LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox scored 17 runs and matched their season-high with 15 hits in a 17-8 victory over the Senators to win their third in a row. Bowie scored 12 of the 17 runs in the first four innings. **Frederick Bencosme** hit a grand slam and **Jud Fabian, Samuel Basallo,** and **John Rhodes** all collected three RBI each. Rhodes also homered for the eighth time this season. On the mound, Cameron Weston struck out seven over 4.1 innings in relief to pick up the win.

WE'VE GOT THE RUNS

Bowie has scored 29 runs in the series thus far, the second-most amongst Double-A teams this week while having played one less game because of Thursday's postponement. The Baysox also lead all Double-A teams in SLG (.569) and OPS (1.012) this week. In July, the Baysox scored 69 runs, the fourth-fewest in Double-A.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, leads the Eastern League in total bases (162) and is tied for 2nd among active Eastern League players in hits (99). Basallo is leading all qualified Eastern League hitters in August with a .464 batting average (13-for-28). The No. 2 O's/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 2nd-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (15) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit homers in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in '18. Basallo will turn 20 years of age next Tuesday.

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

With his 17th homer of the season on Tuesday, OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for the Eastern League lead in home runs after his leadoff solo shot. Amongst Double-A hitters, he is tied for 4th in home runs. The O's No. 8 prospect has 32 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers. Fabian has also reached base in 10 straight games, one shy of his season-long.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** recorded his first four-RBI game at Double-A with his first career grand slam last night. The Orioles No. 24 prospect has tallied a hit in 12 of his last 14 games. Over his last 10 games, the 21-year-old is batting .429 (15-for-35) with two doubles, two homers and 10 RBI.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** set a new a career-high in home runs on Tuesday with his 12th of the season. The 22-year-old has reached base in 72 of 90 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (49) and stolen bases (25), tied for fourth-most and tied for third-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is batting a team-best .375 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .510 and OPS of .960. The 23-year-old has collected a hit in eight straight contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 22 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

SIZING UP THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators are in last place in the Southwest Division with a record of 12-21. The Double-A affiliate of the Nationals is at the bottom of the league in AVG, OPS and HR but its pitching staff owns the second-best ERA in the circuit. Eight of the Nationals top 30 prospects are on the Senators active roster - OF Daylen Lile (No. 9), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 16), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 19), SS Kevin Made (No. 20), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (No. 25), RHP Andy Lara (No. 26), RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTERS

RHP Rodney Theophile and RHP Tyler Stuart will start both games of the double-header for Harrisburg today. Theophile was promoted to Harrisburg on June 25 and has a 2.25 ERA in seven Double-A starts this season. Stuart was traded from the Mets to the Nationals during the trade deadline. The former Binghamton Rumble Pony is tied for the sixth-most strikeouts in the Eastern League (104).

2024: Has thrown 5th-most innings (82.1) and has 8th-most strikeouts (95) in O's system this season. Threw only 2.1 IP in most recent start on 8/3 vs SOM after inclement weather suspended game. Owns a 5.40 ERA in seven second half starts. Recorded a 4.08 ERA in the first half. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC and still looking for first win of season. Owns a 4.81 ERA in 10 home starts. Baysox are 5-15 when Bright starts. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA (9th lowest in EL) over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

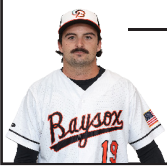

2024: Makes his first start since 7/2 vs RIC. Leads team in wins (6). Holds a 2.72 ERA as a starter in 10 starts this season. Last three outings have been out of bullpen as a bulk reliever. 1.13 career ERA in four outings vs HBG. Holds a 3.79 ERA in second half. Placed on IL from 7/23-8/5. Baysox are 7-3 when he starts. Recorded a 3.91 ERA in first half. Threw first 6.0 inning start by a Baysox pitcher this season with 6.0 shutout, no-hit innings and 6 K on 6/2 @ SOM. Began season in rotation for three starts before being bumped into long relief role for five straight outings. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made four rehab appearances between FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen before being sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) with Baysox and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

2022: Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

2021: Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 K over 60.2 IP and an ERA of 3.86.

2019: Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

Personal: Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League.
