**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a 6-game set at Richmond.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Altoona earned a 6th straight win with a 6-4 comeback win over the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday night. Matt Gorski scored on a pair of errant pickoff throws and then Dylan Shockley gave the Curve the lead in the 9th.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:** The Curve have won six straight beginning with five straight wins of their series with Binghamton last week and the series opener with Richmond. Altoona last won seven straight games May 7-15 of 2021.

**HAMMERING HANK HEADS TO INDY:** C Henry Davis, who had at least one hit in 17-of-22 games in May and had his first two career multi-homer games was promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on Tuesday, June 5. Davis' .980 OPS is 3rd-best among all Double-A players and he reached base safely in 37-of-41 games with Altoona.

**WINNERS:** The Curve took 5-of-6 in their series with Binghamton, it was the 3rd time in 3 seasons that they've won 5-of-6 against a single opponent, each time taking out the Rumble Ponies: 5/11-16/2021 and 8/9-14/2022 @ BIN. Altoona won back-to-back 6-game series for the 6th time since the installation of the schedule format in 2021. Altoona has won three straight 6-game series just once, the final three series of the 2022 season.

**MAY MOUND MEN:** Through two months of Eastern League play, right-handers Sean Sullivan and Kyle Nicolas have established themselves as two of the top starting pitchers in the league. Through play on May 31, Sullivan ranked 3rd in the league in ERA (2.56), 3rd in WHIP (1.09), 4th in BAA (.206). Nicolas is 3rd in the league in strikeouts (56), T-1st in GS (10) and T-3rd in IP (46.2). Juan Minaya is tied for the league lead with 17 appearances on the mound and Oliver Garcia is T-2nd in wins (4).

**BEAM ME UP SCOTTY:** Outfielder Connor Scott has found some success at the plate as the calendar rolled into late-May. He reached base safely in a season-best 5 straight games from May 23-30 and batted .421/.476/1.053/1.529 with 3 3B, 3 3B, 1 HR, 10 RBI, 2 BB. Scott's streak ended on May 31, but he lifted a game-winning sacrifice fly in the 10th inning to secure a 4-3 win over Binghamton.

**JUST DON'T RUN ON HIM:** Catcher Dylan Shockley, who already has matched a franchise record with four base stealers caught in one game on May 12 vs. Akron, has caught 12 baserunners overall this season. His 12 CS are T-3rd in the Eastern League and T-6th among all Double-A catchers this season. Altoona's catchers threw out 12 potential baserunners in May, which was tied for the second-most at the entire Double-A level and first in the Eastern League.

**KEEP IT IN THE PARK:** Curve pitching have allowed one home run in 7-of-8 games including 5 straight games in their series with Binghamton, a new season-long. Entering play on Tuesday, May 30 the Curve had allowed the second-fewest homers by a Double-A team, but allowed a season-high 8 home runs last week.

**WE'LL TAKE TWO:** Altoona leads all Double-A teams with 50 double plays turned in the field. The Curve have struck out 393 times this season, the fewest among all Double-A teams and 2nd fewest in all of MiLB.

**PROSPECT PARTY:** The Curve roster features several top Pirates prospects according to MLB Pipeline led by No. 6 INF Liover Peguero, No. 11 RHP Jared Jones, No. 17 OF Matt Gorski, No. 20 RHP Kyle Nicolas, and No. 23 OF Matt Fraizer.

**THE SQUIRRELS THAT FLY:** Dennis Pelfrey returns for a second season as Richmond skipper after leading the Flying Squirrels to a First Half Title and a playoff appearance in 2022. The Squirrels roster features several top Giants prospects according to MLB Pipeline including: No. 5 OF Vaun Brown, No. 8 LHP Carson Whisenhunt, No. 10 RHP Mason Black, No. 13 RHP Landon Roupp, No. 17 RHP Carson Seymour, No. 26 RHP Randy Rodriguez, and No. 27 RHP Ryan Murphy.

**THE FIRST IN FLIGHT:** Carson Whisenhunt, the 66th overall selection in 2022 out of East Carolina by the Giants, makes his Double-A debut tonight for Richmond. In 10 starts this season with San Jose and Eugene he's gone 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (9 ER / 39.0 IP) and struck out 56 batters. Whisenhunt never threw a pitch for ECU as a result of a yearlong suspension for a performance-enhancing drug test, but was thought of as one of the drafts best left-handed pitchers. Whisenhunt is known best for an outstanding change-up and a low-90's fastball. He is ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 8 prospect in the Giants system.
