LAST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (June 6, 2021) – Early offense and a season-high 15 strikeouts by the pitching staff lifted the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders to a 4-3 victory over the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on Sunday at PNC Field.

The RailRiders took the lead in the bottom of the first when a Trey Amburgey RBI double scored Hoy Park with the first run of the game. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tacked on three more in the second, with an RBI double from Max McDowell and a two-run home run by Park highlighting the action.

The long ball was the second in as many days for Park, and his fifth of the year in 15 games with the RailRiders. His career high for home runs in a season is seven in 2017.

Staked to an early 4-0 lead, Nick Green turned in his best start of the season for SWB. The right-hander lasted 4.0+ innings, allowing only two hits and walking two while striking out five. He left the game with the bases loaded and no outs in the fifth having not given up a run, but two of those runners scored against Albert Abreu before the inning was over.

Reggie McClain (3-0) got the win in relief for the RailRiders, throwing 1.2 scoreless innings. Kyle Barraclough allowed a run in the eighth on a Mickey Moniak solo home run, but struck out four in 1.1 frames of relief.

Luis Garcia issued a leadoff walk in the top of the ninth, but struck out the next three batters to earn his eighth save of the season. The RailRiders pitching staff struck out 15 batters on the day, and the final seven outs of the game were all recorded on strikeouts.

NEWS & NOTES

TREY DAY: RailRiders outfielder **Trey Amburgey** has been among the best hitters in all of minor league baseball this season, and entering play Tuesday night, has at least one hit in all 13 games he has played. That stands as the longest active hitting streak in Triple-A East, and is the second-longest in the league this season (**Yariel Gonzalez**, TOL, 16 G). Dating back to the end of the 2019 season, Amburgey has hit in 15 consecutive games and has at least one hit in 20 of his last 21 contests, and he is hitting .403/.488/.750 (29-for-72) in that span. The SWB franchise record for longest hitting streak belongs to **Pablo Ozuna**, who hit in 27 straight games in 2004 for the Red Barons, while the longest on-base streak is **Brandon Drury's** 32-game streak in the 2018 season.

THIS ROAD TRIP FEELS...FAMILIAR: With the Buffalo Bisons having to play their entire home schedule this season at Trenton Thunder Ballpark, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders will play this series in a familiar setting for many players. From 2003 through 2019, the Trenton Thunder were the Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. Fifteen members of the RailRiders roster suited up for the Thunder under its Yankees affiliation. Adding an extra layer of complexity to the arrangement, Buffalo wears Trenton Thunder jerseys while playing at home, including the alternate "Trenton Pork Roll" identity on Fridays. The new Trenton Thunder Draft League team is playing its home games this season not at Trenton Thunder Ballpark, but at nearby Rider University in Lawrenceville, N.J.

WELCOME BACK: Since the RailRiders last played on Sunday afternoon, the roster has taken a new look, with five players being added on Tuesday afternoon by the Yankees. **Zack Britton** and **Ryan LaMarre** were both added to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's roster on MLB rehab assignments, with Britton being transferred from Double-A Somerset and LaMarre beginning his. Also, **Trevor Lane**, **Robinson Chirinos** and **Kellin Deglan** were all activated from the Temporally Inactive List after playing in the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympics Qualifying event. Lane represented the United States, while Chirinos played for Team Venezuela and Deglan for Team Canada. Team USA won the event and became the fifth team to qualify for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics (with Japan, Korea, Mexico and Israel).

FAST OUT OF THE GATE: With 19 wins in 28 games, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have kept themselves in elite company across minor league baseball. Entering play on Tuesday there are only 22 teams across minor league baseball with at least 19 wins, with only Nashville, Durham, Omaha and Jacksonville at that mark among Triple-A East teams. Bowie (AA, BAL) has the best record in minor league baseball at 21-7 (.750) on the season, but Tampa (Low-A, NYY) has the most wins at 22-8 (.733). Overall, the Yankees have the best organizational record in baseball (.76-39, .661), a full 4.5 games better than Kansas City (.71-43, .623), who has the second-best record.

SATURDAY IN THE PARK: Since his promotion from Double-A Somerset, infielder **Hoy Park** has been a hitting machine for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. After a 2-for-3 performance on Sunday, Park is hitting .370/.477/.722 with 4 doubles, 5 home runs and 14 RBIs in just 15 games played. In 113 games with Trenton in 2019, Park totaled three home runs, and combined with his one home run with Double-A Somerset this year, Park is already one homer shy of his career-high of 7 HR (2017 with Charleston and Tampa). Signed as an international free agent in 2014, Park already has six multi-hit games with the RailRiders, including a pair of three-hit contests. He has reached base safely in 14 games and recorded a hit in 12 of his 15 contests. Hitting Coach **Casey Dykes** credits Park's success to his advanced command of the strike zone and continued emphasis on generating hard contact and hitting the ball in the air.

WALK-A-THON: Through 28 games this season, the RailRiders have drawn 144 walks (5.14 per game), the second-most in all of Triple-A baseball, trailing only Gwinnett (163). No other team in the minors' highest level has taken more than 139 bases on balls (Lehigh Valley). Overall, the RailRiders are tied for 13th in all of minor league baseball in walks, with Tampa (Low-A, NYY) leading the way with 189 walks. The top four teams in walks all play in the Low-A Southeast, which is using an automated balls and strikes (ABS) system this season. SWB's team .356 OBP is third in Triple-A East, and ranks tied for 16th across all levels of the minors. There are currently three teams in Triple-A East with team OBPs of .350 or higher. Among qualified hitters, the RailRiders claim only **Andrew Velazquez** and **Socrates Brito** (both t-45th, .337) in the top 50 in OBP in Triple-A East.

LAST TIME OUT: Warren came out of the bullpen for the RailRiders on Saturday and threw 2.0 innings against the Lehigh Valley IronPigs. After setting the Pigs down 1-2-3 in his first inning of work, he allowed a triple to Scott Kingery to begin his second frame, and after he scored on a sac fly, Warren yielded a solo home run to Ryan Cordell to account for the second run. Those were the final two runs of the game scored by Lehigh Valley in an eventual 9-6 win.

THIRD (OR IS IT FOURTH?) TIME'S THE CHARM: The 2021 season marks the third different stint in the Yankees organization for Adam Warren. After beginning his career in the Yankees organization (2009-15), he was traded to the Cubs for Starlin Castro during the offseason in 2015 before coming back to the Yankees on July 25, 2016 in the Aroldis Chapman trade. The Yankees traded him to Seattle on July 30, 2018 for international signing bonus pool money. After spending 2019 with San Diego and undergoing Tommy John surgery in September 2019, Warren signed with the Yankees, but was released in July 2020. He then re-signed with New York in December 2020.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the RailRiders Opening Day Roster.
- Earned a win in his first appearance of the season on May 5 at Syracuse.
- Recorded his first save since the 2017 season on 5/9 at Syracuse, and the first save of his minor league career.

SWB CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Pitched for the SWB Yankees/RailRiders previously in the 2011, 2012 and 2018 (rehab) seasons.
- Won the 2012 Rawlings Minor League Gold Glove Award as the top fielding pitcher in the minors.
- Was 10th in the International League in ERA in 2011, named to 2011 Triple-A All-Star Team.
- Went 13-16 with a 3.66 ERA (124 ER/305.0 IP), 6.43 K/9, 2.92 BB/9, 1.34 WHIP in 53 G (53 GS) with SWB in 2011 & 2012.

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Adam Parrish Warren.
- Drafted by the Yankees in the 4th round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of the University of North Carolina.
- Graduated from UNC with a degree with Business administration.
- Went 32-4 with a 3.42 ERA (276.0 IP, 105 ER) and 240K in 65 G (49 GS) in his collegiate career. Left school with the second-most wins by a Tar Heel and tied with Scott Bankhead for the school's highest winning percentage (.889). Won his first 19 decisions at UNC, marking the longest UNC winning streak since Bankhead won 20 straight from 1983-84.
- Helped the North Carolina Tar Heels to the College World Series in three straight years (2006-08), leading them to the championship series in 2006 and '07...graduated fifth in his class from New Bern High School (N.C.), where he earned all-state honors as a junior in 2004 and was selected as the New Bern Sun Journal "Baseball Player of the Year".
- Was a member of the ping pong club.
