**Today's Game:** The Nashville Sounds open the 2024 season against the Toledo Mud Hens at Fifth Third Field in Toledo, Ohio. Nashville is on the road on Opening Day for the first time since starting the 2021 campaign at Toledo on May 4. Highly touted prospect Carlos Rodríguez gets the start for the Sounds, facing the Tigers' first round pick from the 2016 draft, Matt Manning.

**Carlos Rodríguez:** The 22-year-old makes his first Opening Day start at the professional level. The right-hander spent most of last season with Double-A Biloxi, going 9-6 with a 2.77 ERA across 25 starts with the Shuckers. Rodríguez was honored as the 2023 Southern League Pitcher of the Year. He also was honored with his second Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year award, becoming the first pitcher since Ben Hendrickson (2001, 2003) to receive the award multiple times. This is just Rodríguez's second start in Triple-A after finishing 2023 in Nashville, making his debut on September 20 vs. Jacksonville. It's also his first outing against a Tigers affiliate. He enters the season as Milwaukee's No. 8 prospect per MLB Pipeline and No. 11 prospect by *Baseball America*.

**Matt Manning:** The 26-year-old from California gets the Opening Day start for Toledo. He was also the Mud Hens' Opening Day starter when they hosted the Sounds on May 4, 2021. Manning took a no-decision that night, allowing five runs (all earned) in 5.0 innings (Toledo would rally to win 8-6). Manning has spent parts of the last three seasons with Detroit, going 11-14 with a 4.37 ERA in 45 starts in the Majors. Last season, Manning suffered two right foot injuries - both after being hit by line drives. On April 11, he broke his right toe after being hit by a line drive off the bat of Toronto's Alejandro Kirk. After missing several months, he returned only to get hit in the same foot on September 6 at Yankee Stadium, getting drilled by a Giancarlo Stanton liner measured at 119.5 MPH off the bat. After battling for the final spot in the Tigers rotation in spring training, Manning was optioned to Toledo on March 22.

**Young Gun:** At 22 years and 123 days, Rodríguez is Nashville's youngest Opening Day starter since the Sounds moved to the Triple-A level in 1985. Only Bill Dawley, who made the first start in franchise history on April 15, 1978 at age 20, was younger (Dawley was younger starting Opening Day on April 16, 1979 as well). Former Brewer Willy Peralta was 22 when he started for the Sounds on Opening Day 2012 at New Orleans.

**Opening Day Facts:** Nashville is 21-24 all-time on Opening Day...the Sounds have won their last two Opening Day games, both at First Horizon Park (2022 5-4 vs. Durham, 2023 3-1 vs. Louisville)...Nashville's last road Opening Day win came on April 5, 2019 at New Orleans (11-0)...the Sounds are 3-1 on Opening Day with manager Rick Sweet and 7-6 as a Brewers affiliate (2005-14, 2021-present).

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 683-583 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,275-2,103 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

**Paint it Black:** Tyler Black returns to the Sounds lineup after finishing last season as one of the hottest hitters in Triple-A. The Ontario, Canada native ended 2023 on a 14-game hitting streak, batting .453 (24-for-53) with 16 runs, nine extra-base hits and 11 RBI over that span. As a whole, Black led MiLB with 12 triples and was one of three minor leaguers with at least 18 homers, 25 doubles and 55 steals (also Jonatan Clase in the Mariners organization and Ryan Bliss with Triple-A Tacoma and Reno). Black also returns to the Buckeye State after his time as a standout with Wright State University in Dayton from 2019-21.

**Short Time, No See:** Nashville will face the 2023 Sounds Most Valuable Player, Keston Hiura, who's now an infielder with the Mud Hens. Hiura played in 85 games with Nashville last year and hit .308 (97-for-315) with a team-leading 23 home runs. The former Brewer was signed by Detroit to a minor league contract and invite to spring training on February 19.

**One Step Away:** Catcher Jefferson Quero is set to make his Triple-A debut today. The 21-year-old from Venezuela is ranked the No. 3 prospect in the Brewers system and No. 35 in baseball by MLB Pipeline. Quero received a Rawlings Minor League Baseball Gold Glove Award last season behind the plate and impressed the Brewers faithful by throwing out five runners during spring training in Arizona. With the bat, Quero crushed 16 homers with Double-A Biloxi last season, tied for the ninth-most in the Southern League.

### Most Wins by Minor League Managers

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Rodriguez's first career start against Toledo.

- Named the Brewers Minor League Co-Pitcher of the Year and Southern League Pitcher of the Year...was also a MiLB.com Organization All-Star, SL Postseason All-Star and *Baseball America* Double-A and Minor League All-Star
- Became the first Brewers minor leaguer to earn Minor League Pitcher of the Year award twice in the organization since Ben Hendrickson did so in 2002 and 2004
- Led Double-A in ERA and opponent batting average...also ranked among level leaders in WHIP (2nd) and strikeouts (4th)
- Named Southern League Pitcher of the Month and Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July...went 2-1 with a 0.98 ERA (18.1 IP/2 ER) and 24 strikeouts in four starts, including back-to-back scoreless efforts vs. Rocket City (5.0 IP, 9 K) and at Montgomery (3.1 IP)
- Selected to play for Team Nicaragua in the World Baseball Classic...allowed one run over 4.0 innings in team opener against Puerto Rico
- Posted a 1.88 ERA (28.2 IP/6 ER) over his first six starts of the season...also had 0.98 WHIP and .147 opponent average
- Struck out 10 batters for the first time in his professional career on May 3 at Montgomery
- Allowed just one hit (a solo home run) over six innings in victory vs. Rocket City on May 10... was his first homer allowed this season (26.0 innings)
- Set career high with 11 strikeouts and 7.0 innings on May 27 vs. Montgomery
- Tossed three consecutive quality starts to end season with Biloxi, posting 2.94 ERA (18.1 IP/6 ER) with 19 strikeouts
