THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2018, the Sounds put up six runs in the second inning on their way to an 11-3 drubbing of Tacoma at First Tennessee Park. Anthony Garcia's grand slam highlighted that massive second inning. Garcia later doubled and finished with five RBI.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp face off in the fourth game of their seven-game series tonight at 121 Financial Ballpark. The clubs split their afternoon doubleheader yesterday, with Jacksonville claiming game one 4-1 and Nashville responding with an 11-4 victory in game two. Southpaw Thomas Pannone toes the rubber against Jacksonville lefty Enmanuel De Jesus.

Thomas Pannone: 29-year-old Thomas Pannone makes his seventh start for Nashville tonight. The left-hander is 1-0 with a 2.86 ERA (34.2 IP/11 ER) in eight appearances on the year. Pannone spun another quality start his last time out in Charlotte, allowing one unearned run over 6.0 innings, but did not earn a decision. It was his third quality start in his last four outings. Pannone pitched for Worcester in 2022, going 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA in 14 outings (12 starts) for the Red Sox Triple-A affiliate. He then joined the Kia Tigers of the KBO after being released from Boston in June. He made 49 appearances with Toronto in 2018 and 2019 (7-7, 5.43 ERA). Pannone was drafted in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft by Cleveland out of the Community College of Southern Nevada.

Enmanuel De Jesus: 26-year-old Enmanuel De Jesus starts for the Jumbo Shrimp tonight. The southpaw is 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA (15.0 IP/6 ER) over three starts. He took the loss his last time out in Durham despite tossing a quality start (6.0 IP, 3 ER). De Jesus started the season on the injured list and made two rehab assignment starts with Single-A Jupiter (1-0, 3.68 ERA). He was signed by Miami as a minor league free agent on December 10, 2022. De Jesus was originally signed by Boston out of his native Venezuela on August 8, 2013 and pitched in the organization from 2014-2021.

Campbell's Big Game: Outfielder Noah Campbell set a bunch of new career highs in game two of yesterday's doubleheader. He smashed two home runs for the first time in his career, matched a career high with three base hits, and drove in six runs. He is the only Sound to knock six-plus RBI so far this season and the first since Mario Feliciano drove in seven on September 4, 2022 vs. Memphis. The Sounds did not have any multi-homer performances this season entering June - they now have three in the last week.

Gasser Goes The Distance: Robert Gasser pitched all seven innings of the Sounds' game two win yesterday, Nashville's first complete game of 2023 and first since Tyler Herb did it on August 21, 2022, also in a doubleheader at Jacksonville. The southpaw allowed four runs, all coming on a pair of homers in the fifth inning, on six hits and two walks. Gasser struck out seven, the sixth time he's punched out seven or more hitters. He enters today as the International League and Triple-A strikeout leader (67).

Michael Reed Hitting Company: Outfielder Michael Reed knocked another home run in game two of yesterday's doubleheader, his second in 24 hours. It was the first time he's homered in back to back days since April 11-12, 2019 vs. Corpus Christi while with Amarillo in the Padres organization. Over his last five games, Reed is hitting .444 (8-for-18) with two doubles, a homer, six RBI, three walks and five runs.

Devanney is Always On Base: Shortstop Cam Devanney extended his on-base streak to 13 games with hits in both of yesterday's games, including a solo homer in the final inning of game one. Since the streak began on May 17, Devanney is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with seven doubles, a home run, six RBI, nine runs and an .867 OPS.

Rehabbing Brewers: Outfielder Jesse Winker joined Milwaukee teammates LHP Eric Lauer and RHP J.B. Bukauskas on rehab assignment yesterday, leading off for the Sounds in game two and homering in his second at-bat. The outfielder is recovering from a cervical strain. Winker is the eighth Brewer to join Nashville on rehab assignment this season (Adrian Houser, Tyrone Taylor, Gus Varland, Luke Voit, Luis Urias, Lauer and Bukauskas).

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 630-547 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Pannone's last start was June 2 at Charlotte. He pitched a beauty, allowing one unearned run on four hits. He struck out a season-high eight hitters and did not issue a walk, tossing 83 pitches for 56 strikes. Pannone departed in line for the win, but the Sounds fell 4-3 in 10 innings, leaving him with a decision.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Pannone has two previous appearances (one start) against Jacksonville. He has a 5.68 ERA (6.1 IP/4 ER) and six strikeouts. His most recent came on April 23 of this season, tossing 1.2 innings out of the bullpen.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began season on development list...activated on April 22.
- Made first appearance of season on April 23, coming out of the bullpen.
- Made first start on May 3, allowing two runs (both earned) in 3.0 innings.
- Tossed quality start (6.0 IP, 1 ER) in win over Gwinnett on May 14...was his first win of the season...was the first quality start by a Sounds pitcher in 2023... followed it up with another (6.0 IP, 3 ER) in loss at Durham on May 20.
- Struck out eight and did not issue a walk on June 2 at Charlotte... was his first start with 8 Ks and no walks since June 19, 2019 vs. Indianapolis (with Buffalo).

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA in 14 games (12 starts) with Triple-A Worcester... walked just 3.1% of hitters faced, the 2nd lowest in International League (min. 60 IP).
- After being released by Boston on June 27, made 14 starts for the Kia Tigers of the Korea Baseball Organization...went 3-4 with a 2.72 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 82.2 innings.

2021 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-11 with a 7.07 ERA in 24 games (21 starts) with Triple-A Salt Lake (Los Angeles-AL)...posted highest ERA in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 IP).
- Led the Triple-A West in innings pitched...was one of just seven qualifying pitchers in the league.

CAREER NOTES:

- Made Toronto's Opening Day roster in 2019.
- Threw an "immaculate" inning on April 14, 2019 vs. Tampa Bay, striking out Avisail García, Brandon Lowe and Daniel Robertson in order on nine pitches in the fifth...was the third such inning in Blue Jays history...went on to retire all nine batters faced (4 K) in that outing.
- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 30, 2019 after going 2-0 with a 1.63 ERA (11.0 IP/2 ER) and 14 strikeouts.
- Carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning of his first Major League start on August 22, 2018 vs. Baltimore...only hit was Trey Mancini's single to start seventh.
- In 2017, went 9-3 with a 2.36 ERA in 25 starts with Double-A Akron, Double-A New Hampshire and Advanced-A Lynchburg.
- Named an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star in 2017...led the Eastern League in BAA (.227) and WHIP (1.09)...ranked among Eastern League leaders in ERA (2nd, 2.92), winning percentage (3rd, .700) and strikeouts (10th, 110).
- Did not allow an earned run (1 R) through first six starts of 2017 between Lynchburg (5 GS) and Akron (1 GS)...streak of 33.1 innings without an earned run was the second longest in the full season minor leagues by a starting pitcher.
- Traded to Toronto on July 31 alongside 2B Samad Taylor in exchange for RHP Joe Smith
- Named a Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star in 2016.
- Drafted by Cleveland in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft.

COLLEGE/PREP NOTES:

- Graduated from Bishop Hendricken High School (RI).
- Initially drafted by Chicago-NL in the 33rd round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign.
- Attended Community College of Southern Nevada, where two-time NL MVP Bryce Harper and former Brewer Phil Bickford also played baseball.
