Both games are scheduled for seven innings. This is Lansing's first doubleheader of the year.

Starting Matchups: The Nuts have a pair of right-handers set for today, with 22-year-old **Joelvis Del Rosario** taking the mound in Game 1, followed by 24-year-old **Mitch Myers** in Game 2. On the other side, Lake County is expected to start southpaw **Will Dion** in the opener, followed by right-hander **Trenton Denholm** in the nightcap.

Last Night: Captains 5, Lugnuts 4. Lake County overcame a monster game by **Lazaro Armenteros**, who went 3-for-4 with two home runs, including a game-tying shot leading off the top of the ninth, with a walk-off RBI single by **Isaiah Greene** in the bottom of the ninth.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with **Logan Potosky**, and with online audio via StreamGuys, featuring **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Captains through Sunday before returning home for a 12-game, 13-day homestand against the Quad Cities River Bandits and the Dayton Dragons, beginning April 25 and ending May 7.

LUG•NOTES

Welcome to the Show: 2022 Lugnuts right-hander **Mason Miller** fired 4 1/3 innings (2 R, 5 K) yesterday as the Oakland Athletics' starting pitcher against the Chicago Cubs in his Major League debut, becoming the 176th Nuts alumnus to reach the Majors and the third this year.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

Highly Offensive: Lake County (.253) and Lansing (.247) have the highest team batting averages in the Midwest League. The Captains' overall .713 team OPS ranks third behind South Bend and West Michigan while the Lugnuts (.709) rank fourth.

Streiking: **Caeden Trenkle** drew two walks yesterday, extending his on-base streak to nine games – every game he has played this year. Conversely, **Jack Winkler** was hitless in five at-bats, ending his own seven-game hitting streak and eight-game on-base streak.

Speaking of Trenkle: The 2022 ninth-rounder from Oklahoma State is second in the league with a .488 OBP.

Going Deep: After not homering in their first six games of the year, the Nuts have hit six roundtrippers in the last four games. **Jonny Butler** flipped the power switch with a two-run homer on Friday before **Daniel Susac** and **Max Muncy** each connected Saturday and **Lazaro Armenteros** blasted off to center field on Sunday. Armenteros then homered twice again yesterday, giving him three home runs for the season, tied for the most in the MWL. Armenteros has six stolen bases, tied for second most in the league, and his .667 slugging percentage also ranks second while his 1.081 OPS ranks third.

Opposite Ends of the Spectrum: The Captains overcame four errors to prevail last night, giving them 13 errors for the year, tied for the most in the league, with a league-worst .962 fielding percentage. On the other hand, the Lugnuts turned in a clean game yesterday and rank 1st in the MWL in fewest errors (5) and best fielding percentage (.986) in addition to tying for the most double plays turned (12) with West Michigan.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

The King: First name is pronounced “yo-elvis,” with the emphasis on the middle syllable... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball.

Lugnuts Lineage: Del Rosario tossed 4 2/3 scoreless innings on Opening Day, April 7 at Great Lakes... he joined such other Opening Day Lugnuts starters as: Blaine Mull (1996), Steve Hueston (1997), Justin Pederson (1998), Mike Wuertz (1999), Matt Bruback (2000), Wilton Chavez (2001), Angel Guzman (2002), Andrew Sisco (2003), Sean Marshall (2004), Casey Janssen (2005), Chi-Hung Cheng (2006), Zach Dials (2007), Trystan Magnuson (2008), Henderson Alvarez (2009), Ryan Shopshire (2010), Misaul Diaz (2011), Noah Syndergaard (2012), Javier Avendano (2013), Jairo Labourt (2014), Chase De Jong (2015), Jon Harris (2016), Justin Maese (2017), Yennsy Diaz (2018), Josh Winckowski (2019), Seth Shuman (2021) and Grant Holman (2022).

Home Cooking: Also from Santiago: Jose Lima, Santiago Espinal, Joaquin Benoit, Willy Adames, Julian Tavarez, Jhonny Peralta and Jose Reyes.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.

In a Nutshell: Became the final Lugnuts starting pitcher to make his 2023 debut, opening as the Wednesday starter... upon throwing his first pitch, became the 906th player in Lansing Lugnuts franchise history... the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Lugnuts was also the only other Panther ever to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st overall pick in 2016, who made two starts for Lansing in 2016 and is now in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9 on social media.

Hometown Hero: Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

College Journey: Initially committed to University of Alabama, joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros)... upon transferring to Pitt, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.
