder and best infield arm).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound for his seventh Double-A start and his second against the SeaWolves. Last time out, Seymour threw four innings and allowed one run against the Curve on Sunday at The Diamond. He faced the SeaWolves on April 19 in Richmond, allowing two runs in 3.2 innings in a no-decision. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. **For more on Seymour, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Brant Hurter makes his seventh start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. After posting a 0.34 ERA in his first five starts of the year, he allowed a season-high six runs over 4.2 innings in his last start on Sunday at Bowie in a loss. He faced the Flying Squirrels on April 20 at The Diamond and allowed one earned run in four innings, the only earned run he allowed over his first five starts this year. He made his professional debut in 2022 and split the season between Low-A Lakeland, High-A West Michigan and Double-A Erie, going 7-6 with a 3.71 ERA in 25 games (18 starts). He reached Double-A Erie in mid-August and went 0-2 with a 7.90 ERA in four outings. He faced the Flying Squirrels in his final outing of the year on September 14 and threw 4.2 scoreless innings with six strikeouts. Hurter is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 21 Tigers prospect and No. 26 by Baseball America. He was selected by the Tigers in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Georgia Tech, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels catcher in his 2018 freshman season. Entering today's start, Hurter is ranked tied for fourth in the Eastern League with a 2.45 ERA.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. Last Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. He has reached base in six-of-his-seven games started this season.

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .346 (18-for-52) with a homer, seven doubles and five RBIs over his last 13 games, including seven two-hit games. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. Munguia is tied for fourth in the league in hits (33) and tied for fourth in runs scored (20). For the year, he is batting .333 (9-for-27) in the first inning.

MATOS MANIA: **Luis Matos** reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the second-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base in nine-of-his-11 games since then and in 27-of-29 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just 12 times in 123 plate appearances (9.8 percent), the second-lowest rate in the league. Matos clubbed his second Double-A homer in Sunday's win over the Curve. He drove an RBI single on Thursday. For the season, Matos is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in hits (30).

BURGOS THE KING: Reliever **Raymond Burgos** has pitched 10 games without allowing an earned run this season, tied for the longest streak in the Eastern League, even with Harrisburg's Amos Willingham. The only run Burgos has allowed overall this season was an extra-innings placed runner in a loss to the Curve on May 3. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 8 G, no starts), Burgos ranks first in runners left on base (94.1%). He is the only pitcher in the EL (min. 15.0 IP) with a 0.00 ERA.

OLD FRIENDS: Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for first in triples (3). **Ismael Munguia** tied for fourth in hits (33) and tied for fourth in runs scored (20). **Riley Mahan** is tied for seventh in RBIs (18). **Luis Matos** is ninth in hits (30). **Hayden Cantrelle** is sixth in OBP (.412). **Kai-Wei Teng** is sixth in ERA (2.63), tied for sixth in strikeouts (36), fourth in BAA (.171) and third in WHIP (0.96). **Juan Sanchez** and **Nick Swiney** are tied for second in wins (3). **Evan Gates** is tied for seventh in saves (3).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Wenceel Pérez is fifth in batting average (.310), fifth in OBP (.413) and tied for eighth in runs scored (19). Trei Cruz is sixth in homers (6) and sixth in SLG (.517). Colt Keith is third in RBIs (21), tied for sixth in hits (32), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (13) and seventh in total bases (56). Jake Holton is tied for seventh in walks (20). Brant Hurter is tied for fourth in ERA (2.45).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
