TODAY'S GAME: Today's game will mark the end of the road trip for your Quakes, with the final game of a sixgame set against the Inland Empire 66ers (LAA) at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes return to LoanMart Field next Tuesday, April 23, hosting Lake Elsinore in a six-game set. Tickets are available at requakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the sixth of 24 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the sixth of 12 at San Manuel Stadium. Last year, the Quakes went 8-4 here at San Manuel Stadium, 14-13 overall against the 66ers. **LAST GAME:** The Quakes completed a double-header sweep of sorts, as they took a pair of games from the Inland Empire 66ers on Saturday. Game one was the completion of Friday's game, which was postponed in the bottom of the first inning after a power outage interrupted play. The Quakes rallied from two different one-run deficits to take a 9-6 decision. Jordan Thompson's go-ahead two-run blast, his first of the year, proved to be the game-winner against 66ers' reliever Jose Fermin (0-2). Quakes' reliever Jorge Gonzalez (2-0) pitched 2 1/3 innings of scoreless relief for the win, while Noah Ruen closed down the ninth for his first save. In the seven-inning game-two finale, the Quakes got a pair of home runs from Jeral Perez en route to a 6-2 victory, giving them three straight wins in the series and four of five overall for their first road series win of the year. Perez took Inland starter Christian Young (1-1) on the very first pitch of the game, then took him yard again in the third for his third homer of the year, all in this series. Patrick Copen (1-1) allowed one run over three innings to notch the win in relief. Zyhir Hope had two hits and reached base five times in game one, but saw his team-best 11-game hitting streak come to an end in game two on Saturday.

FAMILIAR FACES ON THE FIELD: The Quakes have 29 active players on their 30-man roster to open this road trip. Of the 29, 23 have seen time in Rancho within the last two years. Returning Quakes include pitchers Patrick Copen, Carlos Duran (2022), Gabe Emmett, Jorge Gonzalez, Roque Gutierrez, Edgardo Henriquez (2022), Carlos Martinez, Garrett McDaniels, Jose Rodriguez, Christian Ruebeck, Noah Ruen, David Tiburcio and Reynaldo Yean. Returning position players include Jesus Galiz, Cameron Decker, Wilman Diaz, Jake Gelof, Jeral Perez, Jordan Thompson, Joe Vetrano, Juan Alonso, Josue De Paula and Kendall George.

PROSPECTS TO WATCH: The Quakes have four players on their current roster who are rated by MLB Pipeline as Top-30 Dodgers prospects. Three of them play in the outfield, with Josue De Paula (#4), Kendall George (#12) and Zyhir Hope (#21). Infielder Jake Gelof is the other ranked prospect, as he checks in at #23.

EDGARDO HENRIQUEZ: Edgardo Henriquez makes his third appearance of 2024 and just his third overall since 2022, after suffering a season-ending injury with Rancho. In two starts so far, he's allowed just one hit, but three walks and a hit batter over four scoreless innings. In Tuesday's opener at San Manuel Stadium, he struck out four over two scoreless innings in a no-decision. In 2022, Henriquez went 2-3 for the Quakes, with a 4.54 ERA over 14 games (13 starts). Henriquez signed with the Dodgers out of Venezuela in 2018.

BARRETT KENT: Right-hander Barrett Kent makes his third start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last start, he allowed four runs (three earned) on two hits with six walks over four innings in a loss at Fresno on April 11. Made just three appearances after getting drafted in 2023, covering 8.2 innings in 2023, including one game and four scoreless innings with Inland Empire. Kent was drafted by the Angels in the eighth round of the 2023 draft out of Pottsboro High School in Pottsboro, Texas.
