GAME INFORMATION

CHEF GORDON: RHP **R.J. Gordon**, the Mets' No. 25 prospect, is slated to start Game 1 of the Eastern League Championship Series today. The 2024 13th-round pick out of Oregon is in his first professional season and went 6-1 with a 3.69 ERA in 11 appearances (10 starts) at the Double-A level in the regular season. Gordon was the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for August. Since making his Double-A debut on July 10, Gordon ranked among the EL with 6 wins (T-1st), 61.0 innings (2nd), 71 strikeouts (3rd), and 1.11 WHIP (6th). The 23-year-old spun at least 5.0 innings in nine of his 11 appearances with Binghamton.

POSTSEASON FILE: Binghamton has qualified for the Eastern League Playoffs for the 13th time in franchise history, dating back to 1992 when it won the Eastern League Championship in its inaugural season. Binghamton swept Somerset in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the fifth time in franchise history. Binghamton has won three Eastern League titles (1992, 1994, and 2014) and last reached the ELCS in 2023 when it was swept by Double-A Erie (Game 1; 9-6 @ BNG ... Game 2; 10-0 @ ERI).

HARD 90: The 2025 Binghamton Rumble Ponies are just the fifth Double-A team since 1950 to win 90 games in a season and the second team this century. The other Double-A teams to win 90 games in that span are San Antonio - 2011 (San Diego Padres), Harrisburg - 1993 (Montreal Expos), Greenville - 1992 (Atlanta Braves), and Wilkes-Barre - 1950 (Cleveland Indians).

FRANCHISE RECORD FOR WINS: Binghamton set the franchise record for wins in a single season (90). Binghamton surpassed its previous record of 86 wins in 2013. Binghamton was one of two teams in Minor League Baseball, along with Detroit's High-A West Michigan (92 wins), to reach 90 wins. **REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONS:** Binghamton won both halves of the regular season in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, clinching a playoff berth with a 45-22 (.672) record in the first half and going 45-24 (.652) in the second half. Binghamton finished 90-46 (.662) overall and finished a season-best 44 games above .500. Binghamton had the best winning percentage in Double-A and the 3rd-best in MiLB, behind High-A West Michigan (.702) & High-A Greensboro (.672).

REID ALL ABOUT IT: Binghamton Rumble Ponies fourth-year manager **Reid Brignac** led Binghamton to its most wins in a single season in franchise history (90). Over his tenure as manager (2022-2025), Brignac has managed to a 286-257 (.527) record. He is the 2nd-longest tenured and 2nd winningest manager in franchise history behind Pedro Lopez (377 wins from 2012-16). Lopez was the 2013 Eastern League Manager of the Year, Binghamton's last skipper to win the award.

REIMER REASON: INF **Jacob Reimer**, the Mets' No. 6 prospect (MLB Pipeline), over his final 25 games of the regular season (since August 14), hit .389 (35-for-90) with a .456 OBP, .667 SLG, 1.123 OPS, 5 HR, 20 RBI, 20 R, & 14 XBH. The 21-year-old upped his AVG from .200 to .279 and OPS from .662 to .853 at the Double-A level over that span. Reimer is ranked as MLB Pipeline's No. 3 3B prospect.

GOTTA GO MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito**, the Mets' No. 16 prospect (MLB Pipeline), ended the regular season on a 12-game on-base streak with five multi-hit games in that span. Morabito recorded 49 stolen bases this season, which is the T-4th-most in a single season in Binghamton franchise history. Morabito ranked among Double-A with 49 SB (3rd) and 27 2B (T-8th). The 22-year-old ranked among the Eastern League: SB (2nd), 119 H (5th), 2B (6th), .273 AVG (7th), 63 R (T-7th).

EWING IT ALL: OF **A.J. Ewing**, the Mets' No. 7 prospect (MLB Pipeline), had multi-hit games in both games of the ELDS vs. Somerset (4-for-9, 2 RBI, R, 3B, SB). He reached base safely in 24 of his first 28 Double-A games, with 41 H, 9 RBI, 19 R, and 12 SB. Over his last 21 games of the regular season, since 8/20, Ewing hit .374 AVG with a .866 OPS, 8 RBI, 16 R, 7 2B, and 9 SB. The 21-year-old ranked among MiLB with 70 SB (5th), 10 triples (T-6th), and 15 hits (8th) across three levels.

SUPER SMASH SUERO: C **Chris Suero**, the Mets' No. 16 prospect (MLB Pipeline), smashed a 428-foot solo home run to left field in the eighth inning in Game 1 of the Eastern League Northeast Division Series on Tuesday. Suero ended the regular season on a 4-game hit streak with 5 H and 1 HR. The 21-year-old finished the season with 16 home runs in 115 games across High-A Brooklyn (13) and Binghamton (3). He was named a 2025 High-A South Atlantic League All-Star.

SCHWARTZ TO BE RECKONED WITH: 1B/LF **JT Schwartz** hit a game-tying RBI single in ELDS Game 1. Schwartz had at least 1 H in 16 of his last 23 G of the regular season (.299 AVG, .817 OPS, 12 RBI).

LAST START: Recorded seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings against Portland on Friday, September 12, at Mirabito Stadium, while allowing three runs on six hits...He threw 4.0 scoreless innings, before allowing three runs in the top of the fifth inning.

2025 SEASON: Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for August (4-0 with a 2.80 ERA and 42 strikeouts in 34.2 IP across six starts), ranked among EL: IP (1st), SO (2nd), 0.95 WHIP (2nd), ERA (3rd), .190 BAA (4th) in August...Mets MiLB Pitcher of the Week for 2nd-straight week, after going 2-0 with 17 strikeouts over 10 IP and allowing 2 ER in two starts against Somerset at home (August 26 & 31)...Mets MiLB Pitcher of the Week after throwing 7.0 scoreless innings and taking a no-hitter in to the 7th inning in a win at Portland on August 20...Dominated in Double-A debut against Altoona on July 10 (W, 7 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 K)...Promoted to Double-A Binghamton on July 7...Ranked among the South Atlantic League with 3.06 ERA (7th), 76 SO (T-9th), and .233 BAA (10th) at the time of his promotion...Made 15 appearances and 11 starts and went 5-2 with a 3.06 ERA and 76 strikeouts-to-31 walks in 67.2 innings...Began first season of professional baseball with A+ Brooklyn.

LAST SEASON: Returned to the mound for his final season at Oregon, after missing all of 2023 due to a UCL injury that required internal brace surgery...As a redshirt junior in 2024 at Oregon, he went 7-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (54 ER in 94.2 IP), 46 walks, and 87 strikeouts in 17 starts...Gordon was named All-PAC 12 Honorable for the Ducks...Served as Oregon's Opening Day starter in 2024...Was the Game 1 starter in every regular-season series, the Santa Barbara Regional, and the Bryan-College Station Super Regional...Led the PAC-12 in starts (17)...Also ranked 2nd in IP (94.2), tied for 3rd in wins (7), and 8th in strikeouts (87)...Gordon was initially recruited to Eugene as a two-way player.

CAREER NOTES: Currently ranks as the New York Mets' No. 25 prospect (MLB Pipeline)...Did not pitch professionally in 2024 after being drafted in June.

BACKGROUND: Originally drafted by the New York Mets in the 13th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Oregon...Spent four seasons (three active, missed 2023 with internal brace surgery) at Oregon and tied for 10th in program history with 28 career starts (51 APP, 28 GS, 14-9, 5.22 ERA, 155 SO, 182.2 IP)...2024 All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention...Grew up in Santa Clarita, California and finished his high school career at West Ranch High School...Began his high school career at Notre Dame HS and was a freshman when RHP Hunter Greene (Cincinnati Reds) was a senior...Father Jason played professional golf on the PGA Tour, the Canadian PGA Tour, and the Nationwide Tour...Full name is Robert Joseph Gordon.
