Looking Back

Reading fell to Richmond 3-2 in a rare Monday game. Johan Rojas hit a solo home run in the first to put Reading up, but Richmond added a run in the fourth and fifth inning to grab a 2-1 lead. Nick Podkul tied the game up with a solo shot in the seventh. Richmond took a 3-2 lead in a cazy ninth inning, that included multiple ejections when Brandon Martorano charged the mound after being hit by a pitch.

Kroon Krushing It

Matthew Kroon had two doubles Friday night, marking the third time he's had two in a game this season. He's fourth in the Eastern League with 19 doubles this year. Additionally, Kroon's .320 average ranks third in the league. He snapped a 14-game on-bae streak Saturday night and was placed on the injured list Monday after colliding with Carlos De La Cruz in the outfield.

Oliver Gettin' It Dunn

Oliver Dunn had a strong week against Richmond. Last week, Dunn was 7-16; and across his last five games, Dunn's hitting .438 and is at .342 over his last ten. Dunn's Eastern League ranks currently sit at the following: 4th OBP (.404), 3rd walks (51), T-7th OPS (.889) and 5th RBI (43). Dunn also recently had a 22-game on base streak from May 26 to June 23.

Looking Ahead

After this week's series at Somerset, Reading will enter the All-Star Break, with the first game back set for Friday, June 14, against Portland.

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel was selected to the All Star Future's Game on Monday night. Abel is one-of-two Phillies' prospects to be selected, with the other being Justin Crawford of Clearwater. Abel will return just three-hours from home for the game in Seattle. Abel will not pitch for Reading this week.

The Phillies were off yesterday and open a series in Tampa tonight. Lehigh Valley split a doubleheader against Rochester, winning the first game 14-4. Jersey Shore fell to Brooklyn 8-1 as Gabriel Ricones Jr had a double. Finally, Clearwater loss 5-2 to Bradenton as Justin Crawford had two hits and Emaarion Boyd doubled.

This Day in Baseballtown History

Sup Somerset

This is the second series of the season between Somerset and Reading, with the first being a split in North Jersey. Somerset won the first half title and is 4-2 in the second half. Last week, the Patriots took four-of-six at Bowie, and after this week, they'll head to the break and then play nine-straight on the road, with three at Binghamton and then six at Hartford.

Patriot Pitcher

Righty Richard Fitts gets the start tonight for Somerset. This is his 15th start, and he is 4-5 with a 3.99 ERA. Over 76.2 innings, Fitts has allowed 74 hits, issued just 17 walks and has 84 strikeouts. He earned a win on June 29 at Bowie with 5.1 innings of work, allowing three runs on six hits. Against Reading on May 18, Fitts went 3.2 innings, and gave up three runs in six hits. He was drafted in the sixth round in 2021 by the Yankees out of Auburn. Fitts split 2022 between single-A Tampa and high-A Hudson Valley, going 7-8 over 22 starts.
