✦ **COLUMBIA KID HITS FOR THE CYCLE:** OF **Skylar King** was born and raised in Columbia, South Carolina. With family in attendance, King hit for Salem's first cycle since Mike Floyd on August 28, 2005 at Winston-Salem. King did it in reverse order with a leadoff solo home run, triple in the second inning, double in the fifth inning and single to leadoff the eighth inning. King finished his homecoming debut by going 4-for-6 with three RBI and seeing Salem's fifth all-time cycle:

✦ **SHARING THE HITS:** Last night, Salem recorded 21 hits as a team and all nine hitters recorded at least one hit with seven hitters recording multi-hit efforts. Last night became the first time since May 25th, 2023 (vs. Fredericksburg) that Salem saw all nine starters recorded a base hit. Last night's 21 hits were the most in a single game since 21 hits at Winston-Salem on July 21, 2017

✦ **NEW GAME HIGHS:** Salem turned in one of its best offensive performances in recent memory on Tuesday, setting season highs with 21 hits, 34 total bases, 45 at-bats, a .467 batting average and a 1.276 OPS. The 21 hits were Salem's most in a game since 2017, while the 34 total bases and 1.276 game OPS were the club's highest since July 29, 2021, at Kannapolis. The eight extra-base hits were the most since April 27, 2025, at Hickory, the 45 at-bats were the most since May 30, 2024, at Lynchburg, and the .467 batting average was Salem's highest in a game since July 21, 2017, at Winston-Salem

✦ **SKYLAR'S KINGDOM:** Outfielder **Skylar King** continues to impress in his second season of Single-A baseball. Over his last 10 games since June 24, he's batting .390 (16-for-41) with two home runs, 10 RBI, and a 1.139 OPS. That batting average is fifth among Carolina League hitters since June 24

✦ **GUZMAN GOES YARD:** Catcher **Adonys Guzman** homered for the second time on the road trip with a two-run moonshot in the second inning last night. Through 24 Single-A games, Guzman has recorded a hit in 18 contests. Over his last seven games since June 24, he's batting .391 (9-for-23) with five extra-base hits, three home runs, 10 RBI, and a 1.354 OPS

✦ **FIVE GAME FAB:** Salem has won four of its last five games dating back to last Thursday. Over that span, the RidgeYaks lead the Carolina League with a .304 batting average, 39 runs scored, 52 hits, 85 total bases and an .893 OPS. Each of those marks also ranks among the top five in all of Single-A since Thursday

✦ **OPATA ON TOP:** Outfielder **Andrews Opat** stole his 37th base of the season in the sixth inning Saturday night to pass Augusta's Tate Southisene for the Carolina League lead in stolen bases. Through 65 games, Opat is 37-for-42 on stolen base attempts this season (88.1%). He also ranks third among all Single-A players in stolen bases. His 37 stolen bases are the most by a Salem player since Matty Johnson swiped 40 bags in 132 games during the 2014 season

✦ **PRIMERA PLACES IT:** Catcher **Franklin Primera** started his Single-A career by going 0-for-13 at the dish through his first four games with Salem. However, over his last two games since Sunday, Primera is 4-for-9 (.444) with his first multi-hit effort with Salem coming last night

✦ **GILMAN HITS THE ROAD:** In 25.2 innings on the road this season, LHP Jason Gilman dealt to a 0.70 ERA allowing just two earned runs over six road appearances with 34 strikeouts. The ERA is the second lowest road ERA in the Carolina League among pitchers that have tossed at least 15 innings on the road (Hickory's Alejandro Chiquillo, 0.47)

Last night, OF **Skylar King** recorded Salem's fifth all-time cycle and the first since Mike Floyd hit for the cycle on August 28, 2005 at Winston-Salem

- ✦ **THE STRIKEOUT STAFF:** After 81 games this season, Salem pitchers have combined to strike out 827 batters, good for the second-most in the Carolina League. The only team with more punchouts is the Hill City Howlers (850). In total, Salem is averaging 10.21 strikeouts per game
- ✦ **ANDUJAR BREAKS THROUGH:** After recording just one RBI, one stolen base, and batting .095 through his first 20 games in Single-A Salem, INF **Louis Andujar** has flipped it into gear over the last two weeks. Over his last eight games since June 27, Andujar is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with eight RBI and a .928 OPS. Andujar has recorded a hit in six of his last eight games after collecting hits in just five of his first 20 games
- ✦ **MAGIC NUMBER TEN:** The pitching staff has struck out double-digit batters on 49 occasions this season (61% of all games), including 17 of the last 22 games since June 11
- ✦ **MUSETT MASHES:** **Andruw Musett** snapped a team-best 18-game on-base streak Sunday by going 0-for-4 with three strikeouts. Since arriving in Salem on May 5, Musett has recorded a hit in 16 of his 23 games while reaching base in 21 of those 23 contests
- ✦ **STARTING STRONG:** Salem's success this season has often started on the mound. The RidgeYaks are 16-9 when their starting pitcher records at least 14 outs (4.2 innings). Over the last 16 games of the second half, Salem is 4-1 when its starter pitches more than four innings
- ✦ **GILMAN GOES SIX.....AGAIN:** For the second time this season LHP **Jason Gilman** dealt six innings when he started on Saturday in Augusta. last time Gilman went six innings was on June 2 at Wilson when he struck out a career high 10 batters. Gilman has now struck out 60 batters over 40.1 innings of work, averaging 1.48 strikeouts per inning
- ✦ **FOUTCH FEELING IT:** Friday night RHP **Christian Foutch** turned in one of his best starts of his pro ball career, the starter a night ago went 4.2 innings (a new career high), allowing three hits and one run while striking out a career high eight batters. After pitching to a 7.39 ERA over his first 12 outings of his career. Foutch has allowed just one earned run over his last two starts since June 27. Foutch has struck out 13 batters and allowed just three hits over his last 7.2 IP
- ✦ **SIT THEM DOWN:** Over the 24 games in June, Salem pitchers finished the month by striking out 272 hitters, averaging 11.33 strikeouts per game. In the month of June, that total ranked third in Single-A and across all of Minor League Baseball (Full Season)
- ✦ **SALEM ON THE ROAD:** The RidgeYaks have struggled away from home this season, posting a 15-28 road record, tied for the third-fewest road wins in Single-A. Offensively, Salem is batting just .225 on the road, the third-lowest average in Single-A, while scoring 210 runs, and collecting 319 hits. On the mound, Salem pitchers have allowed 259 runs (fifth most), while posting a 5.10 ERA (compared to the 4.32 ERA at home) and issuing 283 walks, the most by any Minor League club on the road this season

WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

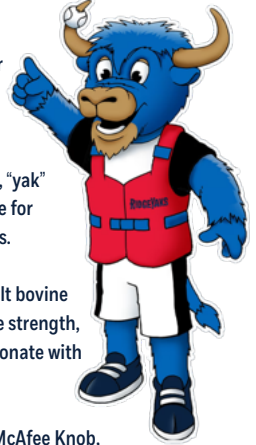
The name "**RidgeYaks**" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

Ridge: A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

Yak: The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named **Mac the Yak**, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- Was selected by the Red Sox in the 18th round of the 2024 MLB draft out of Ole Miss, picked with the 537th overall selection
- Had been committed to transfer to Troy University for his senior season but instead signed with Boston for an under-slot \$50,000 in July
- He made his professional debut shortly thereafter and closed the 2024 campaign by posting a 5.56 ERA with 14 strikeouts to six walks in five appearances (three starts) spanning 11.1 IP with Salem
- Missed the entire 2025 season with a UCL (ulnar collateral ligament) tear, underwent Tommy John surgery last March
- Transferred to Ole Miss from Pearl River CC for his junior season
- At Pearl River CC, he served as the closer all season until the team decided the night before the National Championship game to give Tolbert the start, and he went on to allow 2 runs on 5 hits while striking out 11 over 7 innings
- Made just 16 appearances in his two seasons at Mississippi
- Spent the last year in Fort Myers rehabbing at the Red Sox Florida Complex. To pass the time while recovering from Tommy John surgery, he started umpiring Little League games in Florida to pass the time
- When he returned and pitched vs Delmarva on May 9 it was his first affiliated pitching appearance in 610 days (Sept 6, 2024 vs Kannapolis, went three innings with two strikeouts against the Cannon Ballers)
- Tossed a career long 4.2 innings against the Crawdads on May 31 of this season, striking out three without allowing a hit or run in the winning decision (his first career pro win in his first bullpen appearance in his pro career)

- Opened the 2026 season with High-A Greenville, going 0-4 with a 12.76 ERA across seven appearances and 18.1 innings pitched
- Reassigned to Single-A Salem on May 19 ahead of the six-game series in Hill City
- Made 16 appearances (11 starts) for Salem in 2025, posting a 3.88 ERA with 50 strikeouts across 67.1 innings while going 4-2
- Earned a promotion to High-A Greenville on July 25 and finished the season making his final seven appearances with the Drive
- Logged five or more innings in 10 of his 16 outings last season and worked at least six innings twice (June 18 vs. Fredericksburg and July 6 at Lynchburg)
- His 67.1 innings pitched ranked second on Salem last season behind Adam Bates (80.1 IP), while his four wins ranked third behind Griffin Kilander and Jay Allmer
- Averaged 4.1 innings per outing in 2025 while throwing the second-most innings of any Salem pitcher last season

YAKTOID: Since Salem's affiliation switched to Boston in 2009, Cohen ranks 10th all-time in innings pitched (178.0), 11th in starts (34), and is one of just 15 pitchers in the Boston era to record double-digit wins (10-7)

- Enters his second season in the Red Sox organization after having his contract purchased from the Lake Country DockHounds of the independent American Association on April 30, 2025
- Opened the 2026 season on the High-A Greenville roster and also made one appearance with Double-A Portland before returning to Greenville on April 21
- Appeared in eight games with Greenville prior to being assigned to Salem on May 19
- Split the 2025 season between Salem and Greenville, combining to go 6-1 with four saves, a 53.2 innings pitched, and 30 strikeouts across 29 appearances
- Pitched in the Arizona Fall League with the Salt River Rafterers, posting a 10.80 ERA and .211 batting average against over seven appearances while striking out three in five innings
